RAY REPORT-The Rays continue a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-
3), Kansas City (1-2) and Oakland (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Fieldfollowing the
homestand, Tampa Bay will meet AL East-leading Baltimore seven times in 11 days from
May 31-June 10, traveling to Camden Yards for a three-game set (May 31-June 2) and
a four-game series at Tropicana Field from June 7-10sandwiched between the seven
games are true off days (May 2 and 6) and a true-game set at Miami (May 4-5)

on Sunday afternoon, the Rays ended a season-high six-game losing skid while denying the Royals not only a ninth straight overall win, but Kansas City's first series sweep of Tampa Bay at Tropicana Field since Aug. 21-23, 1998.

The Rays earned their 13th comeback victory on Sunday, fifth most in the AL behind Baltimore/Detroit/New York (15G) and Cleveland (14G).

After entering as a pinch hitter, Richie Palacios played the final 2.0 innings of the game at shortstop, marking his first MLB action at the position...he last played shortstop with Rookie-level Mahoning Valley in 2018 as a Cleveland farmhand. Tampa Bay has scored five runs or fewer in nine straight games dating back to May 17, marking its longest streak since a 13-game stretch from July 15 (G2)-29, 2023...the Rays have registered eight hits or fewer in seven straight games, their longest run since July 1-8, 2023...they have not had a streak of eight straight games with eight hits or fewer since Sept. 1-10, 2020 (8G). games with eight hits or fewer since Sept. 1-10, 2020 (8G).

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games since April 28, hitting .341/.441/.518 (29-for-85) with 6 2B, 3 HR, 13 RBI, 14 BB and 13 SO... he ranks among AL leaders during that span in OBP (3rd) and AVG (3rd)...Paredes has

he ranks among AL leaders during that span in OBP (3rd) and AVG (3rd)...Paredes has reached safely in 33 of his last 36 games overall since April 14, posting the AL's second-best average over that timeframe (.326/43-for-142) behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.340).

Paredes is batting .284 (31-for-109) with 5 2B, 5 HR and 14 RBI with two strikes...
min 50 AB, his .284 two-strike average leads the AL and ranks fourth in the majors behind LAD Mookie Betts (.298), STL Masyn Winn (.294) and SD Luis Arraez (.290)...Paredes' 31 hits with two strikes are tied with Betts for second most in the majors, trailing only HOU Jose Altuve (32H).

DAWGS GOTTA EAT—Brandon Lowe has hit safely in 10 straight games against Oakland dating to May 8, 2021, batting .378 (14-for-37) with 1 2B, 5 HR, 14 RBI, six walks and 12 runs...he has homered in back-to-back games against the Athletics (April 8-9, 2023)... with a home run tonight, Lowe would join Carlos Peña (Aug. 13, 2008–April 24, 2009) as the only players in franchise history to homer in three straight games vs. the Athletics.

With a hit tonight, Lowe can tie Rocco Baldelli (11G - Sept. 6, 2003–April 29, 2007) for the second-longest hitting streak by a Tampa Bay batter vs. Oakland in franchise history, trailing only James Loney (12G - April 21, 2013–May 22, 2015).

Lowe's eight career home runs and 23 RBI against Oakland are both his highest totals against any non-divisional opponent.

AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL—Tampa Bay pitching has conceded 71 home runs, second most in the majors behind Chicago-AL (77HR)...the Rays have allowed at least 1 HR in a season-high seven straight games, the third-longest active streak in the majors behind Washington (9G) and Cleveland (8G).

Tampa Bay has not allowed 1+ HR in eight straight games since Sept. 11-22, 2023 (11G).

The Rays have allowed 46 HR at Tropicana Field (32G), the most by any club at their home ballpark, with the next closest team being the Padres (42HR/30G).

The 46 HR allowed through 32 home games are tied with the 2004 Devil Rays for second most in franchise history ahead of only the 2000 Devil Pays (54HP).

NOW AND THEN—In seven games since May 19, a stretch in which Tampa Bay is 1-6, the Rays have struggled at the plate...this follows a seven-game stretch from May 12-18 in which the Rays went 5-2 and saw greater offensive success.

PECKING ORDER—Opposing nine-hole hitters are batting .275 against Tampa Bay, the highest mark in the majors, with the next closest teams being Philadelphia (.261) and Houston (.254)...the Rays have surrendered 6 HR to nine-hole hitters, tied with Chicago-AL, New York-AL and St. Louis for the most in the majors.

Conversely, Tampa Bay has limited opposing clean-up hitters to a .198 clip. the best mark in the majors, ahead of Los Angeles-NL (.199) and Philadelphia (.200).

WHAT'S THE DIFF?—The Rays -47 run differential is third worst in the AL, better than only the Athletics (-63) and White Sox (-120)...it signals their lowest mark through 54 games since 2007 (-78)...Tampa Bay's -28 run differential through 32 home games is also its worst since 2007 (-37).

POWER OUTAGE-The Rays 43 HR are second fewest in the majors, ahead of only Chicago-AL (38)... Tampa Bay has not produced a multi-homer effort in 11 straight games since May 15, its longest such drought since a 13-game streak from Sept. 19–Oct. 2, 2022... after hitting a franchise-record 53 HR through 32 games at Tropicana Field in 2023, the 2024 club has hit 29 HR in 32 home games, its fewest since 2015 (also 29HR).

BATTLE OF THE BAYS—Tampa Bay and Oakland kick off a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the Rays and A's will meet in Oakland for a four-game set from Aug. 19-22.

Tampa Bay took five of seven games from Oakland in 2023, including a three-game sweep at Tropicana Field from April 7-9 as part of its modern era-record-tying 13-game winning streak to open the season.

