Philadelphia Phillies (35-37)

Second Place, NL East, 6.5 GB

METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets returned to the win column with a 9-1 victory over the Reds in Cincinnati yesterday...The victory snapped a two-game losing streak...The Mets are 11-8 over their last 19 games and 23-20 over their last 43 games...The Mets are on a six-game, seven-day road trip (1-2) against the Reds (1-2) and Phillies (three games).

ROSTER MOVE: INF Vidal Brujan has been outrighted to Triple-A Syracuse.

MULTIPLICITY: Bo Bichette has recorded multiple hits over each of his last six games, the longest-streak of his career...He is batting .538 (14-26) in that span with eight runs, three doubles, two homers and eight RBI...His six straight multi-hit games is tied for the third-longest streak by a Mets player...Steve Henderson holds the franchise record with eight straight multi-hit games (July 12-21, 1979) followed by David Wright with seven (June 24-30, 2011).

BO KNOWS BALL: Over the last 31 games since May 15, Bo Bichette is batting .304 (38-125) with 22 runs, six doubles, one triple, six homers, 24 RBI, seven walks, a .341 OBP, a .512 SLG and an .853 OPS...Over his last 13 games, he is batting .436 (24-55) with 11 runs, five doubles, one triple, three homers, 14 RBI with a 1.158 OPS.

THE LEFTORIUM: As a team, Mets pitchers are holding opposing left-handed hitters to a .231 (294-1275) mark...That is seventh in the majors and fourth in the NL.

MIGHTY GOOD MANAEA: Over his last seven games (one start), Sean Manaea has gone 1-2 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP), seven walks and 27 strikeouts...This compares to his first eight games of the year where he went 0-0 with a 6.85 ERA (17 ER/22.1 IP), 10 walks and 24 strikeouts...Manaea made his first start of the year in his last outing on June 13 vs. Atlanta...He allowed two earned runs on four hits with six strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work.

HIGH FIVE: The Mets have scored five or more runs in each of their last 10 wins dating back to May 29 vs. Miami...The team scored a total of 73 runs in their last 10 wins...The Mets are batting .283/.355/.468 when they win, compared to a .186/.246/.285 in losses.

JUAN OF A KIND: Juan Soto has 259 career home runs...That is the 11th-most in Major League history prior to turning 28 (next: Frank Robinson, 262)...His 259 homers are 24th among active players...It is 21st all-time amongst players born in the Dominican Republic...George Bell is next with 265...Soto has reached base safely in 10 straight games, batting .382 (13-34) with six runs, three doubles, two homers, seven RBI, 10 walks, a .523 OBP and a .647 SLG.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Mets are 15-23 on the road in 2026...They have won four of their last seven road games...Last season, the Mets went 34-47 on the road...The team has posted a 3.62 ERA on the road, which is third in the majors and second in the National League.

THE HUSASCAR GOES TO: As a relief pitcher, Huascar Brazobán has pitched to a 1.21 ERA (4 ER/29.2 IP) across 25 appearances...He ranks ninth in majors and sixth the NL in relief pitcher ERA (min. 20.0 IP).

PHILS-METS NOTES: In the regular season, the Mets are 97-96 against the Phillies at Citizens Bank Park...They have dropped five straight games at the yard and eight of their last nine in Philly.

POWER OF THE PEN: The Mets bullpen has posted a 3.34 ERA (119 ER/320.2 IP) as a group...That ranks fourth in the majors and third in the National League...They have struck out 324 this season, the most in The Show.

STRIKE THAT: Mets pitchers have tallied 672 strikeouts this season, that is tied for the fourth-most in the majors and is the fourth-most in the NL...Their 672 punchouts are the fifth-most in franchise history through the team's first 74 games of a season.

WILL I AM: Devin Williams is unscored upon in 15 of his last 17 appearances dating back to April 26 and has 24 strikeouts during that span...His 37 strikeouts this season are tied for 11th among NL relief pitchers.

