- ♦ The D-backs are 2-1 in their 9-game homestand vs. Rockies (2-1), Marlins (May 9-11) and Cubs (May 13-15).
- ♦ Arizona has won 5 of its last 6 games and are 9-3 in its last 12.
- ♦ Arizona starting pitchers are 6-0 with a 0.87 ERA (5 ER in 52.0 IP) with 6 walks and 38 strikeouts in the last 8 games.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** boasts an 8-game hitting streak (.393; 11-for-28).

- ♦ **Zac Gallen** (1st, 0.95 ERA), **Merrill Kelly** (4th, 1.22), **Madison Bumgarner** (8th, 1.50 ERA) give the D-backs a Major-League-best 3 of the Top 10 in ERA (min. 5 GS, 20.0 IP).

- AT A GLANCE:** Is in his second season with Arizona...claimed off waivers from the Astros on Jan. 29, 2021
- **Pronounced:** uhm-BAIR-toh kah-stay-AH-nohs.
  - Born and resides in Tepatitlán, México.
  - Signed by Astros as non-drafted free agent July 2, 2015.

- WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Is making his fifth start this season...made 2 relief outings to start 2022 (2 ER in 3.0 IP).
- In 11 career starts, is 4-2 with a 4.97 ERA (28 ER in 50.2 IP).
  - Became the sixth Mexico-born starter for Arizona on July 7, 2021 vs. Rockies (also: Armando Reynoso, Elmer Dessens, Édgar González, Rodrigo López and Óscar Villarreal).

- LAST START:** Picked up his second win on May 3 @ Marlins after tossing 5.2 scoreless innings with 4 hits and 4 strikeouts.

- VS. MARLINS:** Will be making his second career appearance...SEE LAST START.

- NUMBERS CRUNCH:** Limiting lefties to a .219 average (7-for-32).
- Opponents are hitting .200 (2-for-10) off his slider and .182 (2-for-11) off his changeup.
  - Has not surrendered a home run (83 BF).

- VIVA MÉXICO:** Was the D-backs' 13th Mexico-born player (11th pitcher) when he made his 2021 debut June 4 @ Brewers.
- Miguel González, who pitched for the Orioles (2012-15), White Sox (2016-18) and Rangers (2017), was also born in Tepatitlán.

- 2021 REVIEW:** Was 2-2 with a 4.92 ERA (25 ER in 45.2 IP) in 14 games (7 starts) with the D-backs.
- Went 2-1 with a 5.56 ERA (21 ER in 34.0 IP) as a starter and 0-1 with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER in 11.2 IP) in relief.
  - Opponents were 8-for-53 (.151) off his curveball and 6-for-27 (.222) off his 4-seam fastball.
  - Limited hitters to a .208 average (10-for-48) with runners in scoring position.
