THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game roadtrip to open the 2026 season, going 1-2 at Baltimore last weekend, followed by a loss in Kansas City on Monday afternoon...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three at Kauffman against the Royals, then play the series finale tomorrow afternoon...following tomorrow's game, Minnesota will travel home to begin its 17th season at Target Field with a three-game weekend series against the Tampa Bay Rays...following the Rays, the Twins will host the Tigers for four games from Monday-Thursday.

FOUNTAINS NOT SO UP: The Twins lost to the Royals on Monday afternoon by a score of 3-1 in the Kauffman Stadium Home Opener...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-1) made his season debut as the starter, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched and was dealt the loss...his one blemish was a Kyle Isbel two-run homer in the second inning...the offense recorded just four hits, went 0-for-1 with runners in scoring position and left four men on base...Matt Wallner drove in the only run on the day for Minnesota with a solo homer in the second inning off Kris Bubic, a 424-foot shot to rightfield.

GAME OF THRONES: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the second of 13 games in 2026...their next series after this will be four games at Target Field from June 4-7...the next time the Twins will travel to Kauffman will be for three games from August 4-6...the Twins are 34-23 in their last 57 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022...
 ☞ Twins have 196 wins all-time at Kauffman Stadium, their most in any opposing ballpark in their history (since 1961).
 ☞ Byron Buxton went just 2-for-18 against the Royals last season, but has hit .296 (47-for-159) over his last 43 games against KC, with 16 doubles, three triples, eight home runs, 23 RBI, 35 runs scored, a .585 slugging percentage and a .942 OPS...over his last 24 games at Kauffman, Buxton is hitting .303 (27-for-89) with 11 doubles, two triples, four home runs, 15 RBI and a .957 OPS.
 ☞ Josh Bell is hitting .330 (29-for-88) with six doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI and a .972 OPS in 24 career games vs. Kansas City...he has an .871 OPS in 15 career games at Kauffman.
 ☞ Since the start of last season, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with an .866 OPS in nine games against KC.

DID YOU KNOW?: Justin Morneau is the club's all-time leader in home runs at Kauffman with 15.

RYAN KING: Joe Ryan has made 11 career starts against the Royals, going 8-1, 2.02 ERA (62.1 IP, 14 ER) with 15 walks, 66 strikeouts and a .176 opponent batting average...his only loss was at Kauffman Stadium on September 6, 2025, allowing five runs on four hits in 2.0 innings pitched...below are all-time pitching ranks vs. KC (minimum 60 innings pitched):

AUSTIN MARTIN. INTENSITY. DRIVEN.: Austin Martin has gone 2-for-5 (.400) with two walks, one stolen base and just one strikeout through three games this season...he has led off in two of the Twins' four games — both against lefties (Trevor Rogers on Opening Day in Baltimore and Monday against Kris Bubic)...dating back to September 4, 2025, he is hitting .310 (26-for-84) with six doubles, five RBI, 12 runs scored, 12 walks and a .402 on-base percentage...in that span against lefties, he is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with a .400 on-base percentage and an .806 OPS.

MAJORITY REPORT: Twins can even the series with a win tonight...they lost their first series to open the season two games to one in Baltimore, winning the middle of the three games...they went 18-32-2 in series play last season, going 11-13-2 at home and 7-19-0 on the road...Minnesota finished the season going 1-7-0 in their final eight series, their only win coming September 23-25 at Texas, taking two of three from the Rangers during their final roadtrip.
 ☞ With wins tonight and tomorrow, the Twins will win their first series at Kauffman Stadium since taking two of three from March 28-31, 2024...their last series win over the Royals was August 8-10, 2025 at Target Field (2 of 3).

LEFTIES LINING UP: Twins hitters are 7-for-54 (.130) with two extra-base hits (Josh Bell double off Grant Wolfgram and Matt Wallner homer off Kris Bubic) off lefties this season...notable individuals vs. lefties last season:
 ☞ Byron Buxton hit .306 (33-for-108) with 10 home runs, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.050 OPS — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career...Buck's 1.050 OPS ranked second-best in baseball in 2025 (min. 100 PA) and his .676 slugging percentage ranked third.
 ☞ Austin Martin hit .346 (18-for-52) with an .884 OPS against lefties in 2025.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers hit .313 (35-for-112) with a .466 on-base percentage and an .885 OPS...his on-base percentage ranked second-highest in baseball among qualifiers, trailing only Aaron Judge (.491).

HEAD GAMES: Twins enter today having used the ABS challenge system 13 times, third most in baseball...Twins have won eight of those challenges, posting a 62% success rate...they have won four of six on the hitting side and four of seven on the pitching side.

