STAND UP! The Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand by being swept in three games by the Dodgers from Monday-Wednesday...tonight, they will begin a three-game series with Colorado through the weekend.

Despite the three-game slide, the Twins have won six of their last 10 and eight of their last 14. Twins are 6-3 this season following an off-day...their six wins are March 28 at Baltimore, April 21 at New York-NL, May 5 at Washington, May 12 vs. Miami, May 22 at Boston and June 18 at Texas.

GROWING PAINS: The Twins lost to the Dodgers on Wednesday night by a score of 4-3, making them 7-13 in one-run games this season...Joe Ryan (5-4) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and nine strikeouts...all four runs allowed came in the second and third innings as the Dodgers were held scoreless for the final six innings...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Victor Caratini and Tristan Gray...the attendance was 39,853, marking a 2026 high and a sellout.

ROCK(IES) AND A HARD PLACE: The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 28th, 29th and 30th times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 15-12 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 6-6 at Coors Field (2008, '14, '23 & '25) and 7-5 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22 & '24).

These two last met for three games in Denver from July 18-20, 2025 as the Twins lost the first two and won game three.

The Twins last hosted the Rockies from June 10-12, 2024, winning two of the three games. In 10 career games against the Rockies, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with one double, two triples, three home runs, seven RBI, four walks and a 1.122 OPS...in his last five games against the Rox, he is 9-for-21 (.429) with five extra-base hits.

In eight career games against the Rockies, Kody Clemens is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with two doubles, two triples, one home run, six RBI and a 1.279 OPS.

In five career games vs. Colorado, Royce Lewis is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with one double, four home runs, six RBI and a 1.350 OPS...his first career two-homer game came at Coors Field last season, on July 20...the first home run was a 450-foot solo shot off Ryan Rolison, the longest of Lewis' career.

CHAMPAGNE WITH MY CAMPAIGN: Updated voting for the MLB All-Stars were released yesterday and Byron Buxton will move on to phase two of the voting...Buck received 1,789,018 votes in the phase one process, joining him is Aaron Judge (2,567,404), Mike Trout (2,511,587), Cody Bellinger (1,614,585), Daulton Varsho (1,336,544) and Jesus Sánchez (1,260,762)...phase two voting will start on Monday, June 29 at 11 am (CT) and will conclude on Thursday, July 2 at 11 am (CT)...below are Byron Buxton's rankings among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories on the season:

ADDITIONALLY...he ranks tied for second among that same group in RBI (41).

PULLED UP WITH A MILLION TRUCKS, LOOKIN', SMELLIN', FEELIN LIKE A MILLION BUX: All 25 of Byron Buxton's home runs have come in his last 56 games, since April 13...over his last full calendar year, Buck has hit 43 home runs in 133 games (587 plate appearances)...over his last 162 games, he has hit 51 home runs in 713 plate appearances (since May 8, 2025).

AREA KODES: Over his last 39 games, Kody Clemens has posted an .841 OPS and a .532 slugging percentage...in that span, he has 12 doubles, two triples, eight home runs and 21 RBI...on the season, he ranks third on the team in homers, trailing Buxton (25) and Lee (13).

ALWAYS BRING THE RACKET LIKE VENUS AND SERENA: Despite striking out 14 times on Wednesday night, the Twins have struck out just 150 times this month, the second-fewest in baseball, trailing Arizona (140)...by comparison, in May, they were tied for fourth-most strikeouts in baseball (252) and in March/April they ranked tied for ninth-most in MLB (279). Brooks Lee leads the AL this month in lowest strikeout percentage at 8.7%...among all MLB players in June (minimum of 70 PA), he ranks fifth-lowest, trailing Luis Arraez (4.5%), Jung Hoo Lee (5.9%), Nico Hoerner (6.8%) and Otto Lopez (8.6%).

