RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude their three-game homestand against the Tigers tonight at Tropicana Field...after playing 13 consecutive games in 13 days, Tampa Bay will enjoy an off day tomorrow before embarking on a six-game road trip against the White Sox and Brewers from April 26–May 1.

Tampa Bay has dropped a season-high three straight games, marking its longest losing streak since a five-game skid from July 16-20, 2023.

Yesterday's loss secured the Rays first series defeat to the Tigers at Tropicana Field since Detroit swept a four-game set from June 30–July 3, 2016.

Tampa Bay has not been swept in a series since July 17-19, 2023 at Texas, and has not been swept at Tropicana Field since July 4-6, 2023 vs. Philadelphia.

The Rays are under .500 for the first time since April 8 (5-6).

Kevin Cash remains four victories shy of surpassing Joe Maddon (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader.

OPENING ACT—RHP Shawn Armstrong will serve as an opener for bulk reliever LHP Tyler Alexander in tonight's contest...the Rays went 5-1 in Armstrong's starts last season, including 3-0 when he worked as an opener (June 7 vs. MIN; July 15-G2 at KC; Sept. 30 at TOR)...they are 1-1 in his starts this season, both of which came when opening for Alexander (March 31 vs. TOR; April 14 vs. SF).

Since introducing the concept of an opener on May 19, 2018 at Angel Stadium, the Rays are 103-67 (.606) when using one, including 1-1 this season and a 12-9 mark in 2023...they are 400-283 (.586) in all other contests over that timeframe...last season, the Rays used an opener 19 times in the first half of the season compared to only twice after the All-Star break (July 15-G2 at KC; Sept. 30 at TOR).

Armstrong has been the Rays opener each of the last four times the club has utilized one dating back to July 15 (G2), 2023 at KC.

MISSED OPPORTUNITIES—Tampa Bay is 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position during the current series vs. Detroit...over their last eight games since April 16, the Rays own a .149 (10-for-67) RISP average, the third-lowest mark in the majors during that timeframe behind St. Louis (.106) and Pittsburgh (.114).

In their previous eight games from April 7-15, the Rays hit .283 (13-for-46) with runners in scoring position, the fifth-best mark in the AL.

Isaac Paredes has been Tampa Bay's most productive hitter with runners in scoring position, batting .400 (8-for-20) with 10 RBI.

Curtis Mead and Jose Siri have struggled the most among Rays batters in scoring situations, as both own a .125 (2-for-16) RISP AVG.

Overall. Tampa Bays own a .242 RISP AVG this season, ranking night in the AI.

**TROP TROUBLES**—Tampa Bay has allowed 25 HR at Tropicana Field, the most by any team at their home ballpark, with the next closest club being Toronto (18HR)...the Rays 1.52~HR/9.0IP at home is second highest in the majors behind only the Angels (1.83 HR/9.0IP).

Tampa Bay has conceded at least one home run in seven of its last eight home

lampa Bay has conceded at least one nome run in seven of its last eight nome games and in 12 of 16 overall. The Rays have allowed 16 HR over their last eight home games dating to April 13...it marks their most homers allowed at Tropicana Field during an eight-game period since conceding 16 HR from June 9-24, 2023. Tampa Bay has been outscored 81-58 (-23) in 16 games at Tropicana Field this season, including 30-19 (-11) over their last six games.

RED-HOT ROSARIO—Despite losing his career-best 14-game hitting streak last night, Amed Rosario's .346 AVG ranks fifth in the majors behind LAD Shohei Ohtani (.364), HOU Jose Altuve (.357), CLE Steven Kwan (.351) and LAD Mookie Betts (.347).

Rosario has multiple hits in eight of his last 11 games since April 12, the most by any player in the majors during that span, ahead of BAL Gunnar Henderson, NYM Starling Marte and BAL Adley Rutschman (6G each).

He is batting an MLB-best .500 (16-for-32) with two outs, ahead of teammate Isaac Paredes (.458) and MIL William Contreras (.455).