NO PLACE LIKE HERE: Baseball returns to downtown Minneapolis on Friday and the Minnesota Twins are celebrating with a daylong party for the 2026 Home Opener presented by U.S. Bank...festivities begin with Breakfast on the Plaza at 6:00 am; gates open at 1:00 pm for a new Pregame Happy Hour featuring \$2 beers, hot dogs and snacks; and pregame ceremonies will honor 2026 Minnesota-connected Olympians and Paralympians...below is a list of highlights for the day:

- ☞ **Breakfast on the Plaza (6:00-9:00 am):** Fans can drive, walk or bike down 7th Street (adjacent to the Twins New Era Team Store) to pick up a complimentary ballpark-inspired breakfast, enjoy live music and enter giveaways for Opening Weekend tickets.
- ☞ **Open the Gates (1:00 pm):** Twins legends Rod Carew (Gate 29), Tony Oliva (Gate 6) and Kent Hrbek (Gate 14) will open their namesake ballpark entrances at 1:00 pm; current Twins pitcher Pablo Lopez (Gate 3); franchise icons Dan Gladden (Gate 6.5), and Kirby Puckett Jr. and Catherine Puckett (Gate 34); and Minneapolis Mayor Jacob Frey (Gate 34) will also officially open the Target Field gates.
- ☞ **Gate Giveaway (1:00 pm):** The first 10,000 fans through the gates will receive a Twins Beanie, courtesy of U.S. Bank.
- ☞ **Pregame Happy Hour (1:00-3:10 pm):** Enjoy \$2 beers (21+), \$2 hot dogs and \$2 snacks at select stands.
- ☞ **Olympic Rings (Pregame):** A celebration of the 2026 Milano Cortina Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games...Cory Thiesse, Corey Dropkin and Mike Schultz will throw out ceremonial first pitches...the Twins will also recognize the gold medal-winning U.S. Olympic Women's Ice Hockey Team and U.S. Paralympic Sled Hockey Team.
- ☞ **"The Star-Spangled Banner"** will be performed by Anya Bostick and Harriet Spencer, who alternate in the role of Dorothy in the Children's Theatre Company production of The Wizard of Oz, running April 21 through June 14.

2026, MEET JOE RYAN: Ryan took the mound on Opening Day (March 26 at Baltimore) for the second time in his career (2022) and fired 5.1 scoreless IP, allowing one hit - a fourth inning, two out single by Adley Rutschman - with two walks and seven strikeouts...he became the first Twins Opening Day starter to post a scoreless outing since José Berrios blanked Cleveland through 7.2 IP and earned the win on March 28, 2019 at Target Field.

⚔ In two career Opening Day starts, Ryan is 0-1 with a 1.93 ERA (9.1 IP, 2 ER), six walks, 11 strikeouts and a .097 BAA (3-for-31).

SPRING RECAP: Went 1-0, posting a 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 2 ER) with four walks, eight strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .222 BAA (10-for-45) in three 2026 Grapefruit League starts.

⚔ Was slated to start the Twins' first Grapefruit League game, but removed himself due to a lower back issue...made his first spring start on 3/10 at Charlotte Sports Park against Tampa Bay.

2025 RECAP: Made a career-high 30 starts (31 appearances), finishing 13-10 with a 3.42 ERA (171.0 IP, 65 ER), 39 walks, 194 strikeouts (4.97 K/BB), a 1.04 WHIP and a .218 BAA...matched his single-season high in wins (2022)...finished top 10 in the American League in strikeouts (6th), WHIP (6th), wins (7-6th), BAA (9th) and ERA (10th)...was named to the American League All-Star team for the first time in his career...received the Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, as voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America.

ROYAL TREATMENT: Ryan is making his 12th career start against the Royals (8-1), entering the game with a 2.02 ERA (62.1 IP, 14 ER), 15 walks and 66 strikeouts...last faced the Royals on September 6, 2025, when he allowed five earned runs through 2.0 IP on four hits, four walks and two strikeouts in an 11-2 loss at Kauffman Stadium; the outing matched his shortest career start (also on 9/6/25 at Chicago-NL) and the most walks he's allowed in a single game since walking four on September 7, 2022 in game two of a doubleheader at New York-AL.

⚔ His 66 strikeouts are tied with Tarik Skubal for the most by a pitcher against Kansas City since Ryan's rookie season in 2022.

⚔ He is the only starter in Twins club history to win eight of his first 11 starts against the Royals.

⚔ A ninth victory for Ryan against the Royals would tie him with Kyle Gibson and Dave Goltz (9) for fifth all-time in Twins club history for wins against Kansas City.

⚔ At Kauffman Stadium, Ryan is 4-1 with a 2.25 ERA (32.0 IP, 8 ER), 10 walks, 28 strikeouts and a .170 BAA (19-for-112).
