CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 27 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 67 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.99 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 28-31 with a 3.97 ERA in 89 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST START

Littell tossed 4.2 scoreless innings and allowed four hits with two strikeouts on July 29 against the Toronto Blue Jays...He took the no-decision in the 5-2 loss.

vs. PHILADELPHIA

Littell is set to make his second career start and ninth career appearance against the Phillies...He is 1-1 with a 5.17 ERA (9 ER/15.2 IP) and nine strikeouts.

HOW ABOUT THE LAST TWO?

In his last two games, Littell has struck out seven batters and has allowed just one earned run across 9.2 innings of work.

STREAKIN'

Littell posted a six-game winning streak May 3 to June 6, tied for the second-longest winning streak in Major League Baseball at the time...He went 6-0 with a 2.27 ERA, a .197 opponents' average and just two home runs allowed in seven games during this streak..

- The six wins were tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misorowski** and Philadelphia's **Cristopher Sanchez** during the streak.

MAY FLOWERS

Littell went 5-0 in the month of May, pitching to a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with a .209 opponents' average and 19 strikeouts across six appearances.

- Was tied for first in Major League Baseball for wins in the month of May with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misorowski**.
