BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles fell to the Rangers last night, 8-5, and look to avoid a series sweep this afternoon...Baltimore has dropped four straight to Texas since July 1, 2025, and has not lost five straight to the Rangers since a six-game skid from June 5-September 8, 2019... Following today's series finale, the Birds enjoy an off-day tomorrow before beginning a six-game road trip against the Pirates and White Sox.

- ♫ **Taylor Ward** tallied a career-high four hits, adding a double, run, and two RBI...Entering last night, Ward had registered three hits in a game 37 times...Ward was the first Oriole with a four-hit effort since **Jordan Westburg** (also 4 H) on August 17, 2025 at Houston.
- ♫ **Zach Eflin** did not factor into the decision after tossing 3.2 innings, allowing one run, an Ezequiel Duran homer, on four hits and two walks with seven strikeouts...Eflin tallied seven strikeouts only once (6/5 at SEA) across 14 starts in 2025...He was removed from last night's start with one out in the top of the fourth inning with right elbow discomfort.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, the Orioles placed **RHP Zach Eflin** (right elbow discomfort) on the 15-day IL, selected the contract of **RHP Albert Suárez** from Triple-A Norfolk, and transferred **INF Jordan Westburg** (right elbow UCL sprain) to the 60-day IL.

ROGER THAT: In eight starts at Camden Yards since June 23, 2025, **Trevor Rogers** is 5-1 with a 0.83 ERA (5 ER/54.0 IP), .149 (27-for-181) opponent average, 0.74 WHIP, and 50 strikeouts against 13 walks...He began this run with a win over the Rangers, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings while allowing three hits and zero walks while striking out four.

- ♫ Rogers has allowed three hits or fewer in each of his last four starts since September 12, 2025, matching his career-best streak from September 26, 2020-April 15, 2021...The last Oriole starter (excl. openers) to allow three or fewer hits in five consecutive starts was **Steve Barber**, who did so in a franchise-record seven consecutive outings from July 26, 1966-April 30 (G1), 1967...**Keegan Akin** did so in five starts (7.0 IP) from September 5 (G2), 2022-June 12, 2025.

RISPY BUSINESS: The Birds are batting .345 (10-for-29) with runners in scoring position, the third-highest clip in MLB behind the Dodgers (.393) and Tigers (.385).

- ♫ **Gunnar Henderson** is 2-for-5 with a double and three RBI with runners in scoring position so far this year...In 2025, Henderson posted a .342 RISP average (39-for-114), the ninth-highest mark in team history (min. 100 AB), including the highest clip since **Adam Jones** (.361 AVG) in 2017.

BOTTOMS UP: Baltimore nine-hole hitters are 7-for-18 (.389), the third-highest average in the majors behind Toronto (.529) and St. Louis (.438).

- ♫ **Blaze Alexander** is 4-for-11 (.364) with an RBI, while **Jeremiah Jackson** is 3-for-7 (.429) with an RBI.
- ♫ Oriole pitching has permitted five home runs this season, four of which have been hit by the bottom third of the opponents lineup.

STRIKE A POSE: Orioles pitching has struck out 53 batters to begin the season, tied for the second-most strikeouts through the first five games of a season in franchise history (since 1954) with 2024, trailing 2016 (54 K)...The team record through six games is also held by the 2016 club (62 K).

HIGH HEAT: Helsley threw a 102.1 mph ball to Josh Bell in Sunday's save against Minnesota... Entering play today, it is the fourth-hardest pitch thrown of the MLB season, trailing Mason Miller (102.5 mph - 2x & 102.3 mph).

- ♫ He's the third Oriole in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) to hit at least 102.1 mph, joining Félix Bautista (2022 & 2023) and Shintaro Fujinami (2023)...In his career, Helsley has hit at least 102.0 mph 101 times, including a career-high 104.2 mph on September 27, 2022.

WELCOME TO BIRDLAND: Eight players on the Opening Day roster have made their O's debut: **Blaze Alexander**, **Pete Alonso**, **Chris Bassitt**, **Shane Baz**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Anthony Nunez**, **Leody Taveras**, and **Taylor Ward**...Nunez made his major league debut on Saturday.

- ♫ Alonso, Bassitt, Helsley, and Taveras signed as free agents, Alexander (AZ), Baz (TB), and Ward (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while Nunez (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.

FOR THE BOYS: **Craig Albarnaz** became the eighth Orioles manager, full-time or interim, to win his debut with the team on Thursday...He was hired to be the 22nd manager in Orioles history and 19th full-time manager on October 27, 2025..."Alby" joins Baltimore from the Cleveland Guardians where he served as bench coach (2024) and associate manager (2025) under Stephen Vogt, who won American League Manager of the Year both seasons...Albarnaz also worked under Gabe Kapler with the San Francisco Giants as bullpen coach from 2020-23 after spending his first five seasons as a minor league coach in various roles in the Tampa Bay Rays organization.

- ♫ New to the coaching staff is **Jason Bourgeois** (First Base Coach), **Miguel Cairo** (Infield Coach), **Hank Conger** (Bullpen Coach), **Donnie Ecker** (Bench Coach), **Dustin Lind** (Hitting Coach), **Brady North** (Assistant Hitting Coach), and **Joe Singley** (Field Coordinator/Catching Coach).
- ♫ **Buck Britton** (Third Base Coach), **Drew French** (Pitching Coach), **Ryan Klimek** (Pitching Strategy Coach), and **Mitch Plassmeyer** (Assistant Pitching Coach) all return to the staff.