GET BACK, GET BACK, YOU DON'T KNOW ME LIKE THAT: Through 22 games this month, the Twins are slugging .471, which ranks second-best in baseball, trailing only Colorado (.485). Twins have homered in all but two of their last 19 games since June 4, hitting 35 in that span...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (41).

WHO'S YOUR HOUSEKEEPER AND WHAT YOU KEEP IN THAT HOUSE: Despite the three-game sweep from the Dodgers this week, the Twins have won three of their last five series at home.

In 34 home games this season, Byron Buxton is hitting .311 (42-for-135) with 14 home runs, a .689 slugging percentage and a 1.069 OPS...he has homered four times in his last eight home games.

Kody Clemens has reached base safely in each of his last nine home games...additionally, he has reached base safely in 25 of his last 26 home games, hitting .302 (29-for-96) with eight doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and a .910 OPS in that span.

WHAT IN THE WORLD IS IN THAT BAG, WHAT YOU GOT IN THAT BAG: Over his last eight games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .433 (13-for-30) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, a .469 on-base percentage, a .700 slugging percentage and 1.169 OPS.

In 18 games this month, he is hitting .333 (19-for-57) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, six walks and a .915 OPS...his batting average ranks seventh-best in the AL among players with at least 65 plate appearances this month.

GOOD BUSINESS, GOOD BIZ-NASS: Twins drew 105,214 over the three-game series vs. the Dodgers earlier in the week (35,071 avg)...the finale on Wednesday night (Ryan vs. Ohtani) drew 39,853 and was a sellout; was the highest attendance at Target Field since July 11, 2025 vs. Pittsburgh, when they drew 40,100 (Ryan vs. Skenes)...marked their highest series total since September 6-8, 2019 vs. Cleveland (106,371).

CEO, YOU DON'T HAVE TO SEE ID: MLB officially announced yesterday the honorary coaches and staffs for the 2026 All-Star Game in Philadelphia...Derek Shelton will coach on John Schneider's AL team...marks Shelly's second coaching appearance in the All-Star Game after serving on Rob Thomson's NL staff at the 2023 Midsummer Classic in Seattle.

BIG BEATS, HIT STREETS, SEE GANGSTERS ROAMIN' AND PARTIES DON'T STOP 'TIL EIGHT IN THE MORNIN': Ludacris will perform on the field postgame tonight...the concert will begin approximately 15 minutes after final out.

- Taj Bradley is slated to make his 15th start of the season and 88th start (90th game) of his career.
- This will be Taj's second career start against the Rockies...in his lone start vs. Colorado on March 30, 2025 with Tampa Bay, Taj earned the win in a quality start effort, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts.
- In his last outing on June 20 at Arizona, Bradley earned the win, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts, as the Twins throttled the Diamondbacks 16-8 at Chase Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Taj made his 14th start of the season on June 20 at Arizona opposite right-hander Zac Gallen...earn his team-leading sixth win of the season, allowing two runs on three hits — including a two-run homer from Jorge Barrosa — in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts, as the Twins scored a team-high 16 runs en route to a 16-8 victory at Chase Field.

- Has allowed a home run in three consecutive starts dating back to June 9 at Detroit and in four of six starts since returning from the Injured List on May 23; allowed a home run in just two of his first eight starts prior to the injury.
- Six wins through his first 14 games of the season are tied for the most in his career in that span (earned six wins through his first 14 games of 2024 with Tampa Bay).

TWO STARTS AGO: Taj made his 13th start of the season on June 14 vs. St. Louis opposite right-hander Michael McGreevy...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits — including a pair of homers from Alec Burleson (solo) and JJ Wetherholt (two-run) — in 6.2 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts, as the Twins rallied to take the series from the Cardinals with a 5-4 win at Target Field.

- The outing marked his longest since pitching a season-high 7.0 innings on April 29 vs. Seattle.
- Allowed multiple homers in back-to-back games (3 HR on June 9 at Detroit), his first time doing so as a Twin and third time in his career (September 5-10, 2024 and September 8-13, 2023, both with Tampa Bay).

