Elieser Hernández

Elieser Hernández earned the win for Atlanta following Wednesday's rain delay in Washington, DC.

The right-hander has compiled two wins and a save in each of his three outings with the Braves. Since saves became official in 1969, he is just the 11th pitcher to amass those statistics in his first three games with a team. He is the first Brave to do so.

Three total players have done it in the last two seasons, but prior to thoes performances, José Valverde was the last to do so for Houston in 2008.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Philadelphia Phillies today commence a four-game wraparound series with the seventh of 13 scheduled meetings...Atlanta swept Philadelphia in three games here at Citizens Bank Park from April 17-19 and took two-of-three at Truist Park from April 24-26.

 These two teams played six games in a 10-day span from April 17-26, but haven't seen each other since...The Braves and Phillies will now play seven games in a 10-day span to complete their season slate.

 This is Atlanta's second wraparound series of the season after dueling the New York Mets in the same fashion at Truist Park from July 3-6...The two teams split that series.

 The Braves went just 5-8 in 13 games against the Phillies last year, dropping the season set against Philadelphia for the first time since the 2019 season...Atlanta can secure the season series for the sixth time in seven seasons with two wins in this set.

 LHP Cristopher Sánchez is scheduled to make his eighth career start and ninth appearance against Atlanta...The 6-foot-6, 200-pounder has never beaten the Braves, going 0-4 despite a 3.09 ERA (15 ER/43.2 IP) in his turns...Sánchez is one of three active pitchers with zero wins and at least seven starts against the club, joining Adrian Houser and Erick Fedde...Houser and Fedde have pitched to ERAs of 5.21 and 8.89, respectively.

CHRIS SALE: Enters tonight's matchup ranking third in Major League Baseball in ERA (2.06)...Sale's ERA sits just nine points behind the major-league leader (Jacob Misorowski, 1.97).

 Since 1920, only three other pitchers, 37-or-older, have maintained an ERA of 2.06-or-lower through 24 starts: Roger Clemens (1.32, 2005), Justin Verlander (1.84, 2022) and Spud Chandler (1.87, 1946).

 The native of Lakeland, FL, enters tonight's game with a 12.0-inning scoreless streak, the fifth-longest active by a starting pitcher...Sale's 49.0-frame homerless streak is the second-longest active by a starter and the fourth longest regardless of role.

 In his last turn, facing the Los Angeles Dodgers, the southpaw spun the fourth shutout of his career and his first since June 5, 2019...He became the seventh pitcher his age-or-older (37 years, 150 days) with a 10-plus strikeout, zero-walk shutout, the first since Randy Johnson on May 18, 2004 (Sarah Langs).

 Sale has made nine career starts against Philadelphia, pitching to a 4-2 record and a 3.23 ERA (19 ER/53.0 IP)...He has struck out at least nine Phillies in four of his nine starts, and at least seven in seven of his nine...Since joining Atlanta, Sale is undefeated against the club, 3-0, with a 2.31 ERA (9 ER/35.0 IP).

MARQUEE MATCHUP: Chris Sale (2.06) and Cristopher Sánchez (2.52) rank third and sixth on Major League Baseball's ERA leaderboard, respectively...The top six also includes Jacob Misorowski (MIL, 1.97), Cam Schlitler (NYY, 2.04), Dylan Cease (TOR, 2.25) and Parker Messick (CLE, 2.46).

 MLB-wide, the last time two left-handed starters faced each other with ERAs 2.60-or-lower occurred in 1998 (min. 24 starts in season)...The Braves' Tom Glavine (2.53) faced the Mets' Al Leiter (2.40) on September 26, 1998 (credit Elias).

 Regardless of throwing hand, the last time any pitching matchup met those qualifications was on August 19, 2025, when Detroit's Tarik Skubal (2.42) met Houston's Hunter Brown (2.45).

200/200: During Wednesday's game at Washington, Ronald Acuña Jr. became the fastest player in MLB history to reach the 200-home run, 200-stolen base milestone during his 904th career game...He out-paced Alfonso Soriano, who set the previous record during his 929th game.

 Acuña Jr. is batting leadoff for Atlanta this afternoon, and enters play with 840 career hits from the top spot in the batting order...He needs just two hits to tie, and three to pass, Rafael Furcal for the most hits as a leadoff batter in franchise history.

ON BASE: Michael Harris II and Ozzie Albies each extended their on-base streaks to 17 games yesterday, each with a walk...The duo is tied for the third-longest active on-base streak in Major League Baseball.

 The only longer active streaks belong to Bryce Harper (PHI, 35 games) and Heriberto Hernández (MIA, 20 games).

 Albies' streak is his second-longest this season behind an 18-gamer that spanned April-May...Harris II has tied his career-long on-base streak...He initialized his 17-game record from September 10-30, 2024.

 Ronald Acuña Jr. owns the longest on-base streak by a Brave this season, reaching in 27 consecutive contests from April 7-May 22.

WITHIN THE DIVISION: Atlanta enters this series against Philadelphia with the best intradivision record in Major League Baseball (28-14, .667)...The Milwaukee Brewers rank second at 24-13 (.649).

 The Braves' .667 intradivisional winning percentage would finish as the team's fifth-best in the Divisional Era (since 1969)...The club finished with higher marks in 1993 (.705), 1999 (.686), 2023 (.673) and 2004 (.671).

