METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets fell to the Red Sox, 2-0, last night... The Mets conclude a six-game road trip (1-4)...They began in The Bronx (1-2) before shipping up to Boston for a three-game set (0-2)... The Mets are on off on Thursday before the start of a nine-game homestand against the Dodgers (three games), White Sox (three games) and Rockies (three games).

STARTING OFF: The Mets starters have thrown quality starts in three straight outings...Overall, the Mets have made 16 quality starts this season...The Mets starting staff has tossed at least 6.0 innings in six of their last nine starts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Mets own a 12-15 record on the road this season...Their 3.26 ERA away from Citi Field is the second-best in the majors and the best in the National League.

STOP THE STREAK: The Mets have dropped three straight games for the first time this year...The team has lost five of their last six.... Below is a chart of the longest streaks to start a season by the Mets without losing three in a row, courtesy of *Elias*...New York has not lost four or more games since August 9-13, 2024 (also four game losing streak).

MAKE IT A DOZEN: Over his last 12 games, Jeff McNeil is batting .286 (6-21) with two runs, one double, one triple, one homer, four RBI, 10 walks, a .516 OBP and a .571 SLG...He safely reached base in all but four of his 21 games this season.

NO HOMERS CLUB: Pete Alonso has not hit a home run in 13 straight games...That is the third-longest streak in his career...His longest streak is 15 games without a homer (4/27-5/14/21) followed by a 14-game streak (8/5-18/22).

THREE'S COMPANY: The Mets have scored three or fewer runs in each of their last seven games...The team is 2-5 in that span, while slashing .176/.280/.233...The last time the Mets had a longer stretch was a seven-game period from August 22-29, 2023...The Mets are 8-15 when scoring three or fewer runs this year...New York owns a 21-5 record when scoring four or more runs in a game.

PICK SIX: The Mets have not homered in six straight games...It's the team's longest streak since a six-game span from July 19-24, 2015... The Mets also had a nine-game homerless streak from June 29-July 7, 2015...The Mets are 7-14 when they do not homer, while posting a 22-6 record when hitting a dinger in a game.

SOX-METS NOTES: The Mets have not won a series at Fenway since a two-game sweep from July 27-28, 2020.

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: The Mets will play American League teams in nine of their next 12 games (1-4)...This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 8-9 in Interleague Play this season...The team went 24-22 in Interleague Play last year...Overall, New York owns a 286-285 record in Interleague play.

INTERGALACTIC: Pete Alonso has hit a franchise-record 59 home runs in Interleague Play...His 59 home runs are the seventh-most all-time...It is tied for third among active players with Manny Machado... Only Aaron Judge (69) and Kyle Shwarber (63) have hit more.

ED, EDD AND EDDY: Edwin Diaz has not allowed an earned run over his last eight games, recording four saves and allowing four hits, two walks and 11 strikeouts during that span...He has not allowed a hit over last four appearances.

23 AND ME: The Mets have won the last 23 games in which Francisco Lindor has homered...The streak that goes back to July 9, 2024 is the longest streak in team history...Prior to Lindor's streak, the longest was 21 straight wins when George Foster homered between July 3, 1985, and June 29, 1986...The next-longest active streak by any major leaguer is Boston's Ceddanne Rafaela at 17 straight wins...Courtesy of Stats Perform.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Francisco has hit six lead-off homers as a member of the Mets...That is tied with Mookie Wilson for the seventh-most in team history...Michael Conforto is next with seven leadoff homers.

LAST START: Made his last start on May 16 at New York-AL, recording his fourth loss of the season after allowing a season-high-tying four earned runs in 2.2 innings pitched...Marked his shortest start since 6/21/23 at Houston (2.1 IP)...His five walks allowed matched his career high (also 6/3/23 vs. Toronto)...Has allowed four earned runs in three consecutive starts after not allowing more than three earned runs in his previous six starts of the season and previous 12 starts going back to August 30, 2024...Marks just the third time in his career he has allowed at least four earned runs in three straight starts and the first time he has done so since 6/22-7/27/24.

2025: In nine starts this season, is 3-4 with a 3.74 ERA (18 ER/43.1 IP), 22 walks and 56 strikeouts...Has recorded at least six strikeouts in four of his last five starts (since April 21), posting a 13.50 K/9.0 IP ratio in those games...Has allowed three runs or fewer in five of his nine starts, and one or zero runs in four...Has held batters to a .229 average (38-166), including left-handers to a .182 average (14-77)...Has tossed 5.0+ innings in six of nine starts this season...When the count is 0-2, Megill has given up zero hits and has struck out eight of 12 batters faced in that scenario...Has received more than three runs in support in just two of his outings...Among major league pitchers (min. 40.0 IP), he is sixth in K/9.0 IP (11.63, fourth in NL)...Among NL pitchers with the same qualification, he ranks seventh in opponents' SLG (.313) and 10th in HR/9.0 IP (0.62)...He is one of nine National League pitchers to allow three or fewer home runs when facing at least 150 batters (includes teammate Kodai Senga).

TYLOR MADE: Dating back to September 9, 2024, Megill has recorded a 3.05 ERA (22 ER/65.0 IP), 30 walks and 83 strikeouts in 13 starts...He has held opposing batters to a .215 average (53-246) and has posted a 11.49 K/9.0 IP ratio...Also has posted a 0.69 HR/9.0 IP ratio (5 HR/65.0 IP)...In that span, he ranks fourth in K/9.0 IP (11.49, third in NL) and seventh in opponents' SLG (.305, second in NL) among major league pitchers (min. 60.0 IP).

