BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals and Atlanta Braves play the rubber game of a three-game series tonight at Truist Park ... After tonight's game, the Cardinals fly to the Windy City to face the division-rival Chicago Cubs tomorrow afternoon in the first of three over Fourth of July weekend (July 3-5) at Wrigley Field as the club honors and celebrates **Chip Caray** this six-game #ChipTrip ... A win tonight would give the Cardinals their 300th victory over the Braves since they relocated from Milwaukee to Atlanta in 1966.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.0 games behind Chicago and 8.5 games back of Milwaukee ... The Cardinals are pct. points ahead of Miami (46-41) for the 3rd NL Wild Card spot, and 3.0 games behind the Cubs and Phillies ... St. Louis (-10), Texas (-8), Cleveland (-8), and San Diego (-36) are the four MLB teams with winning records but negative run differentials.

BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST: The Cardinals are currently playing a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (1-1 at Braves; 3 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers; and 3 vs. Braves) ... St. Louis finishes the season with the 4th-hardest remaining strength of schedule (.515) behind the Pirates (.517), Reds (.533), and Mets (.534).

ROAD RAGE: St. Louis is averaging 5.21 runs per game on the road, 3rd-highest in MLB to the Dodgers (6.04) and Nationals (5.3)... **Iván Herrera's** .446 OBP and **Jordan Walker's** 41 RBI both lead all of Major League Baseball in road games.

IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY. Happy 40th birthday to manager **Oliver Marmol** & 29th birthday to utility player **Bryan Torres** ... Also celebrating birthdays today are former Cardinals OF **So Taguchi** (57) & LHP **Brett Cecil** (40).

• Until Washington hired 33-year-old **Blake Butera** before this season, Marmol had been Major League Baseball's youngest manager since taking the reigns of the Cardinals at the start of 2022 ... Oli is 3-1 on his July 2nd birthday at Philadelphia (W 2022), vs. New York Yankees (W 2023), vs. Pittsburgh (W 2024), and at Pittsburgh (L 2025).

• Prior Cardinals managers who also celebrated 40th birthdays while actively piloting the team include **Branch Rickey** (1921) and **Frankie Frisch** (1937) ... Marmol's 369 career regular season managerial wins rank 2nd in franchise history among Cardinals managers before turning age 40, trailing **Frisch's** 381 victories from 1933-37. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

• The 29-year-old Torres is currently the oldest position player on St. Louis and MLB's 7th-oldest rookie this season.

LET THE KIDS PLAY: According to *ESPN*, the Cardinals sport the youngest active MLB roster with an average age of 26.5, while the Cubs (29.9) and Braves (30.3) average MLB's top two oldest ages ... Eight current Cardinals are 25 or younger, anchored by 23-year-old rookie infielders **JJ Wetherholt** and **Blaze Jordan**.

• According to *Elias Sports Bureau* (team age weighted by playing time), the last time the Cardinals finished any season with Major League Baseball's lowest average age was **1944**, when 23-year-old **Stan Musial**, 26-year-old **Whitey Kurowski**, and 27-year-old NL MVP **Marty Marion** led the Cardinals over the Crosstown Browns in the World Series aka "Streetcar Series."

EVERYDAY IVÁN: **Iván Herrera** and Atlanta's trio of **Matt Olson**, **Austin Riley**, and **Ozzie Albies** are four of 15 Major Leaguers to have played in every one of their team's games this season ... Herrera is just the 3rd Cardinal to appear at catcher and play in each of the Cardinals first 83 games of a season following **Ted Simmons** (first 91g of 1973) and **Joe Torre** (first 112g of 1970).

ATLANTA CONNECTIONS

Chip Caray previously served as the play-by-play voice of the Braves for 20 seasons on Bally Sports South and Bally Sports Southeast (2010-22), TBS and Peachtree TV (2005-2009) and on TBS and the Atlanta Braves Radio Network (1991-1992)... his father, **Skip Caray**, was part of Braves broadcasts from 1978-2008.

Jordan Walker was born in Stone Mountain, Ga... Graduated from Decatur (Ga.) High School, where he was a 2019 and 2020 Gatorade High School Player of the Year.

George Soriano spent three weeks this offseason with Atlanta; was claimed by the Braves off waivers from Baltimore (Jan. 9, 2026) and then claimed by Washington off waivers (Jan. 30, 2026).

Kyle Leahy's uncle, **Thomas Leahy**, pitched in the Braves minor league organization (1991-93).

Blaze Jordan and **Austin Riley** graduated from DeSoto Central (Miss.) High School.

Austin Riley made his MLB debut vs. the Cardinals (May 19, 2019 at Truist Park).

Riley O'Brien's grandfather, **Johnny O'Brien**, was drafted by NBA's Milwaukee Hawks, who later became the St. Louis Hawks, and are now the Atlanta Hawks.

Cards.TV Director **Tom Mee** was selected by Atlanta in the 12th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played two minor league seasons in the Braves system (1977-78) and was teammates with **Brian Snitker**.

As compensation for **Marcell Ozuna** signing with Atlanta in 2020, St. Louis selected **Alec Burleson** in the 2nd round of the 2020 MLB draft.

JoJo Romero (Aug. 21, 2020 at Truist) and **Jon Jay** (April 26, 2010 at Busch III) made their MLB debuts vs. the Braves.

Dylan Dodd pitched three seasons (2019-21) at Southeast Missouri State University and one season with the Hannibal (Mo.) Hoots of the Collegiate Summer Prospect League.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for & managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Braves (1966-68 & 1982-84)...traded to St. Louis from Atlanta for **Orlando Cepeda** (Mar. 17, 1969).

