TODAY'S GAME: After dropping last night's opener, SF will look to level the series tonight at Fenway Park.

- The Giants have alternated wins and losses for their last six games dating to April 23 and hovering between two games under and a game under the .500 mark...the last time the Giants had consecutive wins or losses was April 22-23 with back-to-back wins in the first two games of their series with the Mets.
- The Giants are in a stretch of 16 straight games without an off day that began yesterday (their longest such stretch of the season)...their next day off is scheduled to come May 16.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants recalled RHP Daulton Jefferies (\#56) from Triple-A Sacramento and optioned RHP Landen Roupp to Triple-A Sacramento after the game yesterday.

ODDS \& ENDS: Yesterday's game marked the second time this year SF has been blanked with the other coming in a 4-0 defeat at the hands of the Padres back on April 6 at Oracle Park

- The Giants only had four hits yesterday (and two of those came in the ninth inning) ...it was the seventh time this year that SF has been held to five or fewer hits in a game.
- SF is 1-6 in such games with the lone win coming in the home opener on April 5 vs. SD when the Giants had five hits and won 3-2.
- Starter Logan Webb threw only 52 of his 91 pitches last night for strikes ( $57.1 \%$ ) ...it was Webb's lowest strike percentage in a start since June 25, 2022 vs. Cincinnati when he had a $56.7 \%$ strike percentage (he threw 55 of his 97 pitches for strikes in that outing)...oddly enough, Webb permitted only two hits and allowed one unearned run in that start that ended up a Giants win, 9-2.
BOSTON CALLING: Since Interleague play began in 1997, this is only the fourth series that the Giants have played here at Fenway Park but they will become more frequent visitors with the new balanced schedule
- Overall, SF is 2-7 in nine games here as they were swept in each of their first two series ( $3-0$ in 2007 and 2-0 in 2016).
'PEN GAME: LHP Erik Miller will start today's bullpen game for the Giants...this spot in the rotation was held by LHP Blake Snell before he went on the IL last week with a left adductor strain...Snell is scheduled to throw a 'pen in SF today.
- Miller was a starter early in his minor league career with the Phillies but transitioned to the bullpen in 2022..his last time starting a game was June 2, 2022 for Double-A Reading in the second game of a doubleheader at Hartford.
- RHP Daulton Jefferies will factor into today's game...after being optioned following his March 31 start for SF at San Diego (2.0ip, 9h, 9r, 5er), Jefferies logged a 3.44 ERA (7er, 18.1 ip) in four games (two starts) at Triple-A Sacramento.

MAY...FLOWERS?: As the calendar flips to May, the Giants enter the month 14-16 but still searching for some consistency on offense...below is a look at some of the club's MLB rankings after the first month.

GRANDSON OF THE WHN CARL: OF Mike Yastrzemski, grandson of Hallof Famerand Red SoxlegendCarlYastrzemski, is playing his second career series here at Fenway Park.

- SF's Yaz (born in Andover, MA) went 4 -for- 13 with a double, a homer, two RBI, two walks and five runs scored in three games here back in 2019.
- Even with an 0-for-2 last night, Yastrzemski has been swinging a hotter bat as of late...he's 9 -for-his-last-24 (.375) with four runs scored, two homers and eight RBI dating to April 18 (nine games)...he began the year 4 -for- 33 through his first 13 games with no extra-base hits.

WHERE SHOULD WE START?: Even with RHP Logan Webb giving up four runs last night, Giants starters have still logged a 1.73 ERA (8er, 41.2ip) over their last eight games...they've struck out 37 , walked 10 and allowed one homer in those 41.2 innings.

- Over their last 23 games dating to April 5, Giants starters have logged a 3.30 ERA (46er, 125.1 ip), fifth-best in the Majors...in the National League specifically, it's the third-best starter's ERA behind the Phillies (2.27) and Pirates (3.30).

## Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/28 vs. PIT; S, 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb (22 pitches)

- Pitched in three of SF's last four games, totaling 57 pitches.
- Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), he has made 10 appearances, going 2-0-5 while allowing eight hits, two runs and five walks with 14 strikeouts (10.0ip) for a 1.80 ERA.
- 11 of his 14 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).


## \#64 SEAN HJELLE $>$ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: $4 / 30$ at BOS; $1.1 \mathrm{ip}, \mathrm{h}, \mathrm{hb}, \mathrm{k}$ ( 16 pitches)

- Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19..made his season debut on April 21, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the ' 23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days
- The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.


