YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers snapped a 5-game losing streak in a 4-3 victory against the Padres in Phoenix.....a 3-3 tie was snapped in the eighth inning on a homer by LF Brewer Hicklen.....2B Owen Miller went 1-for-1 with a 2-RBI single.

THE ROSTER: The team opened Cactus League play with 58 players in Major League camp: 31 pitchers, 6 catchers, 13 infielders and 8 outfielders.....there are 18 non-roster invitees; 11 pitchers, 2 catchers, 4 infielders and 1 outfielder.

2023 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 92-70 and qualified for the postseason for the fifth time in the last six seasons..... the team won the NL Central for the third time in the last six seasons, taking the division by 9.0 games over the Cubs..... the Brewers were defeated by Arizona, two games to none, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last six full seasons (does not include 2020).....the Brewers have 573 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in seven consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.... his only other Major League managerial experience came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.

TODAY'S STARTER: #56 - RHP JANSON JUNK

RHP Janson Junk, 28, spent most of last season at Triple-A Nashville, where he went 7-10 with a 4.18 ERA in 27 games (25 starts).....he also had two stints with Milwaukee (4/11-4/12 and 10/1-end of season).....Junk was acquired from Los Angeles-AL as part of the deal for OF Hunter Renfroe on 11/22/22.....he was originally selected by the Yankees in the 22nd round of the First-Year Player Draft and was traded to the Angels on 7/30/21.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Devin Williams, 29, went 8-3 with a 1.53 ERA and 36 saves in 61 relief appearances last season to earn his second career NL Reliever of the Year Award (also 2020).....he was an All-Star for the second consecutive season and was named to the All-MLB Second Team for the second time (also 2020).

RHP Joel Payamps, 29, went 7-5 with a 2.55 ERA and 3 saves in a career-high 69 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee.....his 28 holds tied for second in the National League.....opponents batted just .219.

LHP Aaron Ashby, 25, missed all of last season with a left labrum tear.....he underwent surgery last April 7.....Ashby, selected in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, is signed through the 2027 season with club options for 2028 and 2029.....he entered the 2022 season as the top prospect in the organization (*Baseball America*).

LHP Bryan Hudson, 26, was acquired from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for LHP Justin Chambers and a player to be named or cash on Jan. 3....he made his Major League debut last season with the Dodgers, making 6 relief appearances.....Hudson was selected by the Cubs in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.

RHP Jacob Misiorowski, who turns 22 on April 3, enters the 2024 season as the second-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.....over his Minor League career (2022-23), he has held opponents to a .169 batting average with 113 strikeouts in 73.0 innings....Misiorowski was selected in the second round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from Crowder (MO) College, the same school as Aaron Ashby.