 Including tonight's game, Atlanta has 10 games remaining against NL East foes: seven against Philadelphia and three against Miami...The Braves are 5-1 (.833) versus the Phillies and 8-2 (.800) versus the Marlins this season.

Makes his 25th start of the season and the 337th of his career tonight in the opener of a four-game series at Philadelphia...Atlanta is 14-10 in his 24 turns this year.
- 🔥

Makes his 10th career start against Philadelphia and his third against the club this season...Is 4-2 with a 3.23 ERA (19 ER/53.0 IP) and 70 strikeouts across nine previous career starts.
- 🔥

Is 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) and 16 strikeouts in two starts against the Phillies this season, winning 3-1 on April 18 in Philadelphia and 6-2 on April 26 at Truist Park.
- 🔥

Has allowed one run-or-fewer with seven-or-more strikeouts in four consecutive starts against Philadelphia, dating to May 29, 2025...Joins Clayton Kershaw (2012-15) as the only pitchers in the modern era to do so against the club.
- 🔥

Made his Braves debut against Philadelphia on March 31, 2024, taking a no-decision after 5.1 innings in a 5-4 loss.
- 🔥

Has not allowed more than three runs in 21 consecutive starts, dating to April 12 vs. Cleveland, the longest active streak of its kind in the majors...Is 11-8 with a 1.83 ERA (26 ER/128.0 IP) and 161 strikeouts over the span.
- 🔥

In 45 total appearances since the start of last season, he has allowed more than three earned runs just three times.
- 🔥

His 2.33 ERA (116 ER/447.1 IP) and 2.29 FIP since joining Atlanta in 2024 are both the lowest among major league starters over that span, minimum 50 starts... Los Angeles' (NL) Tarik Skubal ranks second in each (2.44, 2.48)...His 0.56 home runs allowed per 9.0 innings over that span also rank first.
- 🔥

Since making his Braves debut at age 35, has pitched to a 2.33 ERA (116 ER/447.1 IP) in 74 appearances...It is the lowest mark in baseball since World War II (1945) among pitchers with as many outings in their age-35-or-older seasons...Hall of Famer Whitey Ford is next at 2.58, over 105 appearances for New York (AL) from 1964-67.
- 🔥

Is 22-8 with a 1.95 ERA (55 ER/253.2 IP) and 324 strikeouts in 42 starts against teams with a .500-or-better record since joining the Braves in 2024, the lowest ERA in that span among pitchers with at least as many such starts as Sale...Skubal (2.41) and Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.45) rank second and third.
- 🔥

His 2.19 FIP is the second-lowest by a starter age 36 or older in a season since 1995, trailing only Hall of Famer Randy Johnson's 2.13 in 2001.
- 🔥

Since the All-Star break is 4-3 with a 1.76 ERA (9 ER/46.0 IP), striking out 60 against three walks over seven starts.
- 🔥

Opponents are 41-for-217 (.189) with 99 strikeouts and no home runs in plate appearances ending on his slider this season.

🔥 Opponents have chased 37.0 percent of his pitches outside the strike zone, the second-highest rate among qualified major league pitchers.
- 🔥

Opponents are batting .156 (15-for-96) against him with runners in scoring position this season, the second lowest batting average against in baseball, trailing only New York's (AL) Cam Schlitlers (.143).
- 🔥

His fastball has averaged 96.0 mph in 2026, his highest mark in any season since he became a full-time starter in 2012.

Tossed the fourth shutout of his career and the 17th complete game of his career August 27 vs. Los Angeles (NL), striking out 11 without a walk in a 1-0 win... Both were his first since June 5, 2019 at Kansas City...His 17 complete games are the second-most among active pitchers, trailing only Justin Verlander (26).
- 🔥

Was the ninth major league pitcher to throw a shutout this season and the first Brave to do so since Max Fried on April 24, 2024...Is also the first Brave to strike out 10-or-more without a walk in a shutout since Tim Hudson on May 2, 2008.
- 🔥

Became the seventh pitcher age 37 years, 150 days or older to record a 10-strikeout, zero-walk shutout, and the first since Hall of Famer Randy Johnson on May 18, 2004 (credit Sarah Langs).
- 🔥

Fanned 10-or-more for the fourth time this season and the 95th time in his career, the seventh-most double-digit-strikeout games in major league history...It was his 14th such start with Atlanta, tying Denny Lemaster for the fifth-most in modern franchise history.
- 🔥

Hit 100.1 mph on a four-seam fastball to Shohei Ohtani in the third inning of that start, just the 16th time in his career he has reached 100.0 mph and his first since July 6, 2018.
- 🔥

Through his first 70 appearances with Atlanta, his 2.36 ERA is the second-lowest by any Braves pitcher in the Atlanta era (since 1966), trailing only Hall of Famer Greg Maddux's 2.03.
- 🔥

Surpassed 2,200.0 career innings pitched during his July 29 start at New York (NL), entering that outing with 2,195.0.
- 🔥

Was named to his 10th career All-Star team this season, his third in as many years with Atlanta...His 10 selections are tied with Justin Verlander for the most among active pitchers.
- 🔥

Recorded his 500th strikeout as a Brave on July 4 against New York (NL), becoming the ninth left-hander in franchise history to reach the mark.