DREAM WEAVER: Luke Weaver has not allowed a run over his last 17 appearances...He has tossed 19.0 scoreless innings, allowing 10 hits, four walks and has struck out 22 in that span...He is now 2-1 with a 2.32 ERA (8 ER/31.0 IP) this season with eight walks and 30 strikeouts in 28 appearances...He has recorded six appearances of at least four outs this season and each of those appearances have been scoreless.

THIS DAY IN 1986: The Mets dropped their second straight game to the Expos, falling 7-4, in Montreal...Doc Gooden took his third loss of the season, allowing seven runs (six earned) over his hits with six walks and struck out one over 6.1 innings of work...The Mets combined to score three runs in the eighth and ninth innings, but could not come all the way back...Wally Backman led the offense, collecting three hits, while Darryl Strawberry and Gary Carter each homered...This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions...The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 title on Saturday, August 1 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Additional information for the 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration is available at [Mets.com/1986](https://mets.com/1986).

START ME BACK UP: Made his first start of the season on June 13 vs. Atlanta (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 6 K, HR) and he allowed two earned runs over 6.0 innings while striking out six...Was the first time he completed at least 6.0 innings since he threw 7.0 innings against Philadelphia in game 3 of the 2024 NLDS...It marked his first start since September 28, 2025 at Miami...For his career, 211 of his 258 Major League appearances have come as a starter and over those starts, he is 74-63 with a 4.09 ERA (527 ER/1160.2 IP) and 1086 strikeouts.

RIGHTING THE SHIP: Overall, this season Manaea is 1-2 with a 4.78 ERA (26 ER/49.0 IP) and has 51 strikeouts over 15 appearances (one start)...Over his last seven appearances dating back to May 10, he has pitched to a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP) with 27 strikeouts...He has held opponents to a .208 (20-96) average while posting a 9.11 K/P over that span...Comparatively, he pitched to a 6.85 ERA (17 ER/22.1 IP) and batters were hitting .312 (29-93) off him during his first eight appearances of the season.

VS. PHILADELPHIA: Will be making his eighth start and 11th career appearance against the Phillies (including the Postseason)...Over his 10 career appearances (seven starts) against Philadelphia, he is 3-4 with a 5.52 ERA (27 ER/44.0 IP) and 45 strikeouts (including Postseason)...Since joining the Mets in 2024, he has made six starts against his division rivals and he is 2-2 with a 4.59 ERA (17 ER/33.1 IP) with 34 strikeouts...Most notably, he faced the Phillies on October 8, 2024, in Game 3 of the NLDS, allowing one earned run over 7.0 innings and picked up the win while striking out 6...He has recorded at least five strikeouts in five of his six appearances against the Phillies since joining the Mets.

RELIEVER RANKS: Has thrown 43.0 innings in relief this season, which is tied for the third-most among all Major League relievers and is tied for the second-most among NL relievers...His 45 strikeouts this season are tied for the third-most among NL relief pitchers...In 47 career games in relief, Manaea is 6-5 with a 4.32 ERA (64 ER/133.1 IP) with 43 walks and 148 strikeouts.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: This season, he has thrown his sweeper 32.2% of the time...He is one of 22 qualified pitchers who have thrown their sweeper at least 30.0% of the time...He has generated a 31.5% whiff rate on his sweeper which is the 17th-best mark in the majors for pitchers who have thrown the pitch at least 200 times this season...21 of his 51 strikeouts this season have come via the sweeper.

CAREER: Over the course of 11 Major League Seasons with the Athletics, Padres, Giants, and Mets he has a 80-68 record, a 4.11 ERA (591 ER/1294.0 IP), and 1235 strikeouts in 258 games and 211 starts...His 1235 career strikeouts are the ninth-most among active left-handers...He resigned with the Mets this offseason on a three-year contract in December 2024...The Valparaiso, Indiana native was originally drafted in the first round by the Kansas City Royals in 2013 out of Indiana State University.