## \#77 LUKE JACKSON $>$ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: $4 / 27$ vs. PIT; 1.0ip, h, bb (23 pitches)

- Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- Has made two appearances since being reinstated (2.0ip, 2h, bb)
- Batters are 4-for-8 with two walks off Jackson in his three appearances at the MLB level this year.
- Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).


## \#56 DAULTON JEFFERIES•RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Changeup, Cutter, Curverball
Last Gm: 4/24 vs. LV (w/AAA); 5.0ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, bb, 7k (64p) (start)

- Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento earlier today.
- The right-hander signed a minor league deal with SF in December.
- Had his contract selected on March 31 and started that day at San Diego...threw just 2.0 innings, giving up nine runs (five earned) on nine hits (two homers) with a strikeout.
- Was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento on April 1...has made four appearances (two starts) with the River Cats since and gone 1-0 with a 3.44 ERA and 17 strikeouts (18.1ip) in those outings
- Prior to his March 31 start, Jefferies had last appeared in a Major League game in May of 2022... underwent surgery to correct Thoracic Outlet Syndrome and ended up having a second Tommy John surgery during his rehab process.
- Made 14 career MLB appearances with the A's from 2020-22.


## \#68 ERIK MILLER•LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: $4 / 28$ vs. PIT; 1.0ip, bb, k (24 pitches)

- Will start tonight's game...has made 19 career starts in the minors but hasn't made one since June 2, 2022 with Double-A Reading.
- Over his last 10 outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs over 10.1 innings (2.61 ERA) with 15 strikeouts, two walks, a 0.58 WHIP and a . 118 opposing batting average (4x34).
- LHBs are 2-for-16 off him early on...RHBs are 4-for-28.
- The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to MLB.com.
- Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters ( $12.63 \mathrm{~K} / 9 \mathrm{ip}$ ).


## \#33 TAYLOR ROGERS • LHP

## Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 4/30 at BOS; 1.0ip, bb, 2k (13 pitches)

- Allowed two homers in the 10th inning on Saturday...was only the second time in his MLB career ( 456 games) that he's given up multiple homers in a single inning...the only other time was August 14, 2022 at St. Louis while pitching for Milwaukee.
- Has appeared in 11 games for SF so far, allowing five runs (four earned) over 9.1 innings of work with nine strikeouts.
- Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging $11.15 \mathrm{SO} / 9$ ( $64 \mathrm{k}, 51.2 \mathrm{ip}$ )
- Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1\%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).


## \#71 TYLER ROGERS • RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider
Last Game: $4 / 27 \mathrm{vs}$. PIT; $1.0 \mathrm{ip}, 2 \mathrm{~h}, \mathrm{k}$ (16 pitches)

- Has appeared in 14 of SF's first 30 games...his 14 appearances are two shy of MLB-lead.
- Opposing batters have gone 15-for-50 (.300) with a .325 BABIP off Rogers early here in 2024...last year hitters batted . 236 with a .274 BABIP off him
- His hard-hit rate allowed this year is 25.6\%, which is in the top 4\% of the league.
- Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler ( 276 g )


## \#74 RYAN WALKER•RHP

## Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: $4 / 28$ vs. PIT; 1.0ip, k (11 pitches)

- Threw a season-high 33 pitches on Friday followed by 11 pitches in a perfect 8th inning on Sunday.
- His 16 appearances are tied for most in the Majors
- 13 of Walker's 16 appearances have been scoreless.
- Has stranded four of his six inherited runners so far in 2024.
- His 26.4\% opposing hard hit rate in 2023 was fifth-best in MLB. so far in 2024 opponents have a $24.3 \%$ hard-hit rate.
- Used his sinker and slider essentially equally in 2023 (50.3\% sliders and $49.6 \%$ sinkers)...so far in '24 he's been at $53.6 \%$ sinkers and 44.2\% sliders.

- Bay Area native was born in San Jose, went to Bellarmine College Prep in San Jose and attended Santa Clara University.
- Was drafted by the Dodgers in the second round of the 2016 draft when current Giants PBO Farhan Zaidi was the GM of the Dodgers.
- Grew up a Giants fan (Matt Cain was his favorite player) ...attended all the Giants World Series runs while in high school and college.
