THE GIANTS: Face the Diamondbacks in game two of this three game set tonight...SF's 12-2 loss last night matched its largest margin of defeat this season (also: lost 13-3 on May 9 vs. PIT).

- ▶ Last night, Ray allowed each of the first four batters he faced to score over the first six pitches of the game...according to *Elias*, the last MLB starting pitcher that gave up four runs within their first six pitches of the game was PIT's A.J. Burnett on May 2, 2012 vs. STL (also six pitches).
- ▶ Since 1958, there have only been six instances of a 1st inning grand slam by a cleanup hitter against the Giants...prior to last night, the last time it happened was July 4, 1978 (SD's Dave Winfield off John Montefusco).

- ▶ The last Giants pitcher before **Robbie Ray** last night to give up 10 runs and go that deep into a game (4.1 innings) was **Jamey Wright** against the Padres in 2006 (*SIS*).

LIVING OUT OF A SUITCASE: SF is 4-4 over the first eight games of it's current 10-game road trip to Los Angeles-NL (2-2), West Sacramento (2-1) and Arizona (0-1).

- ▶ SF is in the middle of a stretch where they play 20 of 26 games on the road, starting May 11 until June 7...the Giants are 10-16 over their first 26 games away from Oracle Park.
- ▶ The Giants are 6-4 in road games in the state of California (Padres, Dodgers, A's) compared to 4-12 vs. all out-of-state hosts (Orioles, Reds, Nationals, Phillies, Rays, D-Backs).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP Landen Roupp takes the mound for his 10th start of the year...he is 0-3 with a 5.93 ERA and 1.76 WHIP over his last three outings, compared to his 5-1 record with a 2.55 ERA and 0.91 WHIP in six starts to begin the year.

- ▶ He's struck out at least six batters in each of his last six outings, the longest stretch of his career and the longest such run by a Giants pitcher since **Carlos Rodón** in July 2022...the last stretch longer than six games by a Giants pitcher was seven games in 2021 by **Logan Webb** (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ Roupp has a 3-2 record with a 2.93 ERA (9er, 27.2ip), 30 strikeouts and a 1.16 WHIP in five road starts this season...the 2.93 road ERA is 11th-best in the NL this season.
- ▶ His changeup has a .088 opposing batting average (3x34) with 12 strikeouts and a 34.4% whiff rate this season...the .088 opponent batting average is the second lowest in MLB among all changeups (min. 150 changeups thrown).

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: Last night **Casey Schmitt** started in left field for SF, marking his first start in the outfield since High School...with **OF Heliot Ramos** landing on the Injured List with a right quad strain on Friday, Schmitt became the fourth different Giant to start in left field in as many days...**OF Drew Gilbert** started in LF for the first time in his career on Saturday and **C Eric Haase** started in LF on Sunday marking his first MLB outfield appearance since 2023.

HOMER HAPPY: IF Willy Adames recorded his fourth homer of the year last night ...SF has now homered at least once in 13 of its last 14 games (dating to the first game of the last homestand on May 4 vs. San Diego) and hit 19 homers total during that stretch...SF's 19 home runs since May 4 are the fourth most in the Majors.

- ▶ However, entering today, the Giants' 38 home runs overall this year are tied with Miami for the third-fewest in the Majors...only the Brewers (32) and Red Sox (34) have hit less.

BADER TOTS: Since coming off the IL, **OF Harrison Bader** is 7-for-24 (.292) with five runs scored, three doubles, three homers, six RBI and a 1.112 OPS in six games.

- ▶ Over his last two games, Bader has seen 36 pitches and not swung and missed once...he had swung and missed at least once in every other game he's played this season...his season whiff rate is almost 33% compared to a career rate of 26% (*SIS*).

DEFENSE: The Giants matched a season-high with three errors in last night's loss...their 27 errors this season are third-most in the National League, behind the Nationals (47) and Marlins (34).

ROUPPER: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

LAST TIME OUT: Received his third straight loss, this time at LAD on May 14, allowing four runs on six hits (one homer) and two walks while striking out seven over 5.1 innings.

VS. ARIZONA: Will be facing Arizona for the fourth time in his career (second start)...he has a 4.66 ERA (5er, 9.2ip) in the three outings with 10 strikeouts...in his lone start, here at Chase Field on July 2 of last season, Roupp allowed two runs on five hits and four walks while striking out four in 4.0 innings.

MAY DAY: After a strong start to the season (5-1 with a 2.55 ERA in six starts), Roupp has struggled this month, going 0-3 with a 5.93 ERA (9er, 13.2ip) in three May starts.

WHERE'S THE K COUNTER LOCATED?: He has struck out at least six batters in six straight starts, which is the longest such streak by a Giants pitcher since **LHP Carlos Rodón** had a six-game streak July 4-31, 2022 (*Stats, LLC*)...the last Giants pitcher to have a streak of seven or more starts with six or more strikeouts was **RHP Logan Webb** August 6-September 7, 2021.

WHAT'S THE COUNT?: Roupp has made it through the 5th inning just once in his last three starts due in part to his high pitch count... Roupp's 17.5 pitches per inning is fourth-highest in MLB among pitchers with at least 49.0 innings pitched this season.

NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED: The righty's 26.7% hard hit rate this season is lowest in the Majors (min. 100 batted ball events)...the next closest is Philadelphia's Jesús Luzardo (28.7%)...Roupp's 55.0% ground ball rate this season is sixth-best in the Majors.

ROAD WARRIOR: Roupp has a 3-2 record with a 2.93 ERA (9er, 27.2ip), 30 strikeouts and a 1.16 WHIP in five road starts this season...the 2.93 road ERA is 11th-best in the NL this season...at home, Roupp is 2-2 with a 4.22 ERA (10er, 21.1ip), 28 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in four starts.

