## Arizona Diamondbacks (72-84) at San Francisco Giants (78-78) RHP Merrill Kelly (13-7, 3.13) vs. RHP Alex Cobb (6-7, 3.67)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants will be opening up their final series at Oracle Park tonight...SF will square off with the Diamondbacks in a three game series this Friday-Sunday...the Giants enter today having won nine of their last 10 games overall and eight of their last 12 contests here at home.

**EVEN STEVEN:** After defeating the Rockies 6-4 last night, SF is back at .500 for the first time since August 23 (61-61)...with just six games remaining on the Giants' schedule, they'll need to go 3-3 to finish the season at .500...a win tonight and the Giants would be above the .500 mark for the first time since August 17 (59-58).

**FINISH STRONG:** Before winning nine of their last 10 games the Giants were 69-77...they have a chance to become the third team in MLB history (and first in 97 years) to finish at or above .500 after being eight games under with 16 or fewer games left...the last team to accomplish that feat was the 1925 Cardinals who were 65-73 with 15 games left and finished 77-76 (*Stats LLC*).

**FAMILIAR FACES:** The Giants' final six games will come vs. NL West opponents, facing Arizona and San Diego...within the division, the Giants have gone 30-40 (.429) with a -20 run differential...however, San Francisco has won nine of its past 10 games within the division.

**IT'S A MARATHON NOT A SPRINT: RHP Alex Cobb** will take the mound tonight...Cobb has been stellar since the start of June posting a 2.91 ERA in 18 starts...prior to June 1, he had a 5.73 ERA in eight starts...his 2.82 drop in ERA is one of the largest by any Giants pitcher ever (*Stats LLC*).

**HE'S GOT OUR NUMBER:** The Giants face Arizona's RHP Merrill Kelly tonight who has dominated the Giants this season...in five starts against the Giants, Kelly is 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (6er, 35.1ip) and a .149 BAA...all five of his starts against the Giants this season have been quality outings...in 15 career starts against SF, Kelly is 6-3 with a 2.56 ERA and a .218 opposing batting average...he has only given up more than four earned runs in a game against SF once in his career (August 11, 2021- five runs).

**BUILT FORD TOUGH:** Yesterday **C/IF Ford Proctor** delivered an opposite field grand slam for his first career home run, something that has only happened seven times this century...the last person to do it was MIA's Jerar Encarnación on June 19 earlier this season...former Giant Cody Ross did it on September 2, 2003 while he was with Detroit...the Giants' seven grand slams this season are tied for second-most in franchise history behind the 2015 team (9) (*Stats LLC*).

**SEPTEMBER TO REMEMBER:** The Giants have posted a 17-10 record in September, clinching their first winning month since April (14-7)...since 2020, the Giants' have dominated in the month of September, ranking near the top of the Majors in numerous categories including ERA (3.48, 2nd), on-base percentage (.343, 2nd), batting average (.265, 4th), slugging percentage (.453, 5th) and runs per game (5.14, 7th)...SF's .641 winning percentage (50-28) in September since 2020 is the second-best in MLB, trailing only the Dodgers (54-23, .701)...the Giants have 38 wins in September over the last two seasons, their most in a two-year span since moving to San Francisco.

**SO YOU'RE SAYING THERE'S A CHANCE:** The Giants are still mathematically in the playoff race, entering play today 6.0 games back of the Phillies after the Phils won the first game of their doubleheader earlier today...one more SF loss or another Phillies win would eliminate SF from playoff contention.

**LIMITING THE LOGBALL:** According to *Stats LLC*, the Giants have gone 18 straight games without allowing a multiple home runs in a contest which gives them two of the four longest streaks this year...their 21 game streak from June 24 to July 16 is tied for the longest in MLB with Seattle (8/12-9/04)...if they reach 20 games it would be the first time the Giants had two separate streaks of 20 or longer in the same season since 1982, when they had three (24, 21 and 23)...the Giants' pitching staff is also on pace to lead the National League in fewest homers per 9.0 innings (0.85) in back-to-back seasons for the first time since doing so three times in a row from 2000 to 2002 (*Sports Info Solutions*).

**TODAY'S START:** Cobb is making his 27th start of the season and his 19th start since being reinstated off the 15-day injured list due to a neck strain that caused him to miss 13 games.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Cobb made his previous start last Saturday in a 5-2 loss to the Diamondbacks...Cobb hadn't allowed any runs through 3 innings but in the fourth inning he gave up five runs after a couple defensive mishaps...he ended up going 5.0 innings...eight of his last 14 starts have been quality starts, but the Giants are 4-10 in those contests.

**VS. ARIZONA:** This will be his sixth career start against the Diamondbacks and fifth this season...in five career starts he is 1-2 with a 5.88 ERA (17er, 26.0ip)...his last start was against Arizona last Saturday...he has a 4.70 ERA against the Diamondbacks this year and they are responsible for two of his seven losses.

**LOCKED IN:** In his 18 starts since returning from the IL on June 19 Cobb has a 2.91 ERA in 102.0 innings with 92 strikeouts and a .238 opposing batting average...in his last six starts, Cobb has a 2.67 ERA (10er, 33.2ip) with 31 strikeouts and 11 walks...opponents are 29-for-126 (.230) against him in that time.

**HOME COOKIN:** In 10 starts at home since coming off the IL on June 19 Cobb has gone 3-4 but posted a 1.49 ERA...that is the third-best home ERA in that span in MLB among qualified starters...overall Cobb has a 2.40 ERA at home compared to a 5.49 road ERA.

**THE WILD WEST:** Despite his success this season Cobb has had a tough time against the NL West...in 13 starts he has a 5.00 ERA (40er, 72.0ip)...against the rest of the league he has a 2.26 ERA (17er, 67.2ip) in 13 starts.

**TAKE THAT FATHER TIME:** Has logged 139.2 innings so far this year, surpassing each of his last three seasons...this comes despite two trips to the injured list this year...his career-best for innings pitched is 179.1, which came in 2017 while he was with Tampa Bay.

**LICKETY SPLIT:** Opposing batters are 62-for-252 (.246) with 55 strikeouts in at-bats ending with Cobb's splitter this season...he uses his splitter 42.8% of the time, which is the second highest usage in MLB behind ATL's Kirby Yates (48.9%).

**THE KITCHEN SINK:** Batter's are 35-for-157 (.223) with 49 strikeouts against it in his last 18 starts...batters are 58-for-233 (.249) with a .227 xBA against his sinker this season...in his last 6 starts opponents are .196 (10-for-51) with 14 strikeouts in at-bats ending with the sinker.

**OH NO, I LOST MY CONTACT:** Cobb is allowing the least amount of solid contact than at any point in his career...his hard hit percentage is 40.6% and batters are only hitting it on the sweet spot 26.1% of the time, a career best...opposing hitters' average exit velocity is 89.2 mph with their average launch angle at 1.6 degrees.

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Cobb's 1.05 ERA in the first inning ranks second in MLB (min. 25.0ip)...his 0.82 ERA in the first inning since the start of 2021 is the best in the Majors (min. 35ip).