From Sept. 5, 1998—Sept. 5, 2003, Tampa Bay went 7-39 (.152) against Oakland...in 151 games since, the Rays have posted a 75-76 (.497) mark against the Athletics.

<u>DOWN ON THE FARM</u>.—Yesterday, it was announced that RHP Trevor Harrison was named Florida Complex League Pitcher of the Week for the week of May 20-26...on May 23 ys. the FCL Orioles, Harrison threw 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering one hit with no walks and seven strikeouts.

Harrison, 18, was selected in the fifth round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of J.W. Mitchell HS (FL).

TONIGHT'S START—The right-hander will take the mound for his 11th **10NIGHTS START**—I he right-hander will take the mound for his 11th start of the season, including his seventh at home...has recorded a 4.19 ERA (34.1IP, 16ER) in his last six starts compared to 2.14 (21.0IP, 5ER) in his first four...has a 2.60 ERA (17.1IP, 5ER) in his last three home starts...has thrown 5.0+ IP in seven straight and nine of his 10 starts overall...is starting on six more days' rest for the fourth time this season, having posted a 2.60 ERA (17.1IP, 5ER) and 0.92 WHIP in the previous three outings.

LAST TIME OUT—Littell fell one out shy of a quality start for the third time this season in the Rays 5-2 home loss to the Red Sox on May 21 (ND, 5.2IP, 3H, 2ER, BB, 7SO, HR)...in the 2nd inning, allowed a two-out walk followed by a **Vaughn Grissom** RBI-single...went nine-up, nine-down in the 3rd, 4th and 5th innings before **Jarren Duran's** solo homer to lead off the 6th...threw only 77 pitches in the outing (54 strikes).

ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENTS-Littell is set to make his first career start opposite Oakland tonight...he has made nine relief appearances against the Athletics, most recently in 2021 during his stint with the Giants... he owns a 4.00 ERA (9.0IP, 4ER) across those outings, holding Oakland

he owns a 4.00 EKA (7.01F, 4EK) across those outlings, holding Cakland scoreless in six of them.

Since officially joining the Rays rotation on July 19, 2023 at TEX, Littell is 1-2 with a 2.73 ERA (26.11F, 8ER) in five starts against AL West opponents...his 2.76 ERA (45.21F, 14ER) against the division in his career (22G/6GS) is his lowest against any division.

HOMEWARD BOUND—Littell has posted a 2.59 ERA (48.2IP, 14ER) and .235 (44-for-187) opp. average in his last eight home starts dating to Sept. 7, 2023...min. 40.0 IP, it marks the seventh-lowest home ERA in the AL over that span...he has tossed 5.2+ IP in nine straight home starts since Aug. 27, 2023, the longest streak by a Ray since **Blake Snell** (10GS) in 2017-18.

PINPOINT PRECISION—Littell holds the AL's fifth-fewest walks per 9.0 IP (1.46) and fifth-lowest walk rate (3.9%)...according to Elias, his free pass to NYY Anthony Rizzo on May 11 snapped a 123 BF streak without a walk, third longest in Rays history behind Corey Kluber (150, 2022) and David Price (124, 2013)...five of his nine walks have come in a total of two frames: the 1st inning on April 10 at LAA (3BB) and the 2nd on May 11 vs. NYY (2BB)...excluding his statistics in those two frames, he has produced a 1.8 pct. walk rate (4BB/200BF) in all other innings.

From April 17-May 4, he recorded 6+ SO without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...the four such starts are tied for second most in the majors behind PIT Jared Jones (5). PINPOINT PRECISION—Littell holds the AL's fifth-fewest walks per 9.0 IP

BEND, DON'T BREAK—Littell has yielded 9.76 hits per 9.0 IP, the sixth-highest mark in the AL/11th highest in the majors...his success has stemmed from his lack of walks coupled with a career-best 34.1 pct. hard-hit rate, the sixth-lowest mark in the AL behind NYY Luis Gil (29.2%), DET Tarik Skubal (29.7%), HOU Justin Verlander (30.2%), BOS Kutter Crawford (31.5%) and KC Michael Wacha (32.1%)...it has dropped 7.8 pct. compared to his 419 pct. hard-hit rate last season

his 41.9 pct. hard-hit rate last season.

Littell has thrown 55.3 pct. of his pitches in the strike zone, the fourth-highest percentage in the AL/seventh highest in MLB... opponents have swung at 53.6 pct. of his total pitches, fourth in the majors behind PIT Jared Jones (56.4%), CHC Shota Imanaga (56.3%) and SEA George Kirby (54.5%).

3RD-FRAME FEATS—Littell has not allowed a run in the 3rd inning, holding opponents to a 2-for-31 (.065) clip while permitting only three baserunners (2 2B, BB), one of which was erased on a double play...on the season, opposing hitters are batting .296 (24-for-81) against him the first time through the order vs. .213 (19-for-89) the second time through.

ROLE REVERSAL—In 2023, he went 0-1 with an 8.10 ERA (3.1IP, 3ER) in his first four relief appearances with the Rays after being claimed off waivers from the Red Sox on May 12...was on the 15-day IL from May 24-June 14 (right shoulder fatigue)...made two starts as an opener on June 29 at AZ and July 5 vs. PHI before transitioning to a full-time starting role on July 19 at TEX.

Over 14 starts, went 3-5 with a 3.41 ERA (71.1IP, 27ER) and 1.05 WHIP...in 14 relief appearances, he posted an 0-1 mark with a 6.75 ERA (18.2IP, 14ER) and 1.66 WHIP.

He became the first pitcher to be claimed off waivers mid-season and go on to make 10+ starts for a team that made the postseason since **Doug Fister** with the 2017 Red Sox (Elias).