SINK OR SWIM: His sinker has been his most-used pitch (36.2 usage rate) and also his most valuable per *Baseball Savant* (+6 run value)...the +6 run value is T-7th best in MLB among all sinkers this season, and is the most valuable pitch on the Giants (**RHP Logan Webb**, **RHP Trevor McDonald** and **RHP Keaton Winn** are all tied for second with sinkers of +4).

CALLING CARD: Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, opponents are batting .207 (12x58) vs. the pitch with 27 strikeouts, a 36.0% whiff rate and a 31.4% putaway rate...the Diamondbacks have a .516 OPS vs. curveballs this season (26th in MLB).

CHANGING THE PACE: His changeup has a .088 opposing batting average (3x34) with 12 strikeouts and a 34.4% whiff rate this season...the .088 opponent batting average is the second lowest in MLB among all changeups (min. 150 changeups thrown).

WE LOVE TO SEE IT: Roupp averages 13.2 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, which is tied for the 10th-fastest in MLB...the league average thus far in 2026 is 16.1 seconds with the bases empty.

NICE AND EASY: Opponents are batting .158 (3x19) with a .358 OPS on the first pitch of an at-bat vs. Roupp...on the second pitch of the at-bat (either 0-1 or 1-0 in the count), opponents are 0-for-16.

TOP OF THE ORDER: The top four spots in the batting order have combined for a .133/.220/.189 slash line with three extra-base hits and a .409 OPS in 100 plate appearances vs. Roupp this season

TYLER MAHLE RHP #54

2026 RECORD: 1-5, 5.39 ERA

- ▶ Will make his 10th start of the season...suffered his fifth loss of the year on Friday at the A's after giving up five runs on 10 hits over 5.0 innings of work.
- ▶ Will face the Dbacks for the sixth time in his career and first since 2022...Mahle has a 1.80 ERA (6er, 30.0ip) with a .154 BAA, 0.87 WHIP and 40 strikeouts (12.00 K.9ip) in the five starts.
- ▶ Last faced them on June 14, 2022, when he threw 9.0 shutout innings and matched a career-best 12 strikeouts with just three hits allowed.

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP *(bohr-RUCK-ee)*

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/18 at AZ; 2.0ip, 2h, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Has now allowed a run over his last four games (6.1ip).
- ▶ Has allowed runs in seven of his 18 appearances (3.93 ERA)... however, he's 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3er, 13.0ip) in his last 12 games.
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-33 (.152) with four walks and nine strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .179 clip (72-for-402) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties are 14-for-35 (.400) with six XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP *(BROO-baker)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/18 at AZ; 1.2ip, 3h, 2r, er, k (29 pitches)

- ▶ In his last seven outings, he has a 5.40 ERA (6er, 10.0ip) and .317 BAA (13x41)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x40).
- ▶ Has a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) in nine road games...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in nine of 16 contests (5.06 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 14-for-49 (.286) with five XBHs off him while lefties are 9-for-32 (.281).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; SV, 1.0ip (15 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first career save on Saturday with 1.0 perfect inning.
- ▶ Gage's 23 appearances this year are tied for third-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered four runs (three ER) in 19.1ip this year (1.40 ERA).
- ▶ His 1.40 ERA is the ninth-lowest among NL relievers.
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-23 (.087) against him this season, and 19-for-106 in his career (.179).
- ▶ His 25.9% hard hit rate ranks in the top 3% of MLB.
- ▶ His 14.1% walk rate is in the bottom 10% of MLB (11 BBs in 19.1ip).
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by **RHP Dan Otero** in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP *(HENT-chiss)*

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/17 at ATH; 1.0ip, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has made four appearances with SF, logging 3.1-scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and three walks with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Is returning to the Majors for the first time since July 10, 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL Sunday.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP *(kill-EE-en)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; 0.2ip, h, r, er, hr (9 pitches)

- ▶ Last 6 games: 6.0ip, 5h, 4r, 3er, 2hr, 5bb, 1bb, 5k (4.50 ERA)...had a 0.64 ERA (1er, 14.0ip) with a .111 BAA and 16 K's in 13 games prior.
- ▶ Owns a 25.6% strikeout rate and .147 BAA (10x68) this season.
- ▶ Has a 5.40 BB/9ip...his 14.6% BB rate ranks in the bottom 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 5-for-40 (.125) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 5-for-28 (.179) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 5/16 at ATH; 0.2ip, 2r, 2er, 2bb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on Saturday after missing 14 games with a low back strain...pitched in two rehab games (May 10 and 13), striking out three over 2.0 innings.
- ▶ Had not allowed a run in his last eight appearances prior to injury dating back to April 8 vs. Philadelphia (8.1ip, 2h, 0r, 0er, 4bb, 13k).
- ▶ Right-handers are 4-for-24 (.167) off him with two doubles.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 57.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the second-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP *(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/17 at ATH; 1.0ip (12 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on May 5 after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 6.1 innings since returning from the IL, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in six games so far (1.42 ERA).
- ▶ Batters are 1-for-12 with a single off his sinker thus far, which he's thrown 43.6% of the time...he threw it 34.3% of the time in his stint w/SF last season.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/17 at ATH; 1.0ip, h, k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Has posted a 1.20 ERA (2er, 15.0ip) with a 0.67 WHIP over his last 15 games.
- ▶ Leads SF with nine holds, which is tied for the fifth-most in MLB.
- ▶ 16 of his 20 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.33 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 10-for-65 (.154) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 5-for-37 (.135) with 14 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 85.2 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 6% of the league while his 24.0% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 2%.
- ▶ His 1.77 xERA is fifth-best in the Majors.
