MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager (472-441) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617)..... under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsav (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

TODAY'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (13g, 12gs, 6-1, 2.25)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 25, will make his 14th appearance and 13th start of the season.....it will be his third start against the Reds.....Peralta last started last Thursday at Cincinnati and received no decision in the Brewers' 7-2 win (4ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 75 pitches).....he did not return to the game after a 37-minute rain delay.... the team is 9-3 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .134 (31-for-232, 7hr).....he has 98 strikeouts in just 68.0 innings.....he has a 1.25 ERA over his last 6 starts (36ip, 5er).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 3-1 with a 3.99 ERA in 15 games / 1 start last season.....he held opponents to a .204 batting average (22-for-108, 2hr) with 47 strikeouts in just 29.1 innings.....he began the season in the starting rotation, making his only start in a 9-1 loss on 7/26 at Chicago-NL (3ip, 3h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 3k, 1hbp, 1wp).....he went 3-0 with a 3.08 ERA in his 14 relief appearances (26.1ip 9er).....his 15.04 K/9 IP as a reliever ranked fifth in the Major Leagues.

CAREER: Is 22-9 with a 4.04 ERA in 83 games / 35 starts (260.2ip, 117er).....has pitched four seasons, all with the Brewers (2018-21).....is 14-8 with a 4.29 ERA as a starter (178.1ip, 85er) and 8-1 with a 3.50 ERA in relief (82.1ip, 32er).....notched his only career save on 7/24/19 vs. Cincinnati.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 14-3 with a 2.71 ERA in 42 games / 15 starts (133ip, 40er)....is 4-0 with a 1.37 ERA in 7 games / 6 starts this season (39.1ip, 6er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 8-6 with a 5.43 ERA in 41 games / 20 starts [127.2ip, 77er].....is 2-1 with a 3.45 ERA in 6 starts this season [28.2ip, 11er].

CAREER vs. REDS: Is 2-1 with a 3.48 ERA in 12 games / 6 starts (41.1ip, 16er), including 0-0 with a 3.12 ERA in 2 starts this season (8.2ip, 3er).
