RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals kick off a six-game road trip tonight with the opener of a three-game weekend series against the New York Mets at Citi Field on nationally televised Apple TV+ Friday Night Baseball ... The Cardinals finished 2-4 on their recent homestand against the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers (0-3) and defending NL Champion Arizona Diamondbacks (2-1).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis opens today in 5th place in the National League Central, 5.5 games behind first place Milwaukee (16-8) and 1.5 games back of Pittsburgh (13-13) for 4th place.

PATH TO THE 10TH TITLE: The Cardinals are retracing their steps from 2006 with their current road trip through New York and Detroit ... The 2006 Cardinals captured their 10th World Series title in franchise history after eliminating the Mets in seven games in the NLCS and then beating the Detroit Tigers in five games in the Fall Classic as closer **Adam Wainwright** recorded final outs via strikeout in both series (**Carlos Beltrán** looking & **Brandon Inge** swinging).

START SPREADING THE NEWS: Despite a 24-27 all-time record at Citi Field, St. Louis enters today winners of 10 of its last 15 games in Queens while outscoring the Mets 84-71. **MEET THE METS:** The Cardinals and Mets are scheduled to play their entire six-game season series over the next 13 days (April 26-28 in Queens & May 6-8 in St. Louis).

ATLANTIC CARDS: The Cardinals are traveling East on a road trip for the first time this season ... In 2023, St. Louis went a combined 14-11 in road games at stadiums of the NL and AL East Divisions.

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Cardinals (3.56, 5th) and Mets (2.95, 2nd) rank among the top five in the National League in bullpen ERA.

- LHP **JoJo Romero**, RHP **Andrew Kittredge**, and RHP **David Robertson** share the MLB lead with eight holds this season.
- RHP **Ryan Helsley** ranks among 2024 MLB leaders in appearances (13, T-5th), games finished (12, 1st), and saves (7, T-4th).
- Since the 2022 season, Helsley and **Edwin Diaz** rank among the top five MLB relievers in ERA, average against, opponent OPS, hits/9, baserunners/9, and WHIP (minimum 70 innings pitched).

LINE DRIVES: Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn**, who made his MLB debut last September vs. the Mets, currently sports the 3rd-highest line drive percentage (38.5%) in Major League Baseball behind **Shohei Ohtani** (38.4%) and **CJ Abrams** (40.3%).

NOLAN KEEPS ROLLIN': **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 23 consecutive games since March 30, tying the injured **Christian Yelich** for the longest active on-base streak in Major League Baseball.

- Arenado's 23-game on-base streak is his longest as a Cardinal & 5th 20+ game OB streak of his career (30-straight in 2014).
- Arenado, who is the lone Cardinal to have played in all 25 games to begin the season, has reached base safely in 23 games overall (T-6th in MLB), has hits in 21 games (T-4th in MLB), and leads St. Louis in hits (28) and total bases (37).

FINEST IN THE FIELD: The Cardinals .990 fielding percentage is tied for the 3rd-highest in MLB behind Atlanta and Washington (.992), while St. Louis is one of four MLB teams with nine or fewer errors.

- St. Louis ranks 2nd in MLB in both double plays turned defensively (31) and groundball double plays induced by pitchers (28), trailing only Oakland (34 & 30) ... 1B **Paul Goldschmidt** (29), SS **Masyn Winn** (21), and 2B **Nolan Gorman** (22) all lead their respective positions in double plays across MLB.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Tommy Edman doubled off **Steven Matz** for his first career MLB hit (June 14, 2019 at Citi Field).

Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Adam Ottavino was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#30 overall) of the 2006 MLB Draft...pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2006-11)...made his MLB debut with St. Louis in 2010.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Statton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Matt Carpenter's younger brother, Tyler, played two seasons in the Mets organization (2011-12).

Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2017-22) where he won the 2021 NL Gold Glove in center field.

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Mets VP of Amateur Scouting **Kris Gross** was a Cardinals amateur scout for three seasons (2010-12).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Taylor Megill's older brother, **Trevor Megill**, was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign, returning to Loyola Marymount (Calif.) University.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Cardinals reporter **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeromy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)...attended Spring Training with New York before released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals AGM/Player Dev. **Gary LaRocque** previously served as Scouting Dir., AGM & VP/ Player Dev. and Scouting with the Mets from (1998-2005)...appointed VP of Pro Scouting in 2006.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 6th start of the season and his 156th career (184th appearance).
- Is looking to bounce back from consecutive losses when he failed to get thru the 4th inning in both games, and is also seeking his 1st ever win at Citi Field.
- Allowed a single-game high 3 HR's in his start last Sat. (4/20) vs. MIL, losing for the 3rd time this season. His career won-loss record dipped below .500 (55-56) with the loss.
- Is 23-24 in his 72 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal, with 42 Quality Starts. The Cardinals are 40-32 in those games.
- Mikolas is an amazing 43-4 (.914 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 57-13 in those 70 games). He's just 8-46 (.148) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 23-53).
- His loss last Sat. (4/20) vs. MIL was his 1st ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Has entered his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (859.1), wins (51), strikeouts (631) and games started (145) for St. Louis; trailing only **Lance Lynn** in all categories.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee. Was the first Cardinals pitcher since **Chris Carpenter** had 35 in 2009 to do so.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is one of two pitchers (**Erick Fedde**) with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.988) since 2018 (min. 100 TC).

LAST TIME OUT

- Failed to get thru 5.0 innings for the 2nd-straight start, as the Brewers won 12-5 last Sat (4/20) at Busch Stadium. Miles allowed a single-game high 3 HR's in the defeat.

- Notched his 1st win of the season, besting the Padres and **Yu Darvish** by a 5-2 score on April 2 at PETCO Park. It was his 1st win in San Diego since May 10, 2018, and marked the 6th quality start among seven career starts against his former team.
- His loss on 4/20 vs. MIL was his 1st ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Was 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA in five Grapefruit League starts this spring. He led the staff in IP (21.0) and starts (5) and co-led in wins (2) and strikeouts (15).

CAREER

- Two-time National League All-Star (2018 and 2022). Did not appear in the 2022 contest at Dodger Stadium and chose to miss the 2018 game in Washington D.C. to be with his wife as they welcomed twins.
- St. Louis is 80-66 (.548) in his 146 career outings (145 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Has registered 32 or more starts in every season in which he was not injured or sidelined by COVID-19 protocols.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only **Clayton Kershaw** (67.6%) for the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.0%.

- Making his 6th career start (7th app.) vs. the Mets with the previous five starts coming with the Cardinals and one relief appearance in 2012 with the Padres.
- Dropped both of his starts vs. the Mets last season and is seeking his 1st win against them since 4/20/19. Has yet to record a win at Citi Field.
- Took the loss in his 6/16/13 start at Citi Field. Worked 6.0 innings and allowed a season-high six runs on eight hits with the big damage coming with two outs in the 1st inning on back to back run-scoring hits by Brett Baty (2-RBI double) and Tommy Pham (RBI single).
- Earned his lone win against the Mets on April 20, 2019, at Busch Stadium, allowing two runs over 8.0 innings. Faced the Mets again in 2022 at Busch Stadium and left after both he and Max Scherzer pitched 7.0 scoreless innings each for no decisions, as the Mets won late 5-2 with five runs in the 9th inning.
