**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals look to salvage a three-game weekend series with today's series finale with the visiting Miami Marlins ... The Cardinals have dropped four straight and gone 1-4 on their six-game homestand against Miami (0-2) and Arizona (1-2) ... St. Louis is 5-10 over their last 15 games (June 11-present) after winning six in a row ... After today's game, the Cardinals fly to Atlanta for a scheduled off day before beginning a six-game road trip against the Atlanta Braves (June 30-July 2) and division-rival Chicago Cubs (July 3-5).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters the final game at the midway point in 3rd place in the National League Central, 1.5 games behind Chicago and 8.0 games back of Milwaukee ... The Cardinals are one half game behind the Padres and Marlins for the 3rd NL Wild Card spot ... St. Louis (-9), Cleveland (-9), and San Diego (-11) are the only three Major League teams with winning records but negative run differentials.

**SMELLING SOMETHING FISHY:** St. Louis has suffered its first losing season series to the Marlins since going 3-4 in 2016 ... The Cardinals need to win today to avoid their third three-game series sweep to the Marlins all-time and first since they re-branded to Miami from Florida:

- July 28-30, 1995 at Joe Robbie Stadium
- Aug. 27-29, 1996 at Busch Stadium II

**WAR, WHAT IS IT GOOD FOR:** The top four National League leaders in position player fWAR include CF **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (4.6), RF **Corbin Carroll** (3.6), SS **Otto Lopez** (3.5), and 2B **JJ Wetherholt** (3.3).

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** Major League Baseball's three-longest active on-base safely streaks include **Bryan Reynolds** (32 games since May 23), **Alec Burlison** (25 games since May 30), and **Iván Herrera** (22 games since June 2).

- Following a 25-gamer earlier this season from April 12-May 9, Herrera is the first Cardinal since **Nolan Arenado** (24g & 25g in 2024) to produce multiple 22+ game on-base streaks in the same season and the first Cardinals catcher to do so since **Ted Simmons** (31g & 28g in 1973).

**EVERYDAY IVÁN:** **Iván Herrera** and Miami's **Xavier Edwards** are two of 15 Major Leaguers to have played in every one of their team's games this season ... Herrera is just the 3rd Cardinal to appear at catcher and play in each of the Cardinals first 81 games of a season following **Ted Simmons** (first 91g of 1973) and **Joe Torre** (first 112g of 1970).

**NOOOOOOOOOO:** **Lars Nootbaar** has reached base safely in all 11 home games at Busch Stadium this season, slashing .382/.511/.588 (13-34) with 10 walks and a 1.099 OPS ... The 28-year-old Nootbaar has also reached base safely in his last 13 games overall against Miami since 2023, batting .313/.411/.375 (15-48).

**MARMOL NAMED TO NL ALL-STAR COACHING STAFF:** Dodgers manager **Dave Roberts** has invited **Oliver Marmol** and Phillies interim manager **Don Mattingly** to serve as honorary coaches alongside the Dodgers coaching staff for the NL in the 2026 All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia.

- Marmol becomes the 10th different Cardinals manager to serve as an honorary National League All-Star coach with **Tony La Russa** (2003, 2009), **Joe Torre** (1992), **Red Schoendienst** (1972, 1974, 1975), **Johnny Keane** (1962-G1), **Solly Hemus** (1960-G1 & G2), **Fred Hutchinson** (1956), **Eddie Stanky** (1952), **Eddie Dyer** (1948), & **Frankie Frisch** (1937, 1938).

**Iván Herrera** caught his first MLB shutout against the Marlins, June 27, 2022 at Busch Stadium from **Adam Wainwright** (7 IP), **James Naile** (1 IP) and **Jake Woodford** (1 IP) in a 9-0 win...hit his first career MLB home run on April 4, 2024 vs. Miami.

**George Soriano** made 72 appearances (1 start) for Miami from 2023-25...signed with the Marlins as an International Free Agent on Aug. 19, 2015.

**Jon Jay** was born in and resides in Miami...attended Christopher Columbus High School and the University of Miami...served as the First Base/Outfield Coach for Miami for two seasons (2023-24).

Marlins Assistant Athletic Trainer **Brad LaRosa** was an athletic trainer for Double-A Springfield from 2006-08...received bachelor and master degrees in kinesiology from SIU Edwardsville.

**Dustin May** earned his first MLB win at Miami on Aug. 13, 2019 in a start for the Dodgers.

**Pete Fairbanks** graduated from Webster Groves High School...played baseball collegiately at the University of Missouri from 2013-15.

**Sandy Alcántara** pitched in eight games for St. Louis in 2017...Originally signed with the Cardinals as an International free agent on July 2, 2013 (signed by **Moises Rodriguez**)...traded to Miami with **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Magneuris Sierra** for **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

**Ryne Stanek** made 31 relief appearances for the Marlins from 2019-20.

**John King** pitched in 127 games as a reliever for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Édgar Rentería** played for the Marlins from 1996-98 before St. Louis acquired him in a trade on Dec. 14, 1998...signed with Florida as a non-drafted free agent in 1992.

