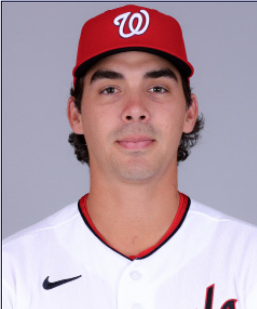

WHAT A STREAK

LAST START

Alvarez matched a career-high with eight strikeouts across 6.0 scoreless innings against the St. Louis Cardinals on Sept. 19 at Busch Stadium.

vs. NEW YORK

Alvarez is set to make his fourth career start against the New York Mets...He has pitched to a 5.54 ERA (8 ER/13.0 IP) with 13 strikeouts.

STREAKIN'

Alvarez enters this start having tossed 13.0 consecutive scoreless innings over his last two starts, the sixth-longest active streak among MLB starters.

REMEMBERING SEPTEMBER

Alvarez leads National League rookies (min. 15.0 IP) with a 1.56 ERA (3 ER/17.1 IP), 10.90 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, a .230 opponents' slugging percentage and is second with a .162 opponents' average (10-for-61) and a .250 opponents' on-base percentage in the month of September.

- Including his start on Aug. 30, he ranks second in all of Major League Baseball with a 1.16 ERA (3 ER/23.1 IP) over his last four starts since Aug. 30.

RECENCY BIAS

In his last 10 games (nine starts), Alvarez has pitched to a 2.14 ERA (13 ER/54.2 IP) with a .172 opponents' average...He ranks in the National League in opponents' slugging (1st, .260), opponents' OPS (1st, .524) opponents' average (3rd, .172), ERA (6th, 2.14) and strikeouts per nine innings (13th, 8.56) since July 27.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Opposing batters are hitting .164 (24-for-146) with six extra-base hits off Alvarez's curveball...He's fanned 68 batters with the curve this season, the most of any of his pitches.

Michael Andrew Alvarez...Graduated from Los Alamitos High School in Los Alamitos, Calif and attended Cal Poly State University.

- As a senior in 2021, Went 7-3 with a 4.08 ERA and 81 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts)...Named All-Big West honorable mention.
