RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Detroit Tigers conclude a three-game Interleague series with today's finale at Comerica Park ... The Cardinals have won consecutive road series, taking two of three at Oakland (April 15-17) and then this weekend at the New York Mets at Citi Field to begin the road trip ... Last September, St. Louis won three straight road series at Atlanta (Sept. 5-7), Cincinnati (Sept. 8-10) and Baltimore (Sept. 11-13).

MADNESS IN THE MOTOR CITY: With a win today, the Cardinals will have won their first regular season series ever at Comerica Park and only their second in the city of Detroit following the inaugural Interleague matchup from June 4-6, 1999 at Tiger Stadium (2-1 series record).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis opens today in 4th place in the National League Central, 4.5 games behind first place Milwaukee (18-11) and 2.0 games back of Cincinnati (16-14) for 3rd place ... Today is the Cardinals 19th road game of the season, tying the Yankees for 2nd-most in MLB behind the Pirates (20).

JUNIOR CIRCUIT JUGGERNAUTS: The Cardinals are 245-239 all-time in Interleague play, with a .506 win pct. that trails only Los Angeles (.540) and Atlanta (.508) among National League clubs ... Dating back to last July, St. Louis has won or tied its last six road series against American League opponents, last dropping two-of-three at Globe Life Field against the future World Series Champion Texas Rangers (June 5-7, 2023).

THE MAN WITH THE GOLDEN GUN: Paul Goldschmidt is batting .377/.456/.739 (26-69) lifetime vs. Detroit, with 11 extra-base hits and 19 runs scored in 18 career games ... In his last six games, Goldy is slashing .519/.552/1.185 (14-27) with five home runs and three doubles ... Goldschmidt has also hit safely in all six career games at Comerica Park (.440/.462/.600, 11-25).

WHIFF: In the first game of yesterday's doubleheader, the Cardinals struck out a season-high 15 times in their 2-1 win ... The last time St. Louis struck out 15 or more times in a nine-inning victory was August 16, 2016 at Houston's Minute Maid Park, as the Redbirds whiffed 15 times but won 8-5.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Since Interleague play began in 1997, St. Louis Cardinals designated hitters have produced a combined .789 OPS, 4th-highest coming from the designated hitter position behind Boston (.868), Cleveland (.810), and Philadelphia (.795).

DAY TRIPPERS: The Cardinals are playing their 15th day game of the season today, making up 48% of their contests ... This season, St. Louis is 4-10 in the daytime, while the Tigers are 10-9 ... The Cardinals are scheduled to play 29 home day games this season and 34 on the road ... Detroit leads Major League Baseball with its 22nd day game of the season today.

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Cardinals lead the NL in save pct. (84.6%) and holds (24), share the NL leads in saves (11), and rank 4th in ERA (3.70) and WHIP (1.25), while their ERA (2.49) from the start of the 7th inning through the end of the game ranks 2nd in the NL.

- LHP **JoJo Romero** and RHP **Andrew Kittredge** share the MLB lead with 10 holds this season.
- RHP **Ryan Helsley** leads MLB in games finished (15), and shares the league lead in both saves (10) and appearances (16).

CARLSON CONTINUES RECOVERY: Outfielder **Dylan Carlson** began an injury rehabilitation assignment with Memphis (AAA) last night, going 0-for-1 with a pair of walks from the designated hitter position against Charlotte (AAA-White Sox) ... Carlson has missed the first 30 games of the season with a left shoulder AC sprain after colliding with **Jordan Walker** on a fly ball against the Chicago Cubs in a Cactus League Spring Training Game on March 25 in Mesa, Ariz.

PALM ROYALE: Due to a rainout last night, **Dave Vonderhaar** will work his 1,000th home game as Clubhouse Manager for the Palm Beach Cardinals today when they play the first game of a doubleheader at 4:00 pm ET against the Daytona Tortugas (A-Reds) ... Vonderhaar, the 2023 George Kissell Award winner, also supervises the Cardinals minor league equipment distribution for the four minor affiliates and minor league Spring Training ... Vonderhaar began with Palm Beach in 2010, taking over for a line of managers that included **Ernie Moore**, **Buddy Bates**, and **Brett Stang** back to when the franchise was established in 2003 ... Dating back to 2000, the Cardinals have not had a clubhouse manager work 1,000 straight home games with a single affiliate.

DETROIT CONNECTIONS

Lars Nootbaar made his MLB debut vs. Detroit (June 22, 2021)...Tripled off **Matt Manning** for his first MLB hit (June 23, 2021).

Tigers Special Assistant **Jim Leyland** spent six seasons (2000-05) as a scout for the Cardinals, scouting NL clubs from Pittsburgh and AL clubs from Cleveland.

Tommy Edman was born in Pontiac, Mich...grew up a Tigers fan while living in Michigan in the 1990s...His father, John, attended graduate school at the University of Michigan and was a volunteer assistant coach for the Wolverines.

