**TRIO OF ALL-STARS:** The D-backs will be represented by 2B **Ketel Marte** (starting 2B), 3B **Eugenio Suárez** (reserve) and OF **Corbin Carroll** (reserve) at the MLB All-Star Game on July 15 in Atlanta.

2B Ketel Marte - Fan-Elected Starter:

- Led NL players in Phase 2 voting.
- Second straight and third career start at second base (also: 2019, '24).
- First NL second baseman with consecutive fan-elected starts since Chase Utley with 5 straight from 2006-10.
- First D-back with 3 fan-elected starts, second with 3 starts (also: Paul Goldschmidt) and third with consecutive starts (also: Paul Goldschmidt in 2014-15 and Randy Johnson in 2000-01).
- 3 All-Star appearances are tied for fourth in team history with Zack Greinke and Brandon Webb behind Paul Goldschmidt (6), Luis Gonzalez (5) and Randy Johnson (5).

3B Eugenio Suárez - Player-Elected INF Reserve:

- 2-time All-Star (also: 2018 with the Reds, player-elected at 3B).

OF Corbin Carroll - Player-Elected OF Reserve:

- 2-time All-Star (also: 2023 as fan-elected starter in LF).
- 12th D-back with multiple All-Star selections, joining Paul Goldschmidt (6), Luis Gonzalez (5), Randy Johnson (5), Zack Greinke (3), Brandon Webb (3), Ketel Marte (3), Patrick Corbin (2), Dan Haren (2), Miguel Montero (2), Curt Schilling (2) and Justin Upton (2).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 6-3 @ Padres.

- **Zac Gallen** had his second straight quality start (1 R-0 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 BB, 9 K).
- **Eugenio Suárez** had a game-tying, RBI double in the second inning, and **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** had the eventual game-winning RBI single in the third inning.
- **Josh Naylor** collected career RBI No. 400-401 on his 2-run homer in the fifth inning.

**SNAKEBITES:** The D-backs are 7-4 in their last 11 overall games vs. NL West (14-10 overall)...are 6-4 on the road vs. NL West.

- **Merrill Kelly**, in 5 starts vs. NL West this season (team is 3-2), is 3-1 with a 2.90 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 31.0 IP), opp. .235 AVG/.687 OPS, 10 walks and 36 strikeouts.
  - In his last 5 road starts vs. NL West, is 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA (9 R-8 ER in 32.0 IP), opponent .239 AVG/.630 OPS, 8 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- **Eugenio Suárez** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 road games, batting .405 (15-for-37)/1.425 OPS with 3 doubles, 6 homers and 13 RBI.
  - Has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 road games vs. NL West at a .400 clip (14-for-35)/1.307 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 homers and 11 RBI.

**6.0+ INNINGS:** The D-backs are 30-13 when their starting pitcher works 6.0 or more innings.

- The D-backs are 20-0 when their starting pitcher works 6.0+ innings and allows 1 or less earned runs [source: Codify].

**STARTERS ON THE ROAD:** D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 6 road starts since June 21 (team is 4-2), are 3-2 with a 3.24 ERA (14 R-12 ER in 33.1 IP), an opponent .246 AVG (31-for-126)/.716 OPS, 11 walks and 42 strikeouts.

- Among all team's starting pitchers since June 21, the D-backs are first with 11.34 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...fifth with 14 runs allowed... sixth with a 3.24 ERA...tied for ninth with 2.33 runs per game...10th with a .405 SLG, .716 OPS and 1.26 WHIP...11th with a .312 OBP.

**TRIPLE THREAT:** **Corbin Carroll** is the first D-back with 10 triples within the team's first 100 games of a season (previous high: 9 by Ketel Marte/2018).

- Since 1998, is the Majors' 20th player with 10+ triples in their team's first 100 games of a season (last: 10 by Jarren Duran/BOS this season).

**IN THE HISTORY BOOKS:** **Corbin Carroll** is the second player in MLB history with 3 straight seasons of 10+ doubles, 10+ triples, 20+ homers, 40+ RBI and 10+ stolen bases along with Dick Allen/Philadelphia Phillies (1965-67).

- Carroll is 1 of 2 MLB players with 10+ doubles, 5+ triples, 20+ homers, 40+ RBI and 10+ stolen bases (also: Shohei Ohtani/LAD)...is 1 of 12 players since 1998 to reach those marks in his team's first 100 games:

**VS. PADRES:** The D-backs are 4-1 in their last 5 overall games vs. Padres.

- The D-backs are 4-1 in their last 5 road games @ Padres and 9-4 in their last 13 road games @ Padres.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 6 straight road games @ Padres (.440, 11-for-25, 3 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI)...has reached base safely in 12 of his last 14 overall games vs. Padres (.365, 19-for-52, 3 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 1 BB).
- **Jake McCarthy** has reached base safely in 6 of his last 7 road games @ Padres, hitting .300 (6-for-20)/.962 with 1 double, 1 home run, 3 RBI and 5 walks.
- **Josh Naylor** has hit safely in all 4 games vs. Padres (.308, 4-for-13, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 3 BB).

**RUNS PER GAME:** Since June 23, the D-backs' 71 runs are fourth in the Majors behind the Blue Jays (90), Red Sox (85) and Cubs (75) and ahead of the Tigers (70), Marlins (69), Astros (68) and Nationals (68).

- In the NL, the D-backs' 5.07 runs per game are fifth behind the Cubs (5.77), Nationals (5.67), Marlins (5.31) and Brewers (5.15).

**DOMO ON-BASE STREAK:** **Geraldo Perdomo's** 14-game on-base streak, since June 23, is tied for the second longest of his career (also: April 4, 2021-April 10, 2022) behind his 15-gamer (April 3-19, 2025).

- His 14-gamer is the Majors' sixth-longest active streak...the longest active streak is 20 games for Tyler Freeman/COL.
- Since June 23, his .477 OBP is fourth in the Majors behind Michael Busch/CHI (.489), Mike Trout/LAA (.482) and James Wood/WSH (.482).

**WALKS > STRIKEOUTS:** **Geraldo Perdomo (53 BB / 48 K)** is 1 of 5 players [min. 40 G] with more walks than strikeouts with Juan Soto/NYM (72 BB / 68 K), Gleyber Torres/DET (49 BB / 43 K), Luis Arraez/SD (18 BB / 9 K) and Tyler Freeman/COL (17 BB / 13 K).
