<u>TONIGHT'S TILT</u>...the Mariners continue a 6-game homestand today with the first of 3 games against the New York Yankees...Seattle also hosted the Toronto Blue Jays (0-3) on the homestand...following an off day on Thursday, the Mariners embark on a 10-game road trip against the San Diego Padres (3 G, 5/16-18), Chicago White Sox (3 G, 5/19-21) and the Houston Astros (4 G, 5/22-25)...tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call, with **Jen Mueller** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** and Mariners.com with **Rick Rizzs**, **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call.

<u>ODDS AND ENDS</u>...the Mariners suffered their second series sweep of the season (also: 4/4-6 at SF), losing yesterday's game 9-1 to the Blue Jays...Seattle is still 8-5 over its last 13 games, 10-6 over its last 16 games, 12-7 over its last 19 games, 14-8 over its last 22 games, 18-9 over its last 27 games...the Mariners 18-9 (.667) record is the <u>best in the Majors since April 9</u>.

- Best In The West The Mariners lead the American League West Division by 2.0 games over the second place Athletics (21-20) and Astros (20-19).
- Long Ball The Mariners are 21-10 (.677) when hitting a homer this season.
- Hey Now! Dave Sims returns to Seattle for the first time since taking the Yankees radio play-byplay announcer role this offseason...Sims spent 18 years (2007-24) as a key member of the Mariners
 broadcast team, calling games both on TV and radio.
- The Fireman Blows Out The Candles Right-hander Matt Brash celebrates his 27th birthday today.
- Tacoma Terror Infielder Cole Young, the Mariners No. 3 prospect (*MLB Pipeline*), was named the Pacific Coast League Player of the Week today...Young hit safely in all 6 games he played, batting .455 (10x22) with 8 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 4 RBI and a 1.357 OPS.
- Rehab Update Right-handed pitchers George Kirby and Jackson Kowar both made rehab appearances with Triple-A Tacoma...Kirby started on Saturday, tossing 3.0 innings with 5 strikeouts in his 2nd rehab start and Kowar recorded a 1-2-3 inning in relief of Kirby in his first outing at Tacoma.
- Hancock's Signature Emerson Hancock is 1-0 with a 3.52 ERA (9 ER, 23.0 IP), 6 walks and 17 strikeouts over his last 4 starts (4/17-c), with the Mariners winning each game.
- Julio is Warming Julio Rodríguez is batting .304 (14x46) with 8 runs, 1 double, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and a .803 OPS over his last 11 games (4/29-c).

STERLING BACKSTOP...Cal Raleigh is batting .241 (34x141) with 26 runs, 7 doubles, 12 home runs, 25 RBI and 4 stolen bases, getting on base at a .371 clip and slugging .546 (.917 OPS) in 39 games this season...he ranks among the MLB leaders in home runs (T-3rd), slugging percentage (12th), OPS (13th) and fWAR (T-8th, 2.2).

<u>J.P. HITS A LOT</u>...shortstop **J.P. Crawford** went 2-for-4 with a double in yesterday's game...he recently had his career-high 16-game hitting streak snapped (4/19-5/9)...since April 9, he is batting .333 (33x99) with 14 runs, 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 1 stolen base and 13 walks, getting on base at a .416 clip and slugging .465 (.881 OPS)...overall this season, J.P. ranks 7th in the AL in OBP (.394).

<u>A TOP RANKED OFFENSE</u>...Seattle batters <u>lead the Majors</u> in walk rate (10.6%), ranking 3rd in the Majors in walks (161), trailing the Diamondbacks (162) and Yankees (162)...across the Majors, the Mariners rank 6th in on-base percentage (.333), T-3rd in OPS+ (120), T-9th in OPS (.739), 6th in runs-per-game (4.92), T-5th in home runs (53), 7th in stolen bases (43) and 4th in hit-by-pitches (22) this season.

MATILDA'S DAD...Andrés Muñoz leads the American League with 13 saves...in 18 appearances this season, the reigning American League Reliever of the Month is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 18.0 IP) with 7 hits allowed, 1 run allowed (unearned), 8 walks (2 intentional) and 25 strikeouts, sporting a 0.833 WHIP and 12.5 strikeouts-per-9 innings rate...his 1.9 bWAR leads MLB relievers and ranks T-6th among all pitchers.

