The Brewers have gone 23-8 over their last 31 games against the Mets, including 10-1 in the last 11 games with 5 consecutive wins.

Willy Adames and Jackson Chourio are the first teammates in franchise history to produce 20 HR/20 SB in the

Willy Do It?
Willy Adames has a franchise-record
32 HR as a shortstop this season,
breaking his own record of 31 HR in .Adames (111 RBI) needs just 2 RBI to tie **Robin Yount** (113 in 1982) for the most RBI as a shortstop in a season in franchise history.

<u>Devinly Body</u> **Devin Williams** - who missed the first four months of the season with a back stress fracture - earned his first save of the season on 8/10 vs. Cincinnati..... since that date, Williams is tied with the Guardians' Emmanuel Clase for the Major League lead in saves (14).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is the first game of a 3-game homestand against New York-NL to end the regular season.....the team is coming off a 2-1 road trip to Pittsburgh.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 45-33 at home, going 14-9-2 in series play.....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers went 46-35 on the road this season, going 15-9-2 in series play.....went 21-10 in their last 31 road games.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 43 replay challenges this season, going 25-18....their last challenge (won) came on 9/26 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base on a pickoff attempt involving Oneil Cruz was overturned.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #47 - RHP FRANKIE MONTAS (29gs, 7-11, 4.85)

MONTAS AT A GLANCE: Frankie Montas, 31, makes his 30th start of the season and 11th with the Brewers.....he last started last Sunday vs. Arizona and had no decision in a 10-9 win (2.2ip, 6h, 8r, 7er, 2bb, 4k, 3hr, 68 pitches).....his teams are 13-16 in his starts (7-3 with MIL).....he has 9 quality starts.....opponents are batting .245 (138-for-563, 23hr).....he was acquired from Cincinnati on July 30 in exchange for RHP Jakob Junis, 0F Joey Wiemer and cash.....he went 4-8 with a 5.01 ERA in 19 starts with the Reds [93.1ip, 93h, 56r, 52er, 41bb, 78k, 14hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 4/22-5/6 with a right forearm contusion.....he is 3-3 with a 4.56 ERA in 10 starts with the Brewers (53.1ip, 45h, 31r, 27er, 22bb, 64k, 9hr).....Montas is signed through the 2024 season with a mutual option for 2025.....name is pronounced "MOHN-tahs."

LAST SEASON: Montas was limited to just a single game last season with the Yankees, coming in relief on 9/30 at Kansas City.....he missed nearly the entire season while recovering from Feb. 21 right shoulder surgery.

CAREER: Is 44-46 with a 4.11 ERA in 159 games/128 starts (740.1ip, 338er).....is in his ninth Major League season with Chicago-AL (2015), Oakland (2017-22), New York-AL (2022-23), Cincinnati (2024) and Milwaukee (2024).....he pitched in the postseason with the Athletics in 2020 and 2022.....he had his best season in 2021 as he finished sixth in American League Cy Young Award voting after going 13-9 with a 3.37 ERA in 32 starts.....Montas was originally signed as a non-drafted free agent with Boston on 12/14/09.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 0-2 with a 6.50 ERA in 6 starts (27.2ip, 20er).....is 0-2 with a 5.92 ERA in 5 starts this season (24.1ip, 16er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 25-20 with a 4.55 ERA in 79 games/64 starts (356ip, 180er).....is 6-4 with a 4.75 ERA in 16 starts this season (83.1ip, 44er).

CAREER vs. METS: Is 0-0 with a 5.40 in 2 games/1 start against the Metropolitans (6.2ip, 7h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 8k, 1hr).....he made a relief appearance with the Athletics on 7/21/17 at Citi Field (1ip. 1h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr) and a start with the Yankees on 8/23/22 at Yankee Stadium (5.2ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 6k, 1hbp).
