#### That's a Fact, Jack!

In his last 17 games, **Jackson Chourio** is batting .315 [23-for-73] with 4 HR and 13 RBI.....in this stretch, he has a .324 OBP/.575 SLG/.900 OPS....he is currently on an 8-game hitting streak, batting .294 [10-for-34] with 2 HR and 5 RBI.....during the streak, he has a .294 OBP/.618 SLG/.912 OPS.

# Born Again Christian

In his last 21 games, **Christian Yelich** is batting .363 (29-for-80) with 7 HR and 17 RBI.....during this stretch, he has a .427 OBP/.663 SLG/1.089 OPS.

# Tag Team Match

Jackson Chourio (12 HR/13 SB) and Christian Yelich (14 HR/10 SB) are currently joined by the Cubs' duo of Pete Crow-Armstrong (19 HR/23 SB) and Kyle Tucker (13 HR/18 SB) as the only sets of Major League teammates with 10+ HR and 10+ SB this season.

# I Like Ike

In his last 9 games, Isaac Collins is batting .320 (8-for-25) with 2 HR and 6 RBI.....during this stretch, he has a .452 OBP/.680 SLG/1.132 OPS.

# U Da Man!

Abner Uribe is unscored upon in 30 of his 34 appearances this season, including 22 of his last 23 outings and 9 games in a row.....Uribe ranks among NL relief leaders in strikeouts [T3rd, 44] and ERA (T4th, 1.31).

# Track Meet

The Brewers and Cubs enter the day with 90 stolen bases each, which is tied for the National League lead and trails only the Rays [97] in the majors.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 2 (0-1) of a 6-game road trip to Chicago-NL (0-1) and Minnesota (3g)....following this trip, the team returns to American Family Field for a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Pittsburgh (3g) and Colorado (3g).

<u>IT WON'T BE THE SAME</u>: This season marks just the second without **Bob Uecker** on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (92 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10\*, SECOND: 25, THIRD: 43, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in second place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 8.5 games (\*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

<u>SERIES-LY SPEAKING</u>: The team is 12-10-1 in series play. <u>Game 1</u>: 12-12, <u>Game 2</u>: 13-10, <u>Game 3</u>: 11-12, <u>Game 4</u>: 3-1 <u>Sweep Wins [2]</u>: vs. BOS [3g, 5/26-5/28] and at PHI [3g, 5/30-6/1] <u>Sweep Losses [1]</u>: at NYY [3g, 3/27-3/30]

AT HOME: The team is 23-15 at home, going 8-4-0 in series play.

<u>ON THE ROAD</u>: The team is 16-20 on the road, going 4-6-1 in series play.....the Brewers are 6-2 in their last 8 road games.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

<u>COACHES</u>: Returning from 2024 is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made nine replay challenges this season, going 6-3.....their last challenge (won) came on 6/14 vs. St. Louis as a safe call at third base involving Iván Herrera was overturned.

**BREWING SUCCESS**: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons [2018-24] and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros [7], Braves [7], Dodgers [7] and Yankees [6].....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons [2017-24], missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY**: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons [2017-24].....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 705 wins since 2017 (6th in MLB/3rd in National League).

# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #32 - RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI (1gs, 1-0, 0.00) 2025 Arsenal: 4-Seam Fastball (53.1%) - Slider (30.9%) - Curveball (13.6%) - Changeup (2.5%)

MISIDROWSKI AT A GLANCE: Jacob Misiorowski, 23, will be making his second start for the Brewers.....he made his Major League debut last Thursday vs. St. Louis and earned a 6-0 win (5ip, 0h, 4bb, 5k, 81 pitches).....he became just the ninth pitcher (sixth starter) since 1900 to throw at least 5.0 hitless innings in a Major League debut.....Misiorowski was selected by Milwaukee in the second round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Crowder (MO) College, where he pitched one season (2022) and became the highest drafted player in school history.....name is pronounced "miz-uh-RAO-skee."

A GAME OF NUMBERS: Misiorowski wore No. 33 in his Major League debut.....the next day - following the trade of RHP Aaron Civale to the White Sox - he switched to No. 32, the number he wore from college and through his Minor League career with the Brewers.

THANKS FOR YOUR SUPPORT: Misiorowski had a number of supporters on hand for his Major League debut, including his parents, Tom and Crystal, his girlfriend, Elle, and her family, along with his grandparents, aunts, uncles and cousins.

HIGHLY-TOUTED: Misiorowski made his Major League debut as the second-best prospect in the organization according to Baseball America (MLB No. 21 overall) and the fourth-best prospect in the organization according to MLB Pipeline (MLB No. 68 overall).

AT NASHVILLE: Misiorowski, who entered the season as the third-best prospect in the organization according to Baseball America, joined the team from Triple-A Nashville, where he was 4-2 with a 2.13 ERA in 13 games/12 starts.....he was International League Pitcher of the Week twice and Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May..... the team went 6-6 in his starts.....he made 4 quality starts.....opponents batted .175 (38-for-217, 4hr).....he produced 80 strikeouts in just 63.1 innings pitched (11.37 K/9IP).

LAST SEASON: Misiorowski went 3-5 with a 3.33 ERA and 1 save in 33 games/21 starts between Double-A Biloxi (19gs) and Triple-A Nashville (14g, 2gs).....he held opponents to a .167 batting average with 127 strikeouts in just 97.1 innings pitched (11.74 K/9IP).....he was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week three times.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Misiorowski has gone 11-9 with a 3.04 ERA and 1 save in 68 games/55 starts in the Brewers farm system (2022-25).....opponents have batted .170 and he has produced 320 strikeouts in just 233.2 innings pitched (12.33 K/9IP).....he pitched in the 2023 All-Star Futures Game at T-Mobile Park in Seattle.