<u>OFFENSIVE CONTRIBUTORS</u>...the Mariners have received offensive contributions up and down their batting order this season...**Jorge Polanco** is batting .327 (33x101) with 16 runs, 6 doubles, 9 home runs, 28 RBI and a 1.026 OPS in 30 games this season...**Dylan Moore** hit his 7th homer of the season yesterday and is batting .296 (16x54) with 2 doubles, 5 home runs, 10 RBI, 5 stolen bases and a .933 OPS over his last 14 games (4/15-c)...**Rowdy Tellez** is batting .275 (14x51) with 2 doubles, 5 homers, 15 RBI and a .935 OPS over his last 20 games (4/17-c)...**Leo Rivas** is batting .341 (14x41) with 11 runs, 1 double, 4 stolen bases and 10 walks with a .836 OPS in 20 games this season.

<u>SERIES WIN STREAK SNAPPED</u>...Seattle's streak of 9 consecutive series won was snapped in their last series...the Mariners had won 9 straight series since April 7: vs. Houston (2-1), vs. Texas (3-0), at Cincinnati (2-1), at Toronto (2-1), at Boston (2-1), vs. Miami (2-1), vs. Los Angeles-AL (2-0), at Texas (2-1) and at the Athletics (2-1)...the 9 consecutive series victories marked their longest string of consecutive series wins since they won a franchise-record 14 (or 15) consecutive series from July 27-Sept. 20, 2001...one of those 15 series was a win in 1 game at Anaheim on Sept. 10, 2001.

<u>HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS</u>...the Mariners are at T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, 5/8-5/11) and New York Yankees (3 G, 5/12-5/14)...remaining promotions on the homestand include, **Star Wars Night** tonight and **Asian American, Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander Heritage Night** tomorrow.

<u>VEDDER CUP ON DECK...</u> following the current series with the Yankees, the Mariners will travel to San Diego for the first official installment of the "**Vedder Cup**"...it was announced on March 14 that the two clubs would play annually for the Vedder Cup in their rivalry series, beginning this season...the winner of the series will take home the Vedder Cup Trophy, featuring a guitar provided by **Eddie Vedder...**as part of the series, both the Padres and Mariners are making annual donations to the EB Research Partnership.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...outfielder Randy Arozarena has an active career-high 33-game on-base streak (3/31-c), batting .252 (30x119) with 15 runs, 9 doubles, 4 home runs, 23 walks and 8 stolen bases, getting on base at a .395 clip and slugging .429 (.823 OPS), and...YOU MAY ALSO KNOW...that his streak is the 2nd longest active streak in the Majors, trailing only Kyle Schwarber-PHI (46 G) and is the longest streak by a Mariners players since Robinson Canó's 34-game on-base streak from April 30-June 5, 2016, but...DID YOU KNOW?...that his streak is tied for the 6th-longest streak in a single season by a Cuban-born player in Major League history?...he trails Yordan Alvarez-HOU (36 G, March 30-May 16, 2023) and Tony Oliva-MIN (36 G, April 22-June 2, 1970) for the all-time record.

ABOUT EMERSON HANCOCK...

- The 25-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 6th start of the season tonight and his 1st against the Yankees... he is also scheduled to make the 21st start of his career and 1st career start against the Yankees.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (6th overall) of the 2020 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Scott Hunter on June 25, 2020.
- Spent 3 seasons at the University of Georgia, 2018-20...in 2020, was named Vince Dooley Athlete of the Year as the top male student-athlete at the University of Georgia.
- Was named to CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team in 2020.
- LAST TIME OUT...ND on 5/6 at ATH, he threw 6.0 innings, giving up 4 hits on 2 runs, with 2 strikeouts and 2 walks...Hancock has thrown 5.0+ innings in his last 4 starts, and has 14th career starts with at least 5.0 innings pitched, with the Mariners moved to 12-2 in those starts.
- LOCKING IT IN ... his last 3 starts (4/23 at BOS, 4/30 vs. LAA, 5/6 at ATH) is the 2nd time in Hancock's career throwing 6.0+ innings in 3 straight appearances (last: 2024 season, 4/13 at CHC, 4/21 at COL and 4/26 at ARI).
- CAREER DAYS...tossed a career-high 7 strikeouts in his road start on 4/24 at BOS with 6.0 innings pitched allowing 2 runs on 5 hits and 2 walks...on 6/13/24 vs. Chicago-AL, tossed a career-high 7.0 innings allowing 2 runs on 6 hits (2 HR) with 2 walks and 1 strikeout...threw a career-high 99 pitches on 4/30 vs. LAA allowing 9 hits on 3 runs with 4 SO and 2 walks.
- HOME WARRIOR...in his last home start (4/30 vs. LAA) he threw 6.0 innings for the 4th time in his career...in 8 home starts at T-Mobile Park last season, he held a 3.61 ERA (17 ER, 42.1 IP) with 15 walks, and 26 strikeouts...he allowed 3-or-less runs in 7 of the 8 starts and went 5.0+ innings in 5 of them.
- SUCCESS ON THE ROAD ... in his 9 road starts since the 2023 season, Hancock is 3-1 with 29 strikeouts and just 8 walks in 42.1 innings pitched... he is 1 of 3 pitchers (George Kirby and Bryce Miller) in Mariners history to have 29 of more strikeouts and 8 or less walks in the first 9 road starts of their career...he has thrown 5.0+ innings in 6 of those 9 starts, with the Mariners 8-1 in road games that Hancock has started in.

