TODAY'S GAME: Following their final off day of the season, the Giants return to Oracle Park tonight to face the Rockies for one last series this year...the series kicks off SF's last homestand of the year, which also sees the Dbacks come to town for three games this weekend (Friday-Sunday)...the Giants went 6-1 on the road trip that included a four-game sweep at Coors Field and winning two of three in Arizona over the weekend.

DOUBLE-DIGITS: SF's 6-1 effort in their last road trip was partly due to its explosive offense, with the Giants recording at least 10 hits in five of those seven games and 73 hits overall...the 73 hits are SF's most over any seven-game span since also recording 73 from September 10-16 last year...in contrast, the Rockies have gone 1-6 in their last two series, including losing four games where they had 10-plus hits...Colorado's .508 (32-31) winning percentage when recording at least 10 hits is the lowest in the Majors, with the MLB average in this situation being .726 (*Stats, LLC*).

GIVE ME FIVE: The Giants have controlled the season series against the Rockies after starting the year on a five-game winning streak and winning each of their last five heading into the final series...the two such streaks are tied for most MLB against a single opponent this year (*Stats, LLC*).

DO YOU REMEMBER?: With Sunday's win, the Giants improved to a 14-10 record in September and are just one win away from clinching their first winning month since April (14-7)...since 2020, the Giants' have dominated in the month of September, ranking near the top of the Majors in numerous categories including ERA (3.52, 2nd), on-base percentage (.343, 2nd), batting average (.264, 4th), slugging percentage (.452, 4th) and runs per game (5.12, 7th)...SF's .627 winning percentage (47-28) in September since 2020 is tied with the Braves for second-highest in MLB, trailing only the Dodgers (52-22, .703).

MR. RELIABLE: RHP Logan Webb takes the mound for SF tonight to make his 32nd start of the season...the right-hander has been extremely dependable throughout his career with SF, throwing at least 5.0 innings in 57 of his 79 appearances...the Giants have gone 42-15 (.737) in those outings, the best team winning percentage in the Majors (min. 50g) in that split (*Stats, LLC*).

VERSATILITY: According to Sports Info Solutions, Webb is one of four pitchers in MLB to have a pitch mix featuring three pitches that he uses at least 30% of the time (sinker: 32.8%, slider: 32.7%, changeup: 31.5%)...he joins Noé Ramirez (4-seam, changeup, curveball), Jason Adam (4-seam, slider, changeup) and Steve Cishek (four-seam, sinker, slider) as the other three.

ÉL DE BEJUMA! The Giants have looked like a whole different team this season when IF Thairo Estrada drives in runners, posting a .725 (29-11) winning percentage as opposed to a 40-52 (.435) record when he doesn't (see chart to the right)...Estrada's 60 RBI are a career-best and third most on the squad, trailing IF Wilmer Flores (69) and OF Joc Pederson (66).

GETTING BACK TO EVEN: With just nine games remaining on the Giants' schedule, they'll need to go 6-3 to finish the season at .500.

FAMILIAR FACES: Each of the Giants' final nine games will come vs. NL West opponents, facing both Colorado, Arizona and San Diego for three games apiece...within the division, the Giants have gone 27-40 (.403) with a -28 run differential.

ON THE MOUND: San Francisco pitchers have posted a 3.84 ERA over 153 games this year, the fifth-best earned run average in the National League behind the Dodgers (2.83), Braves (3.45), Mets (3.56) and Cardinals (3.77)...Giants pitchers have allowed just 128 homers this year, tied with the Astros for fewest in MLB and an improvement from last year's 151 mark.

2022 RECORD: 14-9, 2.93 ERA

LAST TIME OUT: Webb picked up his 14th win of the campaign last Wednesday at Coors Field in SF's 6-1 victory...he twirled five hitless innings before allowing a one-out single in the 6th to Sean Bouchard that ended up ending his day as the Giants are being cautious with Webb's innings since he's already set career highs for innings pitched and starts this season...Webb struck out five, did not walk a batter and hit one batter in the 66-pitch effort, the lowest pitch count he turned in during any start this season.

SETTING THE PACE: Webb's 14 wins are a career-best, surpassing his 11 from last season...he has already thrown a regular season career-high 187.1 innings this year, up from the 148.1 innings he threw last year...if you include last year's postseason starts though, Webb worked a total of 163.0 innings in 2021...his start today will be his 32nd this year, also a career-high surpassing the 26 regular season starts he made last year.

YOUNG, WILD & FREE: With Webb making his 32nd start this year today and **LHP Carlos Rodón** on tap to make his 31st start of the year on Thursday, it would mark the first time since 2015 that the Giants had two starters ages 29 or younger each make at least 31 starts in a season...in 2015, **Madison Bumgarner** and **Chris Heston** were the two...if Rodón gets to 32 starts, it would be the first time since 2012 that two Giants starters 29 and younger each made 32 starts in a season (Bumgarner, **Matt Cain** and **Tim Lincecum** each did so in '12).

A NICE RUN....: Over his last 19 starts dating to June 14, Webb has posted a 2.41 ERA (31er, 115.2ip) with 97 strikeouts and an opponents batting average against of .234...Webb himself has gone 9-7 in that time while the Giants have gone 9-10 as a team...his 2.41 ERA since June 14 is seventh-best in the Majors and fifth-best in the NL.

I GOT FIVE ON IT: According to *Stats, LLC*, when Webb has pitched at least 5.0 innings in his career the Giants have gone 42-15 (.737)...that winning percentage is tops in the Majors (min. 50g) ahead of the Dodgers when Julio Urías pitches (58-22, .725), Cleveland when Shane Bieber pitches (71-28, .717), Atlanta when Max Fried pitches (68-27, .716) or Hyun Jin Ryu's teams when he's pitched (98-41, .705).

VS. COLORADO: Will go back-to-back with the Rockies, facing them for a second straight start and fourth time this year...he's 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA (5er, 18.0ip) in the prior three outings vs. them this season...in four games, three starts, vs. Colorado here at Oracle Park, Webb is 2-1 with a 2.86 ERA (7er, 22.0ip).

WORLD WIDE WEBB: Since the start of last year, the Giants as a team are 38-19 (.667) when Webb takes the ball in a starting capacity...however, the Giants are 9-12 in Webb's last 21 starts dating to June 4...Webb in that time has posted a 2.64 ERA (37er, 126.0ip)...of the 12 losses, seven have been by two runs or fewer.

GROUNDHOG DAY: Has a 56.6% groundball percentage this year that is second-best in the Majors (best in the NL) only to Houston's Framber Valez (67.3%)...it's a tick below Webb's career average (56.8%) and down from last year's 61.2% that led the Majors (min.140.0ip).

HOMIE: Webb owns a 3.04 ERA (68er, 209.0ip) in 38 career games (36 starts) here at Oracle Park (it's 3.05 in his 36 starts)...the Giants are 27-12 in games he pitches here (25-11 more specifically in games that he's started)...this year, Webb is 8-6 with a 2.97 ERA (31er, 94.0ip) at home in 16 starts...the Giants as a team are 10-6 in his home outings this year...however, two of those six losses have come at the hands of the Dodgers...in those games, Webb allowed 10 runs on 15 hits in 9.0 innings (10.00 ERA)...Webb's home ERA this season against everyone else is 2.22 (21er, 85.0ip).