Rosario has posted a career-low 13.4 pct. strikeout rate (11SO/82PA), below his previous best of 16.6 pct. in 2022.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE—Rays batters are averaging one walk every 14.95 plate appearances, the second-highest PA/BB ratio in the majors behind Miami (15.36)...in comparison, Yankees batters are averaging one walk every 8.77 plate appearances, the lowest PA/BB ratio in MLB.

There are five batters in the majors with 75+ plate appearances and have drawn one walk or fewer, three of which are Rays: José Caballero (85PA/1BB), Harold Ramírez (92PA/1BB) and Amed Rosario (82PA/1BB)...those three are joined by MIN Byron Buxton (77PA/1BB) and CIN Christian Encarnacion-Strand

APRIL SHOWERS—In 20 April games, Randy Arozarena is batting .117 (7-for-77) with 1 XBH (2B) and 23 strikeouts...it is the lowest batting average by any MLB player in April, with the next closest being BOS Ceddanne Rafaela (.121)...Arozarena snapped an 0-for-

18 skid with a single last night.

Jose Siri has struck out in 15 straight games, the longest active streak in the majors, ahead of COL **Michael Toglia** (13G)...Siri's 38 strikeouts overall are the most in baseball, ahead of PIT **Oneil Cruz** (37SO).

MOTOR CITY MATCHUP—Tampa Bay and Detroit continue a six-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field...the Rays will travel to Comerica Park from Sept. 24-26, the first leg of their final road trip of the season before closing out the year in Boston.

The Rays earned a 5-1 season series victory over the Tigers in 2023, including a three-game sweep at Tropicana Field to open the year from March 30-April 2.

Since the beginning of the 2017 season, Tampa Bay is 15-6 (.714) vs. Detroit at Tropicana Field...overall, Tampa Bay's 26-15 (.634) winning percentage vs. Detroit since 2017 is its second highest against any AL opponent, trailing only Los Angeles-AL (33-15, .688).

DOWN ON THE FARM—Class-A Bowling Green OF Chandler Simpson has swiped 18 bags in 14 games this year, the most stolen bases in all of minor league baseball.

Simpson, rated the Ray No. 11 prospect by MLB.com, ranks among the South Atlantic League in AVG (1st, .415), OBP (1st, .523), hits (1st, 22), runs (1st, 18), OPS (8th, .938) and walks (T8th, 12).

- Rays LHP Tyler Alexander was selected by the Tigers in the second round of the 2015 First Year Player Draft out of Texas Christian University...he made 120 appearances with Detroit from 2019-2023 before being placed on waivers this past offseason
- Tigers **OF Riley Greene** hails from Orlando and attended Paul J. Hagerty High School in Oviedo, approximately a 125-mile drive from Tropicana Field.
- Tigers RHP Casey Mize, selected first overall by Detroit in 2018 First-Year Player Draft, resides in St. Petersburg during the offseason.
- Ron Cash, the late uncle of Rays Manager Kevin Cash, played two seasons in the majors with the Tigers (1973-74) and hit .297 in 34
- Tampa Bay Bench Coach Rodney Linares was originally signed by the Tigers in 1997 and spent one season in the Detroit system, hitting .228 with 10 RBI across 25 games.
- Rays Assistant Pitching & Rehab Coach Rick Knapp was the pitching coach for the Tigers under Manager Jim Leyland from 2009-11...his son, Ricky, was selected by the Tigers in the 44th round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft out of Port Charlotte High School, but opted to attend Florida Gulf Coast University.

#### TONIGHT'S OPENER: RHP SHAWN ARMSTRONG (0-1, 4.09)

- Armstrong will serve as the Rays opener for LHP Tyler Alexander. he has not allowed a run in his last three games (2.2IP). This marks his third start of the season after going 0-1 with a 6.00
- ERA (3.0IP, 2ER) in two previous starts opening for Alexander...in his last such outing on March 14 vs. SF, he allowed a 1st-inning RBIsingle, but recorded 5 of 6 outs via the SO (2.0IP, 2H, ER, 5SO).
- He made six starts last season, including four as an opener (June 7, July 15, Aug. 12, Sept. 30)...did not allow an ER in those games (12.0IP). In his career, Armstrong is 0-2 with a 1.19 ERA (22.2IP, 3ER) over 11 starts, all with Tampa Bay...the Rays are 8-3 in those games.