MOUNTAIN MAN: Taj is slated to make his second career start against Colorado, and first as a Minnesota Twin...made his lone start against the Rockies on March 30, 2025 with Tampa Bay, when he earned the win in a quality start effort, allowing two runs on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in a 6-4 Rays victory at Tropicana Field.

- He has faced eight Colorado batters (including players on the Injured List); they are hitting a combined .167 (6-for-36) with one home run (Edouard Julien), three walks and nine strikeouts.

OH BOY, HERE COMES THE NATIONAL LEAGUE: In 25 career starts in Interleague Play, Taj is 7-7 with a 5.04 ERA (130.1 IP, 73 ER), 45 walks, 142 strikeouts, 22 home runs allowed, a 1.27 WHIP and a .242 (121-for-501) BAA...he has made 12 home starts against National League opponents, combining to go 4-3 with a 4.87 ERA (64.2 IP, 35 ER), 20 walks and 73 strikeouts.

- In six Interleague starts as a Twin, Taj is 2-0 with a 4.13 ERA (32.2 IP, 15 ER), 12 walks, 36 strikeouts, a 1.07 WHIP and a .190 (23-for-121) BAA...the Twins have a record of 3-3 in those contests.

SETTLING IN: Taj has fared better against National League opponents over his last 13 starts compared to his first 12, and the game results have reflected that...in his first 12 outings against the National League, Taj's team posted an overall record of 4-8, compared to 8-5 in his last 13...below are some more of his numbers against the National League during those spans:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-16 with a 4.93 ERA (224.2 IP, 123 ER), 74 walks, 252 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP in 42 career home starts compared to 13-14 with a 4.55 ERA (237.1 IP, 120 ER), 100 walks, 242 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in 47 road appearances (45 starts).

- SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-1 record with a 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks, 34 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP in five home starts compared to a 5-2 record with a 4.30 ERA (46.0 IP, 22 ER), 22 walks, 50 strikeouts and a 1.39 WHIP in nine road starts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .222/.307/.431 (37-for-167) with eight doubles, nine home runs, 21 walks and 53 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .252/.319/.378 (131-for-127) with seven doubles, three home runs, 11 walks and 31 strikeouts.

LIMITING THE DAMAGE: While Taj has often found himself pitching out of the stretch, he has navigated well with runners on base and in scoring position...this season, opponents are hitting .218 (26-for-119) with runners on base, which is the seventh lowest such BAA in the American League (min. 100 at-bats)...he also ranks 12th in the American League in BAA with RISP (min. 60 at-bats), holding opponents to a .222 (14-for-63) average with men in scoring position.

- His 36 strikeouts with runners on base are tied for 11th most in the American League.

THE ARSENAL: So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS: His strikeout percentage of 32.5% with the cutter is tied for second highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball (min. 50 plate appearances), only behind Philadelphia's José Alvarado (41.8%)...he also ranks second with the cutter in whiff percentage (36.9) and seventh in BAA (.211).

CAREER NOTES

- On April 29, 2026 vs. Seattle, Bradley threw a career-high, 114 pitches, in 7.0 innings against the Mariners; the 114 pitches were the most pitches by a Twin since Kenta Maeda threw 115 on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee.
- Made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2, 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER) with 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- Acquired by the Minnesota Twins from Tampa Bay on July 31 in exchange for RHP Griffin Jax.
- In 2025, made the Rays Opening rotation for the first time as the team's third starter...posted a 4.61 ERA (111.1 IP, 57 ER) with 44 walks and 95 strikeouts over 21 starts.
- In 2024, went 8-11 with a 4.11 ERA (138.0 IP, 63 ER) and 154 Ks over 25 starts with the Rays...set career highs in nearly every major category while leading the club in strikeouts, wins and quality starts (T-1st, 10).
