PITTSBURGH PIRATES (71-81) vs. ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (77-75)

SEPTEMBER 19, 2024 AT BUSCH STADIUM, ST. LOUIS, MO - 6:15 CDT - GAME #153/ROAD #75

RHP LUIS ORTIZ (6-6, 3.45 ERA) vs. RHP ERICK FEDDE (8-9, 3.45 ERA)

THE PIRATES: took a 5-4 lead into the seventh inning before going on to lose 10-5 last night...Have lost five of their last six games since winning four straight from September 8-11...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 49 one-run games, which are tied for the second-most in the National League behind the Brewers (51); it's also the most one-run games for the team since playing in 51 in 2018... Have the best stolen base percentage (85.6 percent) in MLB...Have gone 22-23 against the National League Central (the team's last winning record against the NL Central came in 2018 when the team went 43-33).

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Luis Ortiz gets the start tonight in the finale of this four-game series against the Cardinals...Ortiz has recorded a 3.45 ERA (75.2ip/29er) in 14 appearances (13 starts) since making his first start of this season on June 26...Ortiz' 3.45 ERA ranks 12th in the National League during that time, while his .207 batting average against is the fifth-lowest in the National League behind Sean Manaea (.174), Dylan Cease (.181), Paul Skenes (.192) and Zack Wheeler (.197).

FOUR YOUR INFORMATION: Last night the Pirates lost their first four-game series of the season...The Bucs went 3-1-4 in their eight four-game series this season...The Pirates swept the Marlins in four games in Miami to begin the 2024 campaign...The team's other four-game series wins came at Wrigley Field from May 16-19 and against the Reds at PNC Park from August 22-25 ...Pittsburgh earned series splits at Philadelphia from April 11-14, vs. Milwaukee from April 22-25, vs. the New York Mets from July 5-8 and against the Nationals from September 5-8.

MULTIPLICITY: Nick Yorke recorded the first RBI of his career with his single in the fourth inning last night...Yorke, who is now 5-for-8 in his last two games, became the first Pirate to record two multi-hit games in the first three games of his career since Oneil Cruz did so from October 2, 2021 to June 20, 2022...The last Pirate to accomplish that in a single season was Austin Meadows from May 18-20, 2018.

NICK WITH THE STICK: Nick Gonzales comes into today with a nine-game on-base streak, which is the second-longest of his career (he reached base safely in 10 straight from September 28 of last season to May 17, 2024)...Gonzales is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with a pair of doubles and RBI during his current nine-game on-base streak.

OFF TO OHIO: The Pirates will continue their seven-game road trip when the team begins a three-game series tomorrow night at Cincinnati...Pittsburgh took two of three games against the Reds in its only other visit to Great American Ball Park earlier this year from June 24-26... Pittsburgh is 7-3 against the Reds, giving the team three straight season series wins.

IKF: Isiah Kiner-Falefa doubled twice last night for the sixth time in his career and first since July 13, 2022...Kiner-Falefa has now hit safely in each of his last five starts, going 9-for-24 (.375)...He has also recorded 19 hits this month, which are tied for the 12th-most in the National League.

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, going 12-for-35 (.343)...Reynolds comes into today four hits shy of matching his career high of 169 in 2021 (his 165 hits are the fourth-most in the National League)...Reynolds' 47 multi-hit games this season are also tied for the fifth-most among all National League players this season (Ke'Bryan Hayes led the team with 40 multi-hit games in 2023).

FIRING CUBAN MISSILES: Aroldis Chapman comes into today ninth in all of MLB among relief pitchers with 92 strikeouts (Bryan Abreu and Cade Smith are tied for the MLB lead among relievers with 100 strikeouts apiece)...Chapman's 92 punchouts are the second-most in a single season by a Pirates left-handed reliever...The only Pirates southpaw reliever with more strikeouts in a single season is Rod Scurry (94 in 1982).

SAVING THE DAY: Aroldis Chapman is tied with John Wetteland for 16th all time with 330 saves...The only three southpaws in MLB history to record more saves than Chapman since saves became an official stat in 1969 are John Franco (424), Billy Wagner (422) and Randy Myers (347).

 HOW ACQUIRED: Signed by Pittsburgh as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 2, 2018

STARTING OFF: The 25-year-old righthander is in his third Major League season, which have all come as a member of the Pirates...He has made 57 career appearances (32 starts) for the Bucs, including 22 relief appearances in 2024 (13 starts)...He made the first Opening Day roster of his career with the Pirates in 2024 after making just two appearances (both starts) with the club in 2022 and 18 appearances (15 starts) over two stints with the Bucs in 2023...Ortiz was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent on October 2, 2018.

VS. ST. LOUIS: Ortiz will make his fifth appearance and fourth career start against the RedBirds...He allowed one run in 2.0 innings of relief in his only outing this year against St. Louis on July 2 at PNC Park...This will be Ortiz' second career outing at Busch Stadium...He started and lost a 13-3 decision (0.2ip/6r) on October 1, 2022.

LAST TIME OUT: Ortiz allowed seven runs (4er) in 4.0 innings while losing an 8-3 decision in his last start Friday night against the Royals at PNC Park.

CENTRAL PERK: Tonight will be Ortiz' seventh appearance (third start) within the National League Central this season...He has gone 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (20.2ip/2er) in his previous six outings.

RULING ON THE ROAD: Ortiz has recorded a 2.84 ERA (57.0ip/18er) in 17 appearances (six starts) on the road this season...He allowed one hit over 6.0 shutout innings in his last outing away from PNC Park on August 31 at Cleveland.

ZERO TOLERANCE: Ortiz had his career-best scoreless streak of 16.0 innings end in his September 7 start against the Nationals...It's the third-longest scoreless streak by a Pirate this season...Bailey Falter had a team-best scoreless streak of 19.2 innings from May 12-24 while Dennis Santana had a scoreless streak of 19.1 innings that came to an end on Monday here in St. Louis...Ortiz also had a scoreless streak of 12.0 innings earlier this year from July 2-13.

FOR STARTERS: Tonight will be Ortiz' 33rd career Major League start and his 14th of the season....He made his first start of the season on June 26 at Cincinnati, where he allowed one run in 6.0 innings while winning a 6-1 decision...In his first four starts of 2024, he posted an 0.73 ERA (24.2ip/2er)...In his last nine starts, he has recorded a 4.78 ERA (49.0ip/26er).

WHAT THE METRICS SAY: Ortiz ranks in the 93rd percentile in Fastball Run Value according to Baseball Savant...He has limited opposing hitters to a .185 batting average against (24-for-130) when using his four-seam fastball this season.

2023 RECAP: Ortiz had two different stints with the Pirates last season, going 4-5 with a 4.93 ERA (73.0ip/40er) in his 15 starts and 1-0 with a 3.95 ERA (13.2ip/6er) in three relief appearances.

- Pitched with the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic, making one appearances and striking out three batters in 2.0 scoreless innings.
