RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals contiune a 10-game 'home" stand with the second of a three-game series against the San Francisco Giants that began with the first game on Thursday at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., where the Cardinals served as the home team. St. Louis will play two home games against the Giants then continue with a three-game series against the Atlanta Braves (June 24-26) and conclude with a four-game series against their division rival the Cincinnati Reds (June 27-30) in their first visit to Busch Stadium in 2024

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and tied for the 2nd position in the National League Wild Card race. They have won six of their last nine games and own the best record in the National League at 22-12 (.629) since Mother's Day (May 12).

HERRERA PLACED ON I.L.; RAPOSO SELECTED: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals placed catcher **Iván Herrera** on the 10-day Injured List (back tightness) retroactive to June 19. Rookie catcher **Nick Raposo** was selected from Memphis (AAA). RHP **Keynan Middleton** was transfered from the 15-day to the 60-day Injured List.

THE "RAP" SHEET ON RHODE-Y: When rookie catcher Nick Raposo first appears in a Major League game, he will become the first Cardinal born in Rhode Island to play in a Major League game since the late RHP Phil Paine, who pitched against the San Francisco Giants at Sportsman's Park on Sept. 19, 1958. Raposo will be the ninth player born in Rhode Island to play for the Cardinals since they joined the National League in 1892, and he's the only active player on a 2024 Major League

GALLEGOS ACTIVATED & KLOFFENSTEIN OPTIONED: On Friday, the Cardinals activated RHP Giovanny Gallegos from the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder impingement) after missing 39 games. RHP Adam Kloffenstein was optioned to Memphis (AAA) after making his Major League debut at Rickwood Field on Thursday, throwing a scoreless in-ning for a Hold. OF Victor Scott II was sent back to Memphis after serving as the 27th player, playing an inning in left field.

CONTRERAS CONTINUES REHAB: Cardinals catcher Willson Contreras (fractured left arm) continued his injury rehabilitation assignment at Memphis (AAA) and caught seven innings last night. Contreras has appeared in four rehab games at Memphis and is batting .167 (2-12)

with a walk and RBI. He has missed 38 games since the injury on May 7. Since May 8, Cardinals catchers are batting .252 (38-151) with 2 HR, 16 RBI, 6 doubles and a triple over that period.

THE CITY BY THE BAY: St. Louis and San Francisco all-time series is tied at 361-361 since the Giants moved from New York in 1958.

HELS-BELLS: Cardinals relief pitcher Ryan Helsley established a new record for consecutive saves when he nailed down his 25th straight rescue vs. San Francisco on Thursday night. Helsley moved past **Alex Reyes**, who established his record over six seasons (2016-21). Helsley currently leads the Majors with 25 saves and that total ranks T-6th most by a Cardinals pitcher pre-All-Star Break behind the franchise record holder, **Lee Smith**, with 30 in 1993

ALABAMA SLAMMER: Cardinals outfielder Brendan Donovan played his first Major League game in his home state of Alabama on Thursday at Rickwood Field and hit a two-run home run in his first plate appearance. The Yellowhammer State native went 3-for-4 on the day with a double, three RBI and missed the cycle by a triple, while playing left field and third base in the game. Donovan has an RBI in four straight games, tied for the Cardinals season-high in 2024.

MAKING A SACRIFICE: Entering Thursday night, **NoIan Gorman** had only two sacrifice flies in the first 275 career games of his career, then cracked two sacrifice flies in his first two plate appearances against San Francisco. He became the first Cardinals player since **Albert Pujols** on May 31, 2022, to pull off the feat & it was 8th time by a Cardinals second baseman.

Brandon Crawford played 13 seasons in San Francisco (2011-23), where he was a cornerstone of two World Series Championship teams (2012, 2014) that eliminated St. Louis from the postseason each time...three-time National League All-Star...four-time Gold Glove Award wininer...2015 Silver Slugger Award recipient.

Willie McGee played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond, CA... played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, CA...resides in Hercules, CA... worked as an asst. coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, CA.

Tommy Edman played college baseball at Stanford University (2014-16), where he was teammates with Austin Slater.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Keith Hernandez was born in in San Francisco, CA...graudated from Capuchino High School in San Bruno, CA.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 16th start of the season and his 166th career (194th appearance).
- Moved his career record to 59-59 and dropped his career ERA below 4.00 at 3.99 in his last start against the Cubs at Wrigley Field (6/16); earning the win allowing one run on 6.1 innings pitched.
- Is 3-1 with a 2.76 ERA (42.1 IP), 32 strikeouts, and 0.83 WHIP in his last seven starts since Mother's Day (5/12), lowering his ERA nearly two runs from 6.43 to his current 4.59.
- Leads all National League pitchers since May 12 in WHIP (0.83) and opponent batting average (.182), while ranking 2nd in innings pitched (42.1) and baserunners/9 IP (7.65).
- Has allowed runs in only one inning or less per start over his last eight starts. Opponents have scored in only 18 of 79 complete innings Mikolas has pitched this season.
- Has thrown 6.0 or more innings in five consecutive starts, T-5th-longest active streak in MLB (Corbin Burnes 10, Logan Gilbert 7, Mitch Keller 7, Logan Webb 7).
- Threw a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings for a no decision vs. PIT (6/11) opposite
 rookie Paul Skenes as the Cardinals lost 2-1. Retired the first 17 batters in order and did
 not allow a hit until Brian Reynolds led off the 7th inning with a triple off the centerfield
 wall, but stranded him at third base.
- Surpassed 1,000 innings pitched in his career vs. PIT (6/11) becoming the 49th active pitcher in Major League Baseball with 1,000 innings pitched.
- All five wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, has a winning record on the road (32-28) and losing mark at Busch Stadium (23-25).
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in only one of his 15 starts (101 on May 1 at Detroit).
- This season, has the 5th-highest qualifying ERA (4.59) in the National League and 12th-highest opponent BA (.255).
- In his 155 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 63-32 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings (5-4 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-37 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 46-5 (.902 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 61-14 in those 75 games). He's just 9-49 (.155) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 25-56).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 4th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018.

LAST TIME OUT

- Held the Cubs to one run, allowed by a relief pitcher as an "inherited runner scored" in the 7th inning as his 14.0-inning scoreless streak was snapped, but held on for the win in a 2-1 St. Louis series clinching win at Wrigley Field.
- Allowed four hits and didn't concede an extra base hit until the 7th inning, double to lan Happ, who came around to score on a Michael Busch single.
