

## SAN DIEGO PADRES (62-52) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (56-56) AUGUST 7, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #113/HOME #57 RHP MICHAEL KING (9-6, 3.26 ERA) vs. LHP MARCO GONZALES (1-1, 3.72 ERA)

THE PIRATES: were shut out 6-0 last night in the opener of their three-game series against the Padres...Have lost two straight and four of their last five games (have not lost three straight since May 7-10)...Were three games over .500 at 55-52 following their win on July 30 at Houston (the first time to be record following the action on April 17)...Have won 14 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in

2021)...Have played in 39 one-run games; tied for the most in all of MLB along with the Cubs...Have won seven straight and 10 of their last 11 games when going deep multiple times in a game...Have the third-best stolen base percentage (83.5 percent) in MLB behind the Blue Jays (84.1 percent) and Brewers (83.6 percent).

THE RESILIENT PIRATES: Tonight the Pirates will attempt to avoid their first three-game losing streak since May 7-10...The Pirates will look to remain the only team in MLB to not lose at least three in a row since May 10...Specials thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau.

FRIAR FACTS: Rowdy Tellez collected the team's first hit of the game last night with his 380-foot PITCHER double off Padres starter Dylan Cease...Tellez has hit safely in his last seven games against the Kent Tekulve Mike Williams Padres, going 11-for-23 (.478) with two doubles, four home runs and 13 RBI. Dave Giusti

START ME UP: Marco Gonzales gets the start tonight in the middle game of this series against the Padres...Pittsburgh's starters have allowed two runs in 11.2 innings in the last three games... Coming into today, the team's starting rotation has the third-lowest ERA (3.48) in all of MLB behind the Mariners (3.29) and Phillies (3.37)...Last year Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranked 24th in all of MLB in ERA (4.88).

AGAINST THE WEST: This is the second of four straight series the Pirates will play against the National League West...Following their current homestand that has the team playing the Diamondbacks and Padres, the Pirates will travel to California for a six-game road trip to Dodger Stadium and Petco Park.

PLAY RENEGADE: Since being acquired from San Diego prior to the 2021 season, David Bednar has recorded a 2.74 ERA (217.0ip/66er) and 81 saves in 212 games as a member of the Pirates.. Since the beginning of the 2021 campaign, Bednar's 81 saves are tied for the ninth-most in all of MLB while his 2.74 ERA ranks seventh among National League relief pitchers (minimum 175.0ip).

HEY 19: David Bednar has converted each of his last 19 save opportunities, which is the fourthlongest active streak in MLB...The only three pitchers with a longer active saves streak are Josh Hader (23 straight), Emmanuel Clase (20 straight) and Kirby Yates (20 straight)...The last Pirate to have a season saves streak of 19 games or longer was Felipe Vazquez in 2018 (24 straight).

MAKE THAT A DOUBLE: The Pirates have hit at least one double in 13 straight games...The only team with a longer active streak of games with a double is the Padres (15 games)...The Pirates' next-longest streak this season was 10 games in May.

HUNTING THE GOOD: Hunter Stratton tossed a scoreless eighth inning Tuesday night against the Padres...Since allowing five runs in 0.2 inning on May 23 against the Giants, Stratton has posted Bobby Bonilla Claude Ritchey Neil Walker an 0.75 ERA (12.0ip/1er) in his last 11 appearances.

STREAKING: Andrew McCutchen brings a six-game hitting streak into today...McCutchen has gone 7-for-23 (.304) with a .429 on-base percentage during his current six-game hitting streak. McCutchen hit safely in a season-high eight straight games from July 11-22.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen comes into today one RBI shy of 800 in his career as a member of the Pirates...He will become one of just seven Pirates in team history to record at least 800 RBI since 1920 when RBI became an official stat...McCutchen is tied for the fifth-most RBI (1076) among all active players along with Giancarlo Stanton...The only four active players with more RBI are Freddie Freeman (1210), Paul Goldschmidt (1165), Joey Votto (1144) and Nolan Arenado (1109).

#### **ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY**

August 7, 1999: Francisco Cordova allowed one run in 7.2 innings as the Bucs beat the Cardinals 3-1 at Three Rivers Stadium. Al Martin hit a leadoff home run and finished the game 3-for-3 while Abraham Nunez put the Pirates ahead for good in the second inning after drawing a bases loaded walk that brought home Warren Morris.

HOW ACOULTED. From the Braves in exc	hange for cash considerations on 12/5

STARTING OFF: The 32-year-old lefthander is in his first season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Braves for cash considerations on December 5, 2023... Gonzales is in his 10th Major League season, having played for the Cardinals (2014-17), Mariners (2017-2023) and Pirates (2024)...He was originally selected in the first round (19th overall) of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of Gonzaga University by the St. Louis Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT: Gonzales took the loss on July 27 at Arizona after allowing four runs on seven hits with one strikeout against three walks in 2.1 innings pitched.

BACK IN ACTION: Gonzales was reinstated from the 60-day injured list prior to his start on July 12 at Chicago-AL while recovering form a left forearm muscle strain.

Made two rehab starts with Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1 at Louisville and July 6 vs. Louisville, combining to allow five runs on seven hits with six strikeouts in 7.1 innings of work.

AGAINST THE PADRES: Gonzales will be making his third career start and appearance against the Padres, against whom he owns a 1-0 record with a 3.60 ERA (4 ER in 10.0 IP), seven strikeouts, no walks and a .302 opponents average.

- Last appeared against San Diego on Aug. 25, 2020 at Petco Park as a member of the Mariners, earning the win after he allowed three runs on nine hits with five strikeouts and no walks in 5.0 innings of work.
- His only other career appearance against the Padres came on Sept. 11, 2018 as a member of the Mariners, taking a no-decision after allowing one run on four hits with two strikeouts and no walks in 5.0 innings of work.

HOME COOKIN': Gonzales has gone 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA (4 ER in 10.2 IP), eight strikeouts against one walk in two starts this season at PNC Park...In three career starts at PNC Park, including one start as a visitor, he has gone 1-1 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER in 17.2 IP) and 12 strikeouts with one walk.

LIMITING LEFTIES: Gonzales has limited left-handed hitters to just two extra-base hits this season, both homers...Lefties are just 2-for-12 (.167) against him at PNC Park this season with no extra base hits.

In total, lefties are hitting .286 (8-for-28) against him this season...Prior to his last outing against Arizona where they went 3-for-3 against him, lefties had been hitting .200 (8-for-25) with just one extra-base hit (a home run by Kyle Schwarber on April 13 at Philadelphia).
