



# Colorado Rockies (15-28) vs. San Francisco Giants (20-25)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants host the Colorado Rockies in game one of a three-game series.

- ▶ The Giants enjoyed a much needed off day yesterday, ending a stretch of 16 consecutive games without an off day dating to April 30 for the Giants, the team's longest stretch of consecutive games with no off day this year.
- ▶ **RHP Mason Black** takes the hill tonight after being recalled from Triple-A Sacramento...Black will make his third Major League start and will be seeking his first big league win.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants made the following moves today.

- ▶ **RHP Keaton Winn** placed on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to May 15) with a right forearm strain.
- ▶ **RHP Mason Black** (#47) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **OF Jorge Soler** returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 10-day Injured List.
- ▶ **IF Casey Schmitt** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

**ROX ON?:** Beginning with the 2021 season, the Giants have gone 40-14 (.741) against the Rockies, including a 20-5 (.800) record here at Oracle Park...SF has won each of their last five games vs. Colorado here in the Bay and eight of its last nine...SF has outscored COL by a 133-71 margin during this 25-game stretch of home games, dating to 2021.

- ▶ The Giants have a 13-4 series record against Colorado since 2021, the highest series winning percentage by the team against any opponent over that span (min. three series) according to *Stats, LLC*.
- ▶ The Giants also have eight sweeps against the Rockies since 2021, the most by any team against a single opponent over that span.
- ▶ The Rockies (entering play today) have won seven-straight games starting with a 9-1 win over the Giants last Thursday at Coors Field...they have outscored teams 43-to-14 during this stretch, with the offense hitting .306/.346/.476 with 6.1 runs per game...their pitching staff has a 1.86 ERA (13er, 63.0ip).

**STILL GRINDING:** The Giants are slashing .226/.294/.341 over their last 20 games dating to April 24...they are averaging 3.20 runs/game in that span, scoring 64 runs.

- ▶ SF's 3.20 runs/game in this span is second-lowest in the Majors entering play today ahead of only the Pirates (3.14).

**THE INJURY BUG PLAGUE:** **RHP Keaton Winn** was placed on the 15-day IL today with a right forearm strain, suffered in his last start on Tuesday night versus the Dodgers...**RHP Ryan Walker**, currently on the active roster, was not available for Wednesday's game due to back tightness...below is a chart of all the players the Giants have placed on the IL in the last two weeks (14 days).

**EXTRA! EXTRA!:** The Giants have an extra-base hit in 15-straight games entering tonight (dates back to May 1), tied for the second-longest active streak by a National League team (Mets - 22; Pirates - 15).

**TRENDING UP: LHP Blake Snell**, on the IL since April 24 with a left adductor strain, will have his MLB rehab assignment transferred to Sacramento and join the River Cats tonight to make another rehab start.

**WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** has reached base in 16 consecutive games entering play today and has a .475 OBP with seven RBI in that span...the 16-game on-base streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors behind MIL's William Contreras (23 games), SD's Luis Arraez (21 games) and TEX's Leody Taveras (18 games).

- ▶ Wade's 16-game on-base streak the second-longest of his career...his only longer streak was a 19-game streak from April 20-May 13, 2023.
- ▶ Wade has drawn 15 walks already this month, most in MLB...the last Giant to reach 15 walks in a single month was also Wade in June 2023.
- ▶ His .467 on-base percentage and 21.5% walk rate this season are both tops in MLB (min. 130 PA).

**TRENDING UP:** After going hitless in 14 at-bats in his previous five games, **OF Mike Yastrzemski** enters this series with back-to-back multi-hit games, going 4-for-8, including a homer and two RBI on Wednesday versus LA.

- ▶ The Giants are 62-16 (.795) in Yastrzemski's career when he has two or more RBI in a game (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ Yastrzemski has a .270/.351/.513 slash line in 66 career games vs. Colorado with 11 home runs and 40 RBI.

# MASON BLACK RHP # 47

**WITH THE GIANTS:** Black is making his third MLB start...he has spent parts of four seasons in the system after being taken in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University (Bethlehem, PA)...Black became the seventh Giant, and sixth pitcher, to make his Major League debut this season.

**VS. COLORADO:** This will be Black's first career game against the Rockies.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Black made his Oracle Park debut in the Giants' 5-1 win over Cincinnati on May 11...the rookie struck out two while allowing one run (a solo home run), four hits, two walks and a hit batter across 4.1 innings.

**LAST SEASON:** He ascended to Triple-A for the first time in his three-year professional career in 2023...he put forth a strong 3.86 ERA (26er, 60.2ip) in 13 starts in the hitter-friendly Pacific Coast League...Black posted a 1.19 ERA (4er, 30.1ip) with 42 strikeouts and seven walks over his final seven starts with Richmond...overall, he averaged 11.3 strikeouts per 9.0 innings for the season, striking out 155 batters in 123.2 innings.

**THE FUTURE IS NOW:** With the prospect graduation of both **LHP Kyle Harrison** and **RHP Keaton Winn**, Black is currently SF's third-ranked pitching prospect, No. 7 overall, according to *MLB.com*.

**OPPORTUNITY CALLS:** Black looked to be a favorite to win a rotation spot out of Spring Training prior to the signing of **LHP Blake Snell**...with the injury to Snell, Black received the call to the Majors thanks to a strong start in Triple-A, going 2-1 with a 1.01 ERA (3er, 26.2ip), 29 strikeouts, a 0.90 WHIP and a .178 opposing batting average (16x90) over six starts...he is 12-14 with a 3.22 ERA in the Minors with 320 strikeouts, a 1.16 WHIP and a .219 opposing batting average over 262.1 career innings (59 starts).

**SWEEP IT UNDER THE RUG:** Through two games, Black has thrown his sweeper 35.8% and his four-seam fastball 32.7% of his pitches...the Rockies pose a major test to Black as shown in the chart below.

**RIGHT ON:** The Rockies have a .247/.310/.381 slash line against right-handed pitching this season with their .692 OPS ranking 12th in MLB...when combining Triple-A and MLB numbers, righties are batting .219 (16x73) against Black this season with a very low .557 OPS.

**AWARDS:** Black has had a well-decorated Minor League career...he has won six awards, including a PCL Pitcher of the Week this season when he struck out seven over 5.0 hitless/shutout innings vs. El Paso on April 12.

Dixon is an infielder at Wofford University.
