Major League Baseball Spring Breakout Cincinnati Reds MiLB Prospects at San Francisco Giants MiLB Prospects Thursday, March 19, 2026 - Scottsdale Stadium - 6:05 p.m. MST TV: MLB Network



THE FUTURE IS NOW: Top prospects from the **Reds'** minor-league system are set to face off against a team of prospects from the **Giants** organization in a Spring Breakout game this evening at **Scottsdale Stadium**.

- In the organization's lone Spring Breakout game last year, **Reds** prospects defeated **Brewers** prospects, 9-7, on 3/16 at **American Fields of Phoenix**...**3b Sal Stewart**, **SS Edwin Arroyo**, and **LF Ethan O'Donnell** each tripled in the win...**RHP Luis Mey** was named to the **MLB Pipeline All-Spring Breakout Second Team** for his efforts in the event...**Mey** punched out 2 batters in a perfect 8th inning.
- The **Reds** played in 2 Spring Breakout games in 2024, the event's inaugural edition, defeating **Rangers** prospects, 4-1, on 3/14 at Surprise Stadium before falling, 6-2, to a team of **Guardians** prospects on 3/16 at Goodyear Ballpark...**RHP Rhett Lowder** and **INF Carlos Sanchez** were each named to the **MLB Pipeline All-Spring Breakout First Team** for their efforts.

SPRING BREAKOUT FAQ: Introduced in 2024, **MLB Spring Breakout** is a 4-day event (3/19-3/22) that serves as a showcase for baseball's brightest minor league stars during Spring Training...all games will be played between teams comprised of each MLB organization's top prospects...tonight's contest, which will be broadcast on **MLB Network**, is the sixth of 16 **Spring Breakout** matchups to be played at Cactus and Grapefruit League stadiums.

- Roster limits consist of a maximum of 27 players and a minimum of 23...any player with remaining rookie eligibility (less than 130ab, 50ip, or 45 days on an active MLB roster) is permitted to represent his organization.
- There is no 3-batter minimum for pitchers upon entry into the game...if a pitcher is removed from a Spring Breakout game, he may re-enter later; position players can only re-enter in the event of an injury.

AT THE HELM: **AA-Chattanooga** skipper **Jose Moreno** will manage the **Reds** prospects this afternoon...joining **Moreno** on the coaching staff are **Rookie-ACL Reds** manager **Gary Van Tol**, **AAA-Louisville** coaches **Vince Harrison** and **Peterson Plaz**, hitting coaches **Daryle Ward (Louisville)** and **Troy Gingrich (A-Dayton)**, pitching coaches **Joel Bonnett (Chattanooga)** and **Jason Immekus (A-Daytona)**, athletic trainers **Stephanie McLain (Chattanooga)** and **Nicholas Briggs-Ellenberger (Daytona)**, and strength and conditioning coaches **Brennan Mickelson (Rookie-ACL Reds)**, and **Rafael Hernandez (Rookie-DSL Reds)**.

- The 2026 season will be **Moreno's** fourth as the manager at **AA-Chattanooga** and his seventh in the **Reds** organization...last year, he guided the **Lookouts** to the **Southern League North Division's** first-half title, securing their second Postseason berth in 3 years and the 14th in franchise history...during the 2024-25 winter league season, **Moreno** – a two-time manager of the year in the Venezuelan Winter League – guided **Bravos de Margarita** to their best record in franchise history, a second-place finish, and a second straight playoff berth.

DOWN ON THE FARM: **Cin's** farm system enters the 2026 season rated No. 12 overall in MLB.com's preseason rankings...ranked by **Baseball America** as the 19th-best system in baseball.

- The **Reds** enter the 2026 season with 4 representatives on MLB.com's Top 100 Prospects list: **INF Sal Stewart (22)**, **C Alfredo Duno (38)**, **INF Steele Hall (83)**, and **RHP Rhett Lowder (86)**...**Stewart (23)**, **Duno (77)**, and **Lowder (79)** are also featured on **Baseball America's** respective list.
- Sixteen of MLB.com's Top 30 **Reds** prospects entering the 2026 season are represented on the club's **Spring Breakout** roster, including 8 of the top 10 players...the roster also features 18 of **Baseball America's** Top 30 **Reds** prospects entering the 2026 campaign, including 7 of the top 10 players.