Hancock is making his 1st career start against the Yankees...here is how Emerson has fared against current Yankees batters he has faced: **PLAYER AVG** AB н HR **RBI** BB SO C. Bellinger 0 .000 3 0 T. Grisham .000 2 0 0 0 0

- BEEN A WHILE...his first 2 road starts of the season (4/17 at CIN and 4/23 at BOS) marked just the 2nd time in his career making back-to-back starts on the road (last: 8/15/23 at KC and 8/20/23 at HOU)...the Mariners are now 4-0 in those starts, with Hancock throwing a combined 18.0 innings pitched, allowing 9 runs on 21 hits with 14 strikeouts and just 2 walks.
- QUICK TRIP TO TACOMA ... after his 1st major league start of the season, 3/30 vs. DET, Hancock was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma ... between his two starts with the Rainiers, he allowed 4 runs on 9 hits (1 HR), 2 walks, 2 hit by pitches, and struck out 12 in 9.2 innings of work...between the 2024 and 2025 seasons, Hancock holds a 3.46 ERA (40 ER, 104.0 IP) and is 7-4 with Tacoma across 19 game starts.
- QUALITY AND QUANTITY...in his last 4 starts (4/17-c) of, Hancock has collected 3 QS, and is 1 of 13 starters in the MLB with 3+ QS...during that span, his 23.0 innings thrown are the most in a 4-game span in his career, with his 17 strikeouts the 2nd most strikeouts in a 4-game span in his career (18 SO, 4/7/24-4/26/24).
- LAST 10...in his last 10 starts (6/13/24-c), the Mariners are 7-3 with Hancock collecting 4 QS, throwing 5.0+ innings in 8 starts, and allowing 2-orless walks in 9 of his last 10 starts
- THE VERY FIRST ONE...recorded his 1st career win on 4/1/24 vs. Cleveland at T-Mobile Park...tossed 5.1 innings, gave up 4 hits (1 home run) and 3 earned runs with 1 strikeout.
- THE DEBUT...made MLB debut on 8/9/23 against the San Diego Padres, allowing just 1 run on 2 hits and 3 walks with 3 strikeouts... became just the 6th starting pitcher in franchise history to pitch 5.0+ innings and allow 2-or-fewer hits in a Major League debut, joining Pat Rice, Ken Cloude, Taijuan Walker. Roenis Elías and Bryce Miller.
- NO PLACE LIKE HOME...in 11 games started at home for Tacoma he owns a 2.44 ERA over 66.1 IP with 46 strikeouts and 24 BB...he is also holding opponents to a .212 average (51x241) while also holding a 1.13 WHIP.
- THE COMPLETE PACKAGE...on July 21, 2024 vs. Reno, Hancock threw a 9.0 inning complete game shutout...it was the only 9.0 inning complete game shutout in Triple-A in 2024 and only 1 of 2 in the full-season minor leagues this year...there have only been 2 complete game shutouts in the Pacific Coast League since the start of 2019.
- PCL PITCHER OF THE MONTH...was awarded Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Month for June 2024...held a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA in 4 starts as he allowed 2 runs on 14 hits with 7 walks over 21.1 innings...he tallied 17 strikeouts and held opponents to a .187 (14x75) average... after allowing 2 runs in his first inning of June, he did not allow another run in his next 20.1 innings during the month with Tacoma.
- HOME SWEET GEORGIA... is 1 of 5 players in MLB history born in Cairo, GA, the same birthplace as Jackie Robinson, Ernie Riles, Willie Harris and Hurston Waldrep...was the 11th Georgia Bulldog in school history to be drafted in the first round...he became the highest Georgia selection since Derek Lilliquist went 6th overall in 1987...1 of 7 Bulldogs to play in MLB in 2024 (also: Jonathan Cannon-CWS, Kyle Farmer-MIN, Jared Walsh-TEX, Alex Wood-OAK, Zac Kristofak-LAA and Aaron Schunk-COL).