ACROSS LEAGUE LINES: Will be making his second career start against Boston tonight (also 9/4/24 where he allowed three earned runs over 4.0 IP)...Has made four starts against Interleague opponents this season, going 2-2 with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER/18.0 IP), nine walks and 17 strikeouts...In 21 career outings (19 starts) in Interleague games, Megill has gone 7-4 with a 3.53 ERA (38 ER/97.0 IP), 39 walks and 99 strikeouts...Since the start of last season, the right-hander has allowed just one home run to a total of 197 American League baters, posting a 0.20 HR/9.0IP ratio in Interleague games...He also recorded a 9.85 K/9.0IP ratio (50 K/45.2 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) vs. Interleague opponents since the beginning of the 2024 season.

CH-CH-CH-CHANGEUPS: Though he has only used his changeup 6.9% of the time this season, Megill has recorded a 36.8% whiff rate with his off-speed pitch...He has held batters to a .083 average when throwing his changeup.

2024 RECAP: Over 16 games (15 starts) in 2024, Megill went 4-5 with a 4.04 ERA (35 ER/78.0 IP), adding 32 walks against 91 strikeouts...The right-hander allowed three runs or less in 11 of his 15 starts, including each of his last six starts of the season (August 30 - September 30)...He recorded at least six strikeouts in nine starts, tied for his most such starts in a single season (also: 2021)...Among National League pitchers, his 10.50 K/9.0IP ratio was tied for the ninth-best (min. 75.0 IP)...Megill pitched in the Postseason for the first time in his career, making appearances in Game 2 of the NLDS vs. Philadelphia (1 ER/1.1 IP) and in Game 3 of the NLCS vs. Los Angeles-NL (4 ER/3.0 IP).

FAMILY MATTERS: His brother, Trevor, plays for the Milwaukee Brewers...Tylor and Trevor both debuted in the majors in 2021...The Megill brothers join teammates Luisangel Acuña (Ronald Acuña Jr.) and Edwin Díaz (Alexis Díaz) as three of 13 pairs of siblings to begin the season on 40-man rosters...Courtesy of *Elias*.

CAREER NOTES: Made his third career Opening Day roster (also: 2022, '24)...Over parts of four Major League seasons with the Mets, Megill has combined to go 24-25 with a 4.47 ERA (191 ER/384.2 IP), 152 walks and 402 strikeouts over 83 games (76 starts)...In 2024, he established career bests in ERA (4.04), K/9.0IP (10.50), HR/9.0IP (0.92) and FIP (3.62)...Was originally drafted by the Mets in the eighth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Arizona.

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- Tossed a scoreless seventh inning in relief on May 18 at the Yankees (H, 2 BB, K)...Loaded the bases and struck out Anthony Volpe to end the inning...Pitched on consecutive days for the fourth time this season (also: 4/8-9, 4/22-23 and 5/4(G1)-5).
- On May 17 at the Yankees, retired each of his five batters faced in relief (1.2 IP, K)...Also stranded two inherited runners in the sixth inning...Has stranded 11 of his 13 inherited runners this season (15.4%), which is tied for the eighth-best percentage among Major League relievers and second-best in the National League (min. 10 IR)...Trails only teammate Max Kranick (12.5%).
- Earned his second win of the season on May 12 against the Pirates after tossing the ninth inning (1.0 IP, 2 H, R).
- Has not allowed an earned run over his last nine appearances (11.1 IP, since April 27)...In that span, has allowed just three hits to 43 batters faced (.083 opponents' BA, 4 BB, 11 K).
- Has recorded a 1.09 ERA (3 ER/24.2 IP) in 19 games as a reliever this season...Among NL relievers this season (min. 20.0 IP), is second in ERA, fifth in WHIP (0.81), seventh in groundball percentage (55.7), eighth in opponents' OPS (.503), ninth in opponents' BA (.169) and opponents' SLG (.253), and 10th in opponents' OBP (.250).
- In 12 road games this season (one start as an opener), he has posted a 0.57 ERA (ER/15.2 IP) with one save, four holds, 14 strikeouts and a .137 opponents' BA (7-51)...Is scoreless in 11 of those games.
- Has been scoreless over 10.1 innings against Interleague opponents this season, holding batters to a .094 average (3-32).
- Has gone 2-0 with one save, six holds and a 0.98 ERA (3 ER/27.2 IP) through 21 appearances (two starts as an opener) this season, holding batters to a .152 average (14-92)...17 of his 21 outings this season have been scoreless...With runners on base, has held batters to a .093 average (4-43)...He is one of nine Mets pitchers (10th time) to record a sub-1.00 ERA in their first 21 games of a season and is the first to do so since Francisco Rodríguez's 0.83 ERA in 21 games from 4/2-5/18/11.
- Seven of his 19 relief appearances have been for five or more outs and each of those outings have been scoreless...Is one of seven relievers to record at least five scoreless appearances of 2.0+ innings.
- Has produced a run value of five with his sinker this season, tied for the 10th-best among qualified Major League pitchers.

- Tossed a scoreless eighth inning on May 19 at Boston (1.0 IP, 2 H).
- Threw 2.0 innings scoreless innings on May 16 against New York-AL (BB, K)...It marked the 12th time since the start of 2024 season that he pitched at least 2.0 innings without allowing an earned run in relief, which is tied for the fifth-most such games in the majors over that span.
- Has not allowed just two hits to his last 17 batters faced (since 5/9 vs. CHC).
