MINNESOTA GETS ROCKED AGAIN: The Twins lost to the Rockies last night at Coors Field by a score of 10-6, dropping the series, their 16th this season (14-16-2)...Zebby Matthews (1-2) returned from the IL and allowed five runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts and was dealt the loss...Brock Stewart gave up a three-run homer to Ezequiel Tovar in the fifth inning to break a 3-3 tie, his first extra-base hit allowed to a right-handed batter all season...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Kody Clemens and Carlos Correa...Clemens drove in three of the six runs for the Iwins, finishing with a double and a triple.