Marlins Head Strength & Conditioning Coach **Daniel Vega** was the Cardinals' strength & conditioning coach/Latin American strength & cond. coord. from 2016-18 and the strength & cond. coach for Double-A Springfield from 2019-21.

Marlins Bullpen Catcher **Tanner Garrison** played for the Gateway Grizzlies of the Frontier League in 2025.

Marlins Video Coordinator **Austin Lamkey** graduated from SEMO in 2013.

Marlins Assistant Athletic Trainer **Jose Alvarez** was the Cardinals minor league assistant rehab coordinator in 2018.

**TODAY'S STARTER:**

- This afternoon marks Kyle's 16th start of the season (17th career) and 114th career Major League appearance; he transitioned to a full-time starter to begin the 2026 season.
- Facing the Marlins for the 2nd time this season and 6th time career with four of his five previous meetings coming in relief.
- Is seeking his 1st win since 5/16 vs. KC; the Cardinals have gone 1-5 over his past six games started.
- His five wins this season are a career high and rank T-2nd on the team to **Andre Pallante** (9).
- Three of his five wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston and April 28 at Pittsburgh.
- Has made four starts in nationally televised games including Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit, April 11 vs. Boston on FOX, May 23 -Game 2 at Cincinnati on FOX & May 29 vs. the Cubs on FOX.
- His first 97 career appearances were as a relief pitcher beginning with his Major League debut on July 7, 2023; First career start came at Chicago's Wrigley Field on Sept. 28, 2025.
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

**LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, June 23 vs. Arizona):** ND, L, 4-3; 6.1 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR - 85 pitches.

- Worked a career-high 6.1 scoreless IP high and left with the score knotted at 0-0; The two teams combined for all seven of the game's runs in the 9th inning with Arizona holding on for the 4-3 win.

**2026 HIGHLIGHTS:**

**EN GARDE:** Ranks T-4th among all MLB pitchers with his 20 Opponent's Sword Swings (Max Meyer-MIA, 1st with 29) and his 88.4 competitive swing pct. ranks 6th best among MLB qualifying starters and 2nd on the Cardinals staff to **Andre Pallante** (87.8). A "sword" swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

**AIR BENDER:** Leads Cardinals starters with an average swing & miss distance of 3.6 inches, including a season high 20.9 inch swing & miss by the Pirates Nick Gonzlaes on April 28.

**HIGHS & LOWS:** Struck out a career-high 8 batters in his 5/23 [2] start at CIN, but also allowed a career-high 5 runs - all coming in his 5th and final inning of work

**PARK PLACE:** Each of his first six road games took place at Parks ( Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park). His start at Target Field on June 12 ended the string.

**CENTRAL FOCUS:** Earned wins in two of his five starts against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT & May 4 vs. MIL) to improve to 4-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

**DECISIONS, DECISIONS** Has earned the decision in nine of his 15 starts, but just one decision in his last 6 starts.

**STRETCHING OUT:** Pitched a career-high 6.1 innings on 6/22 vs. ARI and has worked at least 5.0 innings in 12 of his 15 starts on the year.

**SNAKE CHARMER:** Blanked the Diamondbacks on just 3 hits over his career single-game high 6.1 IP on 6/22 vs. ARI, but took a no-decision while exiting the game with a scoreless tie.

**OH MOTHER:** Blanked the Padres over his 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.

**BROOM RIDE:** Gained the win in the middle game of the Cardinals three-game series sweep at HOU in a 9-4 win on 4/17; Struck out a season high 6, but allowed 3 solo HR's.

**ALL EYES ON US:** Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX. Made the start on 5/23 [2] at Cincinnati on FOX in national telecast Memorial Day weekend.

**EASTER DELIGHT:** Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

**IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER:** Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42° on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45° and below, two shy of matching Cards announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

**CAREER:**

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County POY and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa Univ. in Grand Junction, CO, going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 K and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

**LEAHY VS. MIAMI:**

- Makes his 2nd career start and 6th appearance against Miami today - his 2nd meeting this season with the Marlins.
- He's 0-1, 3.72 ERA career vs. Miami in 5 games totaling 9.2 IP with no HR's allowed.
- Made his 1st start vs. MIA on 4/22/26 at loanDepot Park and allowed 4 runs over 5.0 IP in a 4-1 loss.
- Previously faced the Marlins in four relief outings (2024-25), hurling 4.2 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with four strikeouts in four St. Louis defeats.
- Has made four career Grapefruit League appearances vs. the Marlins since 2023, throwing 4.2 shutout innings with eight strikeouts.