MVP! MVP!: **INF Sal Stewart** and **C Alfredo Duno** were named Most Valuable Player of the Southern League and Florida State League, respectively, for their efforts during the 2025 season.

- At the time of his promotion to **AAA-Louisville** on 7/18, **Stewart** led the Southern League with a .306 batting average, while also ranking second in OPS (.850) and total bases (139) and third in hits (90), doubles (19), and slugging percentage (.473)...later made his Major League debut with the **Reds**, appearing in 18 regular season games and in both games of the National League Wild Card Series at **LAD**.
- Duno**, who spent the entire 2025 season with **A-Daytona**, led the Florida State League in in doubles (32), home runs (18), extra-base hits (52), RBI (81), on-base percentage (.430), slugging percentage (.518), OPS (.948), walks (95), total bases (202), and runs scored (78)...**Duno** was also recognized as the FSL's August Player of the Month and was named the league's Player of the Week 3 times.
- Stewart** and **Duno** also represented the **Reds** organization at the **2025 All-Star Futures Game** at Truist Park in Atlanta, GA, entering as defensive replacements in the 5th and 6th innings, respectively.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Several **Reds** farmhands were named to their respective league's All-Star Teams this past season...**OF Rece Hinds** was recognized as an International League All-Star after becoming the second player in **AAA-Louisville** history to record a 20+HR/20+SB season...**INF Sal Stewart**, **OF Héctor Rodríguez**, and **RHP Trevor Kunc** represented **AA-Chattanooga** on the Southern League All-Star Team...**C Alfredo Duno** and **INF Carlos Sanchez** earned Florida State League All-Star honors for their efforts with **A-Daytona**...**INF Tyson Lewis** was honored as an Arizona Complex League All-Star in his first season as a professional...**RHP Dony Aguilera** was named to the Dominican Summer League All-Star Team.

READY FOR THE BIG STAGE: Two of **Cin's** 4 full-season affiliates qualified for Postseason play in their respective leagues this past season...**AA-Chattanooga** reached the Postseason for the second time in 3 years and for the 14th time in club history, where it fell, 2 games to 1, to eventual champion **Birmingham** in a best-of-3 Southern League Division Series...**A-Daytona's** second consecutive trip to the Postseason culminated in its first Florida State League Championship Series appearance since 2018, where it was swept by **Lakeland**, 2 games to 0.

FALL-BALL HEROES: Four members of the **Reds** organization were named to the **2025 Arizona Fall League Fall-Stars Game** for their efforts with the **Peoria Javelinas**: **INF Leo Balcazar**, **INF Cam Collier**, **C Alfredo Duno**, and **RHP Rhett Lowder**...**Duno** hit 3 home runs and recorded 6 RBI in Peoria's Arizona Fall League Semifinal Game against Scottsdale, helping the Javelinas advance to the league's championship game...**Balcazar** ranked among Arizona Fall League leaders in hits (26, T3rd) and doubles (6, T5th)...**Collier** slashed .221/.368/.325 with 5 doubles, 14 RBI, and 16 walks across 22 games...**Lowder** went 1-1 with a 5.00 ERA in 4 starts.

CLASS OF 2025: **Cin's** Spring Breakout roster includes 7 of the club's selections from the 2025 MLB Draft: **SS Steele Hall** (1st round, No. 9 overall), **RHP Aaron Watson** (2nd round, No. 51 overall), **RHP Mason Morris** (3rd round, No. 83 overall), **OF Mason Neville** (4th round, No. 114 overall), **OF Eli Pitts** (5th round, No. 145 overall), **OF Kien Vu** (9th round, No. 264 overall), and **INF Ty Doucette** (10th round, No. 294 overall).

- Morris** (2gs), **Neville** (23g), and **Vu** (23g) each made their professional debuts with **A-Daytona** in 2025.

- Also finished the year ranked among all Reds farmhands in on-base percentage (.442, 3rd), OPS (.899, 7th), batting average (.295, 8th), and walks (54, T8th).

- Spent the entire 2025 campaign with AA-Chattanooga...ranked among Southern League leaders in doubles (23, T3rd), batting average (.284, 4th), hits (132, T4th), triples (4, T4th), total bases (172, 7th), runs (63, 8th), and OPS (.716, 10th).
- Missed the entire 2024 regular season after undergoing surgery to repair a torn labrum in his left shoulder on 3/20...suffered the injury in the 4th inning of a Spring Training game against the Giants on 3/13 at Scottsdale Stadium.