RANGER DANGER: The Birds and Rangers are meeting this week for the first three of six matchups this season...Baltimore travels to Globe Life Field for a three-game set from August 7-9.

- ♫ The Orioles are 281-229 (.551) against the Rangers since they moved to Texas in 1972, marking the O's fourth-highest winning percentage against any club during that period, trailing the Pirates (20-12, .625), Reds (14-10, .583), and Brewers (208-166, .556).
- ♫ Triple-A Norfolk Manager **Tim Federowicz** appeared in 163 career major league games, including 29 with the Rangers in 2019, when he made his final major league appearance on September 25.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his second start of the season and 104th of his career today in the series finale vs. Texas at Camden Yards...In his previous outing on March 26 vs. Minnesota, Rogers made his first career Opening Day start and picked up the win with 7.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and four walks with five strikeouts...Became the eighth Oriole starter (9th occurrence) to throw at least 7.0 scoreless innings on Opening Day, including the first since **John Means** on April 2, 2021 at Boston (W, 7.0 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 5 K)...He was the first to accomplish the feat at Camden Yards since **Dylan Bundy** on March 29, 2018 vs. Minnesota (ND, 7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 BB, 7 K).

TEXAS HEAT: Rogers is set to make his fifth career start against the Rangers, going 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (8 ER/25.2 IP) over his previous four outings...Two of those starts came last season with the Orioles, when Rogers tossed 8.0 shutout innings in a 6-0 win at Camden Yards on June 23 before recording 5.1 innings of two-run ball at Globe Life Field a week later on June 30.

Over 10 career starts vs. the AL West, Rogers is 2-3 with a 3.86 ERA (25 ER/58.1 IP) but has won his past two decisions against the division dating back to his win over Texas on June 23, 2025 in Baltimore...During that stretch, he holds a 1.32 ERA (4 ER/27.1 IP) and .156 opponents average (15-for-96) with three of his four outings being quality starts.

GOOD DAY SUNSHINE Rogers went 5-2 last season in seven day game starts, all of which were quality starts...He recorded a 1.33 ERA (7 ER/47.1 IP) in those games while holding opponents to a .193 average (33-for-171).

His 1.33 ERA on day games was the lowest mark in the majors (min. 7 GS) last season ahead of KC's Kris Bubic (1.48).

FOUR-SEAM FOCUS: Last season, Rogers featured his four-seam fastball 40.8 percent of the time and limited the opposition to a .158 (22-for-139) clip on the offering...The .158 opponent average was the second lowest among all MLB starters (min. 100 AB ending in pitch), trailing SEA's Bryan Woo (.153, 42-for-274).

Rogers threw 34 four-seam fastballs in his season debut (38.6%) on March 26, averaging 93.2 mph on the pitch while generating three whiffs.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).

From 7/6-8/30/25, made 10 straight starts of 6.0+ innings and allowing two or fewer runs, setting the franchise record.

Named 2025 American League Pitcher of the Month for August, going 4-1 with a 1.29 ERA (6 ER/42.0 IP) across six starts...Became the first Oriole to earn the honor since Corbin Burnes (September 2024) and the first Oriole left-hander since Erik Bedard (July 2007)...Became the first Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to make at least five starts and allow one or zero runs in each of the outings in a single month.

MVO: Rogers was voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002).

2025 IN REVIEW: Went 9-3 in 2025 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) on 70 hits (6 HR), 29 walks, and two hit batters with 103 strikeouts across 18 starts...Led the Orioles with a career-high 5.5 *Baseball Reference* Wins Above Replacement, the third-highest mark by an Oriole southpaw in franchise history (since 1954).

His ERA was second lowest in MLB behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.73), while his opponent average, opponent slugging percentage, and opponent OPS each led all pitchers (min. 100.0 IP).

On 8/1 at CHC, threw his first career complete game (L, 8.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 8 K), becoming the first Oriole starter to throw a complete game since Dean Kremer (9/23/22 vs. HOU, 9.0 IP)...Became the first Oriole to suffer a loss in a complete game since Chris Tillman (9/14/13 at TOR, 8.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).

Began the season on the 15-day Injured List after being placed on the IL on 3/27 (retroactive to 3/24) with right knee subluxation...Reinstated on 5/11 and optioned to Triple-A Norfolk that day.

FRIDAY'S STARTER: RHP KYLE BRADISH (0-1, 3.86)

LAST TIME OUT: Bradish suffered the loss on March 28 vs. Minnesota after throwing 4.2 innings, permitting three runs (2 ER) on two hits (1 HR), and three walks with four strikeouts...Has allowed five or fewer hits in each of his last nine starts dating to June 8, 2024.

vs. PITTSBURGH: Bradish is scheduled to make his third career start against the Pirates on Friday, going 0-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) in his previous two starts vs. the club...He faced Pittsburgh once in 2025 on September 9 and spun 7.0 innings of one-run ball in a 3-2 Baltimore win at Camden Yards.