Drake Baldwin played college baseball at Missouri State University (2020-22).

Stubby Clapp played the 2003 season for the Richmond Braves (AAA-Braves).

Braves Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** pitched his final three MLB seasons with Atlanta (1980-82).

Braves Asst. Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 2000.

Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played his final three seasons with Atlanta (1986-88).

Cardinals Communications Gameday Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2015 Media Relations Trainee for Gwinnett (AAA).

Braves Baseball Communications Trainees **Jo Ganzer** (2024-25) and **Mark Reed III** (2024) previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associates.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 16th start as a member of the Cardinals (73rd career start & 87th appearance) tonight.
- Has not pitched in 11 days, last pitching at Kansas City on June 21. Is 7-7 with a 3.85 ERA in 22 starts of starting with 6+ days since his last start in his career.
- Is looking to bounce back from his shortest start (2.0 IP-44 pitches) as a Cardinal at KC (6/21) in what was a wild 12-10 Cardinals win.
- Had his career-best 15.0 inning scoreless streak in the opening inning of his start at KC (6/21) when he allowed a pair of runs.
- Also had streak of 33.0 IP with no homers allowed snapped at KC when he allowed a 2nd inning HR to Nick Loftin.
- Since May 1st, leads Cardinals pitchers in strikeouts (55).
- Pitched 6.0 innings in every start over a four-game stretch (April 27-May 15), the longest streak of his career and tying **Michael McGreevy** for the longest by a Cardinal this season. All were quality starts.
- His four caught stealing on attempted base stealers, T-7th among NL pitchers with teammate **Matthew Liberatore** (4).
- Issued just four walks to right-handed batters among 132 RH batters faced, limiting RH batters to a .190 BA (24-126) and 2 HR.
- Joins **Nathan Church** (2024-26), **Hunter Dobbins** (2026), **Mark McGwire** (1997-2001), **Red Schoendienst** (1945-56, '61-63), and **Rex Hudler** (1990-92) as notable red-headed Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, June 21 at Kansas City): ND, W, 12-10, 2.0 IP, 6 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO, 2 HR - 44 pitches.

- Made his shortest start as a Cardinal (2.0 IP) and had both his 15.0 scoreless innings streak and 33.0 homerless IP streak snapped in a wild 12-10 Cardinals win last Sun. at Kauffman Stadium vs. KC. Took a ND in what his 1st start coming off his complete game shutout win over San Diego on 6/15.
- Threw 44 pitches in his 2.0 IP after throwing 101 pitches in consecutive starts on 6/9 at NYM and 6/15 at SD.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

BURNT ENDS: His 2.0 inning start at KC (6/21) was his shortest since 5/17/23 vs. MIN (1.2 IP) in a 7-3 Dodgers win; exited with right elbow pain.

CODE RED: Threw his first complete game and shutout vs. SD (6/15) carrying a perfect game through 6.0 innings and a no-hitter 6.1. Struck out eight batters in a 3-0 win. First Cardinals pitcher to throw a one-hit shutout at home since Jaime Garcia vs. MIL (4/14/2016).

ALMOST PERFECT: His shutout on 6/15 vs. SD saw D. May carry a perfect game into the 7th inning before a walk to Fernando Tatis, Jr., snapped it, and one batter later, a Manny Machado single through the left side broke up the no-hitter.; struck out eight batters, his 3rd-highest total of the season and threw a season-high 101 pitches for the 2nd consecutive start; it was his 2nd start this season carrying a no-hitter through 6.0 innings.

POPPING THE CORK IN NEW YORK: Fired his first scoreless start as a member of the Cardinals pitching 6.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with six strikeouts in a 7-0 'Birds win at Citi Field (6/9), running the St. Louis win streak to five games. His first win since 4/21 at MIA (7 starts).

BASEBALL HQ TOUR: Took time on June 9 to tour MLB's Central Offices while the Cardinals spent their off-day in NYC.

OH NO-NO: Took a no-hitter in the 8th inning at MIL (5/27), broken up by a **Garrett Mitchell** lead-off double, and eventually lost 2-1; Threw a season-high 7.0 IP and fanned a then season-high 9 batters; the only Brewers batsmen to reach safely before the 8th came via a HBP and catcher's interference.

DECISIONS, DECISIONS: His 2026 season has been one of streaks starting with 2-straight loses, then 3-straight wins, a career-high 4-straight losses and he currently has consecutive wins.

DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS: Has the 2nd-lowest walk percentage among Cardinals starting pitchers behind **Michael McGreevy** (6.0%) with 6.4%.

MAY'S DAY: Started on May 3 while wearing uniform No. 3, against his former team, the Dodgers, suffering 4-1 loss that snapped his 3-game winning streak.

NOCTURNAL NIGHTMARE: Has made a team-high 8 starts in Day games this season (1-6, 6.81 ERA) is 4-0 with a 2.05 ERA in his 7 Night starts.

BACK-TO-BACK JACK: Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

MILESTONE WIN: Bested his former team the Red Sox on 4/10 in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

TIGER STRIKE: Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

OPENING ACT: Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

MAY VS. ATLANTA:

- Making his 3rd start (4th app.) vs. Atlanta and his first as a member of the Cardinals.
- Pitched 5.0+ innings in each of his previous two starts, striking out six batters in each.
- Held the Braves to one unearned run on one hit over 5.0 innings (4/1/25) at Dodger Stadium in a no decision in 1 win (3-1).
- His one relief appearance was Aug. 18, 2019 at Truist Park, suffering a blown save opportunity in 2.0 innings, surrendering a home run to Rafael Ortega.