Jack Flaherty was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#34) of the 2014 MLB Draft...pitched parts of seven seasons with the Cardinals (2017-23)...traded to Baltimore at the 2023 MLB Trade deadline for **César Prieto**, **Zack Showalter**, and **Drew Rom** (Aug 1, 2023).

Alex Lange graduated from Lee's Summit West High School...Selected by the Cubs in the 1st round (30th overall) of the 2017 MLB Draft, which was received from St. Louis in compensation for the signing of free agent **Dexter Fowler**.

Matt Vierling was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College High School in St. Louis...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 30th round of the 2015 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Notre Dame...attended the 2013 World Series at Busch Stadium.

Tigers Special Assistant to the President of Baseball Operations **Kirk Gibson** was **Paul Goldschmidt's** first MLB manager in Arizona (2011)...originally selected in the 7th round of the 1978 NFL Draft by the St. Louis Football Cardinals.

Carson Kelly was selected by the Cardinals in the 2nd round of the 2012 MLB Draft...played parts of three seasons in St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged with **Luke Weaver**, **Andrew Young**, and 2019 Competitive Balance Rd B pick to the Diamondbacks for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018).

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was born in Highland Park, Mich...originally selected by the Cardinals Cardinals in the 1st round (#10) of the 1967 MLB Draft from Southfield (Mich.) High School...attended the University of Michigan and Wayne State in his offseasons.

Sacramento natives **Dylan Carlson** (33rd) and **Matt Manning** (9th) were both selected in 1st Rd. of the 2016 MLB Draft...Both grew up in the same neighborhood and played little league together.

Tigers Bullpen Catcher **Chris Chinea** was drafted by St. Louis in the 17th round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played spent five seasons in the Cardinals organization (2015-19).

Shelby Miller pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2012-14)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the first round (19th overall) in the 2009 MLB Draft.

Buddy Kennedy attended 2024 Spring Training with St. Louis before being claimed off waivers by Detroit (Feb. 29, 2024).

Tigers Hitting Coach **Michael Brdar** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 36th round of the 2017 MLB draft...played the 2017 minor league season with the GCL Cardinals.

Cardinals Sr. Director of Communications **Brian Bartow** is a native of Battle Creek Mich...graduated from Ferris State University in Big Rapids, Mich.

TODAY'S GAME

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 7th start of the season and his 157th career (185th appearance).
- Is one of 13 active Major League pitchers with 180 appearances and 150 starts who has faced 29 different MLB opponents, but the only one of the 13 who has not faced the Tigers as their final opponent. - *Elias Sports Bureau*
- In his 146 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 59-29 when throwing 6.0 or more innings, while the Cardinals are 22-36 when throwing 5.2 innings or less.
- Is 23-24 in his 72 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal, with 42 Quality Starts. The Cardinals are 40-32 in those games.
- Mikolas is an amazing 44-4 (.917 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 58-13 in those 71 games). He's just 8-46 (.148) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 23-53).
- His loss vs. MIL (4/20) was his 1st ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Has entered his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (859.1), wins (51), strikeouts (631) and games started (145) for St. Louis; trailing only **Lance Lynn** in all categories.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee. Was the first Cardinals pitcher since **Chris Carpenter** had 35 in 2009 to do so.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is one of two pitchers (**Erick Fedde**) with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.988) since 2018 (min. 100 TC).

- Threw 5.2 innings allowing two runs, one on a Tomas Nido home run and an RBI double by J.D. Martinez, in a 4-2 win at Citi Field. Moved back to .500 in his career. Tied his season-high with five strikeouts.
- His five strikeouts moved him into 27th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history passing Howie Pollet (635) with 636.

- Earned his first career win against the Mets (4/26t) at Citi Field, his 17th different active Major League stadium with 5.2 innings allowing two runs. His second straight start without a walk issued, first time in consecutive starts since July 8-17, 2023.
- Notched his 1st win of the season, besting the Padres and **Yu Darvish** by a 5-2 score on April 2 at PETCO Park. It was his 1st win in San Diego since May 10, 2018, and marked the 6th quality start among seven career starts against his former team.
- His loss on 4/20 vs. MIL was his 1st ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Was 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA in five Grapefruit League starts this spring. He led the staff in IP (21.0) and starts (5) and co-led in wins (2) and strikeouts (15).

CAREER

- Two-time National League All-Star (2018 and 2022). Did not appear in the 2022 contest at Dodger Stadium and chose to miss the 2018 game in Washington D.C. to be with his wife as they welcomed twins.
- St. Louis is 80-66 (.548) in his 146 career outings (145 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Has registered 32 or more starts in every season in which he was not injured or sidelined by COVID-19 protocols.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only **Clayton Kershaw** (67.6%) for the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.0%.
