THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals open a seven-game road trip over eight days in the Golden State with the first of four games with the San Diego Padres at Petco Park. The Cardinals lost to the Brewers 6-2 yesterday to split a two-game, rain-shortened series, part of a 17-game scheduled stretch without a day off, until Tuesday's rain out. The Cardinals have won 7 of their last 9 games and trail only the Cubs (8-1), Phillies (8-1) and Rays (8-1) for best record since April 27.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today at 21-15 and in 2nd place in the National League Central, 3.5 games behind first place Chicago. The Cardinals have the 5th-best record in the National League, one game behind tonight's opponent San Diego (22-14). The 2021 season was the last time the Cardinals posted a winning percentage of .583 or better through 36 games at 22-14 (.611).

ROAD FIX: The Cardinals enter on a four-game road winning streak after sweeping a four-pack from the Pirates at PNC Park to conclude April. The Cardinals are 11-5 (.688) on the road this season with two series sweeps and three series wins. Only the Atlanta Braves have a better road record (14-6, .700) in MLB this season.

RILED UP: This weekend's series features two of the top closers in Major League Baseball in the Cardinals' **Riley O'Brien** and the Padres' **Mason Miller**. The two rank 1st (Miller - 11) and 2nd (O'Brien - 10) in saves among National League firemen. Both boast a pitch arsenal with numerous pitches at 99 MPH or above with Miller posting a league-best 40.7% (99 of 243 pitches) with O'Brien ranking 10th at 20.6% (53 of 257 pitches). O'Brien ranks in the Top 10 in Sinker (98.3 MPH) and Slider (91.6 MPH) velocity.

GETTING TO FIRST BASE: Cardinals catcher **Iván Herrera** has reached base safely in a career-high 22 straight games, the 4th-longest active streak in MLB behind **Nick Kurtz** (30, ATH), **Ian Happ** (27, CHI) and **Ronald Acuña, Jr.** (23, ATL). This is the Cardinals longest on-base streak since **Willson Contreras** rank off 27 last season about this time (Apr. 17-May 16). Over the last five years, 12 Cardinals have ran off on-base streaks of 20 or more games with **Paul Goldschmidt's** 46 in 2022, the longest since 2014.

BOOK THE ROOK': Rookie second baseman **JJ Wetherholt** is off to a blazing start leading all MLB rookies in runs (28, 1st) and go-ahead RBI (8, 1st); and ranking in the Top 10 in home runs (7, 4th), RBI (18, T-6th), hits (33, T-5th), doubles (5, T-7th), walks (18, 4th), total bases (59, 7th) and games played (36, T-4th). Wetherholt has played in all 36 Cardinals games this season and the only one he did not start, was the only game the Cardinals were shutout this season (4-0 at DET, April 3).

THE CALIFORNIA FIVE: This season, along with all even years, the Cardinals will play road games at all five California locations starting with the Padres tonight. They will travel to Sacramento to play the Athletics (May 12-14), Anaheim for the Angels (July 20-22), Los Angeles for the Dodgers (Sept. 1-3) and San Francisco for the Giants (Sept. 7-9). The Cardinals were 9-7 in their California Five road matchups in 2024.

MANAGER MATH: Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** is one win away from moving past **Miller Huggins** (346) into 11th place all-time on the Cardinals managerial list with his 347 wins. The 39-year old Marmol, is the 3rd-longest tenured manager among his National League peers (**Dave Roberts**, LA & **Torey Lovullo**, ARI) and the 2nd-youngest manager in MLB. Standing next in line is Hall of Fame manager **Joe Torre** (1990-95) for 10th all-time with 351.

THE 'OUT' FIELD: Through 36 games, Cardinals outfielders lead the National League and rank 2nd in Major League Baseball with nine assists (Boston - 10). **Jordan Walker** is tied with **Jarren Duran** (BOS) for the MLB lead with four assists, one shy of his career-high in 2023. Cardinals outfielders rank 2nd in outfield arm velocity in right field (95.8 MPH) and 3rd in left field (90.0 MPH).

BROADCAST NEWS: Tonight is the first of three straight National TV appearances for the Cardinals televised on ESPN, then Apple TV Friday and FOX Saturday before Cardinals TV will have Chip Caray and Mark Sweeney on the call Sunday. Mike Claiborne and Ricky Horton will be broadcasting all seven games of this trip on KMOX radio, as John Rooney is on assignment.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Cardinals TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series...was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

Thomas Saggese was born in and resides in Carlsbad, CA...graduated from Carlsbad High School.

Ramón Urías's younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played parts of two seasons in San Diego (2018-19), where he made his MLB debut.

Brant Brown (June 15, 1996 at Wrigley), **Daniel Descalso** (Sept. 18, 2010 at Busch III), **Dustin May** (Aug. 8, 2019 at Dodger Std.), and **Brad Thompson** May 8, 2005 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Padres.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **Chaim Bloom** began his baseball career as a Baseball Operations Intern with the San Diego Padres.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Yohel Pozo was signed by San Diego as a minor league free agent in Nov. 2020, before the Texas Rangers re-acquired him by selecting him in the Triple-A phase Rule 5 Draft 23 days later.

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

Jon Jay played the 2016 season with San Diego...traded by St. Louis to the Padres for **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville's** brother, **Andrew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Coach **Nick Punto** played 63 games for St. Louis in 2011 and was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions.

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebbbs** from the Padres for **Heathcliff Slocumb** and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Cardinals 26-year-old Opening Day southpaw starting pitcher makes his team-leading 8th start of the season tonight.
- Tonight's game marks his 128th career Major League appearance and his 61st career start.
- Has departed with the lead in each of his last three starts. Sports a 1-1 record, but the Cardinals are 5-2 in his seven starts this season.
- The Cardinals are 15-15 in his 30 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 11-10 with a 3.93 ERA (151.0 IP/66 ER) with 10 quality starts.
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first five starts this season before a 3.1 IP outing on 4/25 vs. SEA, his shortest start since 7/11/25 at ATL (3.0 IP)

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, May 1 vs. Los Angeles Dodgers at Busch Stadium): W, 7-2; 5.2 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 4 SO, 0 HR, 96 pitches).

- Exited with two outs in the 6th inning and runners on second and third with the Cardinals leading 4-2.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP on 4/25 vs. SEA as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He is the lone Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau thus far.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Henge**.
- Is a career 14-22 with a 4.83 ERA (289.0 IP) in his 60 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- Has limited left-handed batters to a .249/.306/.382 (93-374) with a .688 OPS average over his Major League career.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. SAN DIEGO:

- Making his 3rd career start against the Padres (8th app.) after five relief appearances between 2023 & 2024.
- Is 0-3, 2.57 ERA career in his 7 games (2 starts) vs. SD with a pair of Holds.
- Has lost both starts vs. the Friars, which were back-to-back assignments in 2025 on July 26 and Aug. 1. Pitched 4.1 innings and received just one run of suport in both outings.
- Career 0-2 with a 4.50 (6.0 IP) and three strikeouts in three games (two starts) at Petco Park.
- Was unscored upon in his 1st three career outings against the Padres at Busch Stadium, allowing just 1 hit over 3.2 IP.
- His lone HR allowed to Padres batter was to **Manny Machado** on Sept. 22, 2023 at Petco Park (2-run HR in 8th to break 2-2 tie). Has not allowed a longball in his last 6 app (59 BF).