- Following the 2025 campaign, played for the Arizona Fall League's Peoria Javelinas and was named to the Fall Stars Team.
- Originally signed by the Reds as an international free agent on 1/15/21.

- In 2025, was limited to just 85 games between A-Dayton and AA-Chattanooga after undergoing surgery to repair the ulnar collateral ligament in his left thumb on 3/13...suffered the during a Spring Training game on 3/2 at Chc.
- With A-Dayton in 2024, was recognized as a Midwest League Postseason All-Star and the Reds' Minor League Position Player of the Year...was also honored as *Baseball America's* Reds Minor League Player of the Year.

- Attended Felix Varela Senior High School (FL), where as a senior in 2024 was recognized by the Miami Herald as the Miami-Dade County Class 7A-6A Pitcher of the Year after posting a 6-1 record with a 1.00 ERA and 74 strikeouts.

- In 2025, recognized as the Reds' Minor League Position Player of the Year...also named the Florida State League Most Valuable Player, selected to the league's All-Star Team, and tabbed as the FSL's top MLB prospect.
- With A-Daytona this past season, led the Florida State League in doubles (32), home runs (18), extra-base hits (52), RBI (81), on-base percentage (.430), slugging percentage (.518), OPS (.948), walks (95), total bases (202), & runs (78).
- Along with INF Sal Stewart, represented the Reds organization at the 2025 All-Star Futures Game at Truist Park in Atlanta, GA.
- Recognized as Florida State League Player of the Week 3 times, becoming the first FSL batter to earn 3 weekly honors in a single season since 2011...honored as the Florida State League's August Player of the Month.
- Following the season, played for the Arizona Fall League's Peoria Javelinas and was named to the Fall Stars Team...hit 3 home runs and recorded 6 RBI in Peoria's AFL Semifinal Game against Scottsdale, helping the Javelinas advance to the league's championship game.
- Reached base in a career-high 39 straight games from 5/23-7/21, 2025, the longest streak by a Tortugas batter since they became a Reds affiliate in 2015.
- Originally signed by Cin as an international free agent on 1/16/23...entered the 2023 season rated by MLB.com as the fourth-best international signing prospect.

#3 STEELE HALL · INF

- Selected by the Reds in the first round (9th overall) of the 2025 MLB Draft... became the first Alabama prep middle infielder to be selected in the opening round of the MLB Draft since Condredge Holloway (4th overall) in 1971.
- Enters the 2026 season, his first as a professional, rated by MLB.com as the Reds' third-best prospect and the 83rd-best overall in baseball...also enters the year rated by *Baseball America* as the Reds' fifth-best prospect, as well as the organization's fastest baserunner and top athlete.
- Attended Daphne High School and Hewitt-Trussville High School (both in AL)... as a senior at Hewitt-Trussville in 2025, named Alabama's "Mr. Baseball" after slashing after slashing .484/.554/.871 (60-for-124) with 8 homers, 5 triples, 14 doubles, 46 runs scored, and 35 RBI.
- Was the Reds' highest-selected high schooler since 2024 National League All-Star RHP Hunter Greene (2nd overall) in 2017 and highest-drafted position player from the high-school ranks since OF Austin Kearns (7th overall) in 1998.
- Rated as the 12th-best player in the draft by MLB.com and the 15th-best prospect in the draft by *Baseball America*...previously committed to the University of Tennessee.
- This spring, appeared in 4 Cactus League games with Cin as a minor league extra.

#6 KYLE HENLEY · OF

- Selected to the Reds' Spring Breakout roster for the second straight year.
- Spent the entire 2025 season with A-Daytona, where he led the Florida State League with 57 stolen bases...also ranked among league leaders in runs scored (70, 2nd), hits (101, 4th), and batting average (.267, 5th).
- Stole home twice on 5/18/25 vs St. Lucie, becoming the first full-season minor leaguer to accomplish that feat since AAA-Las Vegas' Max Schuemann on 8/17/23.
- In 2024, led the Arizona Complex League with 35 stolen bases, the most by any ACL player since Antoan Richardson (40) in 2005.
- Selected by Cin in the 14th round of the 2023 MLB Draft...attended Denmark High School (GA)...prior to being drafted, had previously committed to Georgia Tech.

