BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue an eight-game homestand into the All-Star Break against first place teams in the National League Central (Milwaukee) and East (Atlanta). The Cardinals dropped the opener last night 4-3 to the Brewers and will play a doubleheader today. The Cardinals are playing their second doubleheader this season after a twinbill vs. Cincinnati at Great American Ballpark on May 23. The last time the Cardinals and Brewers played a doubleheader was Sept. 25, 2020 at Busch Stadium.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play in 3rd place in the National League Central, 8.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and two games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are a half-game out of the 3rd wild card position. The Cardinals are playing a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (2-1 at Braves; 2-1 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers 0-1; and 3 vs. Braves).

ZIMMERMANN SELECTED; FERNANDEZ OPTIONED; RAJIC TRANSFERRED TO 60-DAY I.L.: Following last night's game, the Cardinals optioned RHP **Ryan Fernandez** to Memphis (AAA). Prior to today's game LHP **Bruce Zimmermann** was selected from Memphis (AAA) and in a corresponding move, RHP **Max Rajcic** was transferred from the 15-day to the 60-day Injured List. Zimmermann was 5-3 with a 3.78 ERA in 15 starts for the Redbirds and last played in the Major Leagues for the Brewers on Sept. 23, 2025 at San Diego.

DOBBINS APPOINTED AS 27TH PLAYER: The Cardinals 27th player appointment for today's doubleheader is RHP **Hunter Dobbins**, who was acquired from the Boston Red Sox in a four-player deal for **Willson Contreras** this off-season. Dobbins is 1-0 with a 3.63 ERA in four appearances this season. He made two starts and two relief appearances, including his first Major League save, a 3.2-inning performance vs. Chicago-NL on Sunday Night Baseball on May 31.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: The Cardinals are 1-3 when facing today's Game 1 starting pitcher **Jacob Misiorowski**. The lone win came in his only appearance at Busch Stadium on Sept. 19, 2025. St. Louis hit the "The Miz" for two runs on five hits over 3.2 innings in a 7-1 Cardinals victory. It was the second shortest start of the Brewers' All-Star pitcher's career.

FOUR SCORES AND 24 GAMES AGO: The magic number for the Cardinals is four when it comes to the Milwaukee Brewers. During manager Oliver Marmol's tenure, the Cardinals are 19-5 against the Brewers when scoring four or more runs with a 10-2 mark at Busch Stadium. St. Louis is 8-32 when scoring three runs or less vs. Milwaukee since 2022.

LIVING UP TO HIS NAME: Yesterday's multi-walk effort was the 5th straight game **Jordan Walker** drew a base on balls, extending his career-best streak. Walker's previous high was a three-game streak five times. **Iván Herrera** has the Cardinals season-high streak of nine games (3/131-4/10), tied for the 2nd-longest streak in MLB behind **Nick Kurtz** (ATH) who ran off 20 games with a free pass this season. Walker ranks 4th in MLB in July on-base percentage (.500) trailing **James Wood** (.600, WSH), **Otto López** (.520, MIA) and **Garrett Mitchell** (.520, MIL).

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather Johnny O'Brien was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Bryan Torres originally signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent in 2015 and played parts of five minor league seasons in the Brewers minor league system (2015-19)...played two seasons for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association (2022-23), where he was back-to-back Independent League Batting Champion (.374 and .370).

Matthew Liberatore earned his first MLB win on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Stadium.

Andre Pallante struck out **Christian Yelich** (April 15, 2022 at Milwaukee) for his first career strike-out, and **Matt Svanson** fanned **Isaac Collins** for his first strikeout (April 27, 2025 at St. Louis).

Jacob Misiorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers Baseball Ops Special Asst. and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the President of Baseball Ops & 2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Yadier Molina** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 23, 2004 at Milwaukee off **Matt Wise**.

William Contreras's older brother, **Willson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2005-08).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and post-game shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Brewers Sr. Special Asst to the GM **Carlos Villanueva** pitched in 35 games for St. Louis in 2015.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Drew Rom was acquired by the Cardinals from the Orioles in the four-player Jack Flaherty trade in 2023. He earned his first MLB win with St. Louis at Baltimore on Sept. 13, 2023.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

TONIGHT'S GAME 2 STARTER:

- **Was appointed as additional player for today's day/night doubleheader and has been tabbed to start Game 2 tonight**
- Will be making his 3rd start of the season and 5th appearance. Also marks his 18th career appearance (14th start) since making his MLB debut last season.
- Dobbins's last MLB appearance was a June 11 start at Citi Field, scattering seven hits for three runs over 4.1 IP for a no-decision in a 5-4 loss to the Mets.
- Pitched 5.0 in relief and won on June 5 vs. the Reds at Busch III, his longest relief outing by a Cardinal since **Michael McGreevy** hurled 5.2 scoreless vs. NYM (May 4, 2025-G2).
- The Cardinals have won three of four games he's appeared in this season.
- Has a 1.04 ERA (8.2 IP) at Busch Stadium (both night games), but 6.23 ERA (8. IP) on the road (both matinees).
- Began the season on the 15-day injured list (recovery from right knee surgery).
- Acquired by the Cardinals along with minor league RHP **Blake Aita** and RHP **Yohoiker Fajardo** from the Boston Red Sox in a four-player deal for 1B **Willson Contreras**, Dec. 21, 2025.
- Has gone 5-1 with a 3.79 ERA over 12 starts at Memphis (AAA) this season. Pitched 59.2 innings with 33 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP.

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, June 30 vs. Charlotte (AAA-White Sox): W, 10-5; 5.2 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO - 91 pitches

- Scattered a season-high nine hits for five runs (four earned) over 5.2 innings in the win as the Redbirds bounced out to a 9-1 lead after 4.0 innings.

2026 NOTES:

LONGHAUL DRIVER: Pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering four singles for the win vs. CIN (6/5), his first win since 6/8/25 vs. NYY w/BOS. It was the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher in 2026 and since Michael McGreevy threw 5.2 IP vs. NYM (5/4/25-G2).

HUNTING RARE FEATS: *Became the first Cardinals pitcher in franchise history to record a save and a win in his first two relief outings with the club pitching 3.0 innings or more in each.*

EARLY RISER: Has pitched 5.0 innings or more in eight of his 12 starts with Memphis (AAA) with one quality start.

THREE OUTTA FOUR AINT BAD: Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings at Iowa (5/20) in a no decision the Redbirds lost 3-2

SEVENS: Struck out a season-high seven batters twice (4/7 at Charlotte & 5/26 at Omaha).

CAREER:

- Was an 8th round pick in the 2021 Draft by the Boston Red Sox out of Texas Tech University, the same alma mater of Cardinals first base coach **Stubby Clapp**.
- Posted a career 23-17 record with a 3.84 ERA over 78 minor league appearances (75 starts).

DOBBINS vs. MILWAKUEE

- Makes his second career appearance and first career start against the Brewers.
- Faced Milwaukee in relief on May 28, 2025 at American Family Field with Boston, his first career relief appearance after seven consecutive starts to open his career with the Red Sox. Was charged with a blown save with 2 runs over 3.0 innings.
- Lifetime 2-0 with a 3.43 ERA (21.0 IP), one save, and 20 strikeouts in five games (two starts) vs. the NL Central Division.
