**THE TWINS:** Began the post-All-Star break portion of their schedule with consecutive losses to the Rockies at Coors Field...today, they will play the three-game series finale in Denver...after today's game, they will travel to Los Angeles to play the Dodgers for three games from Monday-Wednesday.  
✦ Twins have gone 13-19 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13) and 0-2 at Colorado.  
✦ Twins are seeking their first road win since a 2-1 victory on July 2 at Miami.

**MINNESOTA GETS ROCKED AGAIN:** The Twins lost to the Rockies last night at Coors Field by a score of 10-6, dropping the series, their 16th this season (14-16-2)...Zebby Matthews (1-2) returned from the IL and allowed five runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts and was dealt the loss...Brock Stewart gave up a three-run homer to Ezequiel Tovar in the fifth inning to break a 3-3 tie, his first extra-base hit allowed to a right-handed batter all season...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Kody Clemens and Carlos Correa...Clemens drove in three of the six runs for the Twins, finishing with a double and a triple.

**RYAN KING:** Joe Ryan appeared in his first All-Star Game on Tuesday at Truist Park, pitching a scoreless fourth inning on 10 pitches...he struck out Manny Machado, induced a pop out to Will Smith and struck out Kyle Tucker...over his last 13 starts (14 games), since April 27, Ryan has gone 8-2, 2.30 ERA (82.1 IP, 21 ER) with 20 walks, 93 strikeouts and a .185 opponent batting average...below are his AL ranks since that date:

**YOU'VE HAD THIS PAIR OF EXTRA GLOVES THIS WHOLE TIME?:** The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 27th time in their history today...the Twins have gone 14-12 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-6 at Coors Field (2008, '14, '23 & '25) and 7-5 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22 & '24).  
✦ In 10 career games against the Rockies, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with one double, two triples, three home runs, seven RBI, four walks and a 1.122 OPS.  
✦ Carlos Correa has played in 24 career games against the Rockies, hitting .411 (37-for-90) with nine doubles, three home runs, 21 RBI, a .611 slugging percentage and a 1.082 OPS...he has reached safely in 19-straight games against the Rockies, dating back to August 15, 2018 (.481 OBP in span).  
✦ All-time Twins home runs at Coors Field: Trevor Larnach (2), Brian Dozier (2), Byron Buxton (1), Matt Wallner (1), Willi Castro (1), Ryan Jeffers (1), Justin Morneau (1), Eduardo Escobar (1), Edouard Julien (10), Max Kepler (1), Michael A. Taylor (1).

**BUCK NASTY:** Over his last 31 games, Buxton is hitting .339 (40-for-118) with eight doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBI, 29 runs scored, 10 walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .729 slugging percentage and a 1.129 OPS.  
✦ Since June 17, Buck has 11 home runs (26 games), tied with Juan Soto, Nick Kurtz, Riley Greene and Kyle Stowers for third-most in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (12) and Eugenio Suárez (12).  
✦ At 17 stolen bases, Buck needs three more to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hise (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

**AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF:** Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in seven-straight games with an at-bat, tied the third-longest of his career...his season-long is eight (April 26-May 6) and his career-high is 14 (July 15-August 9, 2023)...in 13 games this month, Jeffers is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, two walks, a .447 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.047 OPS.

**CARLOS COR-RAKING:** Carlos Correa has reached safely in eight of his last nine games...over his last 23 games, Correa is hitting .337 (28-for-83) with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, a .389 on-base percentage, a .470 slugging percentage and an .859 OPS.

**BREAKING BROOMS:** Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fifth time this season...the other four were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15) and three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22).  
✦ Other than those four sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep three times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto and June 19 at Cincinnati.  
✦ The Twins have never been swept by the Rockies, in eight previous series'.

**THE MISSILE:** Last night, Kody Clemens set new single-season career-highs in hits (34), runs scored (25) and RBI (29)...since playing his first game with Minnesota on April 28, he has posted an .848 OPS, second-best on the team since that date, trailing Byron Buxton (.992)...his .541 slugging percentage in that span also ranks second, trailing Buxton (.607).

**TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS:** Dominican Summer League infielder Santiago León and Florida Complex League right-handed pitcher Joel García have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.  
✦ León, 17, played in five games for the DSL Twins, hitting .333 (6-for-18) with one double, one triple, two RBI, three walks, nine runs scored and a .978 OPS...the Carabobo, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins in January.  
✦ García, 21, made the start on Tuesday at FCL Braves, pitching 5.2 scoreless innings, with five hits allowed, two walks and six strikeouts...the Anaco, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins in December of 2022.