#32 CADE HUNTER · C

- Spent the entire 2025 campaign with AA-Chattanooga...the 2026 season will be his fifth in the Reds organization.
- Originally selected by Cin in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft...was also a 35th-round pick of the Rockies in 2019, but did not sign.
- His father, Scott, was drafted by LAD in 1993 and played in parts of 9 minor league seasons...currently serves as the Mariners' director of amateur scouting.
- Attended Lenape High School in Medford, NJ, the same school that produced Major League pitcher Scott Schoeneweis, who pitched for Cincinnati in 2006 and won the 2002 World Series with Anaheim during his 12-year career.

#7 CARLOS JORGE · OF

AGE: 22 **HEIGHT:** 5-9 **DOB:** 9/22/03, Puerto Plata, DR
B/T: L/R **WEIGHT:** 183 **RESIDES:** Puerto Plata, DR

- Selected to the Reds' Spring Breakout roster for the third straight year.
- Enters the 2026 season rated by both MLB.com (18) and *Baseball America* (30) as one of the top prospects in the Reds organization.
- Spent the entire 2025 campaign with A-Daytona...ranked eighth in the Midwest League with 40 stolen bases, becoming just the seventh player in Dragons history to swipe at least 40 bags in a single season.
- Selected as a 2023 Florida State League Postseason All-Star after leading the league in OPS (.883), tying teammate Hector Rodriguez for the lead in triples (9), and also ranking in AVG (.295, 2nd), SLG (.483, 2nd), and OBP (.400, 3rd).
- In 2022, ranked among all Reds farmhands in on-base percentage (.405, 3rd), slugging percentage (.529, 3rd), OPS (.934, 3rd), stolen bases (27, T4th), and batting average (.261, 9th)...his 27 SB also led the Arizona Complex League.
- Signed by the Reds as an international free agent on 1/15/21.

#61 TREVOR KUNCL · RHP

- Enters the 2026 season rated by *Baseball America* as the Cin's 29th-best prospect.
- This past season, named a Southern League All-Star with AA-Chattanooga after leading the league and ranking second among all minor league pitchers with 20 saves...his 47 appearances were also tied the Southern League lead.
- In 2025, also led Reds farmhands in saves and ranked third in appearances... following the season, pitched for the Arizona Fall League's Peoria Javelinas.
- Before making his pro debut in 2025, pitched for the independent Atlantic League's Lancaster Stormers (2024) & Frontier League's Lake Erie Crushers (2022-24).
- Originally signed with the Rangers as a minor league free agent on 2/6/24...later released on 3/21.
- Played and pitched collegiately at George Washington (2018-22)...as a junior during the COVID-shortened 2020 season, began pitching exclusively.
- Attended St. Xavier High School in Cincinnati, the same school as Reds broadcaster Chris Welsh, 7-time Pro Bowler and 2026 Pro Football Hall of Fame inductee Luke Kuechly, and Charleston men's basketball head coach Chris Mack.
- Originally signed by the Reds as a minor league free agent on 10/11/24.

#9 TYSON LEWIS · INF

AGE: 20 **HEIGHT:** 6-1 **DOB:** 1/10/06, Omaha, NE
B/T: L/R **WEIGHT:** 195 **RESIDES:** Yutan, NE

- Enters the 2026 season rated by both *Baseball America* (4) and MLB.com (5) as one of the top prospects in the Reds organization...also enters the year as the organization's best power hitter, according to *Baseball America*.
- Selected to the Reds' Spring Breakout roster for the second consecutive year.
- In 2025, his first season as a professional, was named an Arizona Complex League All-Star after ranking among league leaders in total bases (100, 4th), hits (64, T4th), batting average (.340, 5th), runs scored (44, 5th), slugging percentage (.532, 6th), and OPS (.928, 7th).
- Recognized as the Reds' Minor League Player of the Month for July 2025... entered the 2025 season as the organization's best athlete, per *Baseball America*.
- Selected by the Reds in the second round (51st overall) of the 2024 first-year player draft...was rated by both MLB.com (39) and Baseball America (43) as a top-50 prospect in the draft...previously committed to the University of Arkansas.
- As a senior at Millard West High School (NE) in 2024, named the Gatorade Nebraska Baseball Player of the Year, becoming the school's sixth recipient of the award.