**TONIGHT'S OUTING**—Alexander is slated for his fifth outing, including his third relief appearance, in tonight's series finale...carries a 6.1 scoreless his third relief appearance, in tonight's series finale...carries a 6.1 scoreless inning streak into the contest...is 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA (11.1IP, 2ER) and 0.88 WHIP in his last two games (1GS) after posting an 8.68 ERA (9.1IP, 9ER) and 1.93 WHIP in his first two.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Making his second start of the campaign, Alexander worked 5.1 scoreless frames in first career start at Yankee Stadium on April 19 (5.1IP, 2H, OR, BB, 4SO)...the only hits he permitted were an infield single by **Oswaldo Cabrera** in the 3rd and a **Jose Trevino** single in the 5th...he retired 9 of his final 10 BF...marked his third career game recording 5.0+ scoreless IP (last: 7.0 on 9/19/22 at BAL).

HELLO, OLD FRIEND-Alexander will make his first career appearance against his former club this evening...he was originally selected by the Tigers in the 23rd round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft, but opted to attend TCU...the Tigers drafted him again in 2015, this time in the second round...he went on to make 120 appearances (44GS) with Detroit, pitching to a 4.40 ERA...from 2020-23, his 287.2 IP were second most among Tigers hurlers behind Tarik Skubal (379.1IP).

Detroit marks the 28th club Alexander has pitched against in his career...he has yet to face Miami and San Diego.

He went 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (9.1IP, 2ER) in six relief appearances opposite the AL Central in 2023.

**FIRST\_THINGS\_FIRST**—Alexander has posted a career-high 75.6 pct. first-pitch strike rate, up from 72.4 pct. last season...min. 75 BF, only AZ **Brandon Pfaadt** (77.0%) has a posted a higher mark in all of MLB...he has limited opponents to a .255 (13-for-55) average following a first-pitch strike vs. .316 (6-for-19) when his initial offering misses the mark.

LEFT SIDE, BEST SIDE—Alexander is holding left-handed hitters to a .115 (3-for-26) mark, but two of the three hits have been homers...right-handed hitters are batting .339 (19-for-56)...they had gone 18-for-47 (.383) in his first three outings before he held Yankees right-handers to a 1-for-9 (.111) clip in his last appearance on April 19 at NYY.

SOFT SERVE—Alexander has recorded the highest walk rate (6.7%) and second-lowest strikeout rate (17.8%) of his career, ahead of only 2022 (14.3%)...however, he has limited opponents to career lows in both average exit velocity (86.8 mph) and hard-hit rate (34.3%)...opponents have registered an average exit velocity of 77.9 mph against his sweeper, third lowest on any breaking pitch in the AL (min. 10 balls put in play) behind OAK T.J. McFarland's sweeper (73.5) and TOR Francis Bowden's curveball (76.7).

At 86.7 mph, Alexander owns the fourth-lowest average fastball velocity in the majors (min. 100 FB thrown), ahead of only CIN Brent Suter (86.1), LAA Adam Cimber (85.7) and LAD Ryan Yarbrough (85.5).

**SWINGMAN**—Of his 124 career appearances, 45 (36.3%) have come as a starter while 79 were in relief...his 40 multi-inning relief appearanes since 2020 are seventh most in the majors—he has gone 7-3 with a 3.38 ERA

2020 are seventh most in the majors—he has gone 7-5 with a 0.00 Error (117.1IP, 44ER) in those outings.

In his two starts this season, Alexander has produced a 3.72 ERA (9.2IP, 4ER)...in two outings working behind an opener, he has pitched to a 5.73 ERA (11.0IP, 7ER).

For his career, he is 4-20 with a 4.66 ERA (208.1IP, 108ER) in 45 starts vs. 8-3 with a 4.05 ERA (153.1IP, 69ER) in 79 relief appearances.
