AT HOME: The team has gone 51-29 at home, going 17-8-1 in series play, including this series.....the Brewers have won 50+ home games for the eighth time in franchise history and first time since going 51-30 in 2018.....had a season-high 7-game winning streak from 8/8-8/22.

ON THE ROAD: The team went a Major League-best 45-36 on the road, going 13-11-2 in series play.....went 35-18 in the last 53 road games.....had a franchise-record-tying 9-game winning streak from 7/23-8/16.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 25 replay challenges this season, going 17-8.....their last challenge (won) came 9/24 at San Diego as an out call at second base involving Jackson Chourio was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have now made the nostseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three straight seasons.....the team has won the NL Central four times in the last five seasons and three years in a row.....Milwaukee was just two games away from qualifying for the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers have 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25).....this does not include 2020.....entering 2025, the Brewers, Dodgers and Astros were the only teams with 86+ wins in the last seven full seasons. the Brewers have 762 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: All-Star Freddy Peralta, 29, is going to be making his career-high 33rd start of the season and second against the Reds.....he last started last Monday at San Diego and had no decision in a 5-4, 11-inning loss (5ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 1bk, 76 pitches)....the team is 19-13 in his starts.....he has 13 quality starts....opponents are batting .191 (121-for-634, 20hr).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through 2024 with club options for 2025 and 2026.

RIGHT SAID FRED: Peralta is the team's first 17-game winner since Zach Davies (17) in 2017 and looks to become the first 18-game winner since Chris Capuano (18) in 2005... Note: Salid FRED: Per alta is the learn's first 17-game will less since thins capital to the leads the NL in wins (17) and ranks among the leaders in opponent AVG (2nd, 1911), H/9IP (2nd, 6.23), ERA (4th, 2.68), WHIP (4th, 1.07), K/9IP (5th, 1.06) and strikeouts (T6th, 201).....he has made 30+ starts for the third consecutive season (30, 32, 32).....he has 200+ strikeouts for the third consecutive season (210, 200, 201).....he was named NL Pitcher of the Month for August (5gs, 4-0, 0.32era).....he had a streak of 30.0 consecutive scoreless innings from 8/5-9/10, the second-longest streak in franchise history behind **Teddy Higuera** (32.0 in 1987).....Peralta has 1,150 career strikeouts, trailing only **Yovani Gallardo** (1,226) and **Ben Sheets** (1,206) on the all-time franchise list.

CAREER: Is 70-42 with a 3.58 ERA and 1 save in 210 games/161 starts (929ip, 370er)....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-25)....is 62-40 with a 3.56 ERA as a starter (845ip, 334er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021 and 2025.....was the Opening Day starter in 2024 and 2025.
