D-BACKS RBI TEAM LEAD 2025 NIKE RBI WORLD SERIES: The D-backs Nike RBI Senior Baseball team (3-0) lead the the Nike RBI Senior Baseball World Series standings after defeating Puerto Rico Aguadilla Nike RBI 3-1 this morning, Paterson Baseball Association Nike RBI 6-1 yesterday and Detroit Tigers Nike RBI 8-7 on Monday at the Jackie Robinson Training Complex in Vero Beach, Fla.

PERDOMO NAMED D-BACKS HEART & HUSTLE AWARD WINNER: **Geraldo Perdomo** was named the D-backs' Heart & Hustle Award winner, announced by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLB-PAA) and will be recognized in a pregame ceremony on Sat., Aug. 9...the annual award is given to active players who exemplify a true passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and traditions of the game.

- At the conclusion of the season, all alumni and fans will vote to select the final winner from the 30 team winners, which will be announced in mid-November on MLB Network...no D-back has ever won the overall award.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 10-5 vs. Padres last night to snap their 3-game win streak.

- Ryne Nelson** went decisionless after allowing 2 runs on 6 hits and 2 walks in 5.2 innings with 8 strikeouts...his 16 swings-and-misses tied a career high (also: April 7, 2024 @ Braves).
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** had his eighth career multi-homer game (last: May 7, 2023 vs. Nationals)...his game-tying 2-run home run in the bottom of the eighth inning off a 103.9 mph fastball from Mason Miller was the hardest thrown pitch hit for a homer in the Majors since pitch tracking became available in 2008 (previous: Ian Happ/CHC off a 103.2 mph fastball off Miller on Sept. 17, 2024).
- Geraldo Perdomo** reached base safely (1 H, 2 BB) in his seventh straight game.
- Andrew Saalfrank** tossed his eighth scoreless outing in his 9 games.
- John Curtiss** made his fourth straight scoreless outing.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs selected RHP **Casey Kelly** (No. 60), optioned LHP **Kyle Nelson** to Triple-A Reno following last night's game and transferred RHP **Kevin Ginkel** to the 60-day injured list.

SNAKE BITES: With a win, the D-backs will claim their second consecutive series win and third since the All-Star break (also: @ Athletics and vs. Cardinals).

- Geraldo Perdomo's** 18-game on-base streak at home is the longest active home streak in the Majors.
- In their last 4 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 16 earned runs in 16.1 innings (8.82 ERA) while hitting .328 (22-for-67)/.420 OBP/.567 SLG/.987 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers and 11 walks.
- Against lefty starting pitchers, the D-backs' 17.3% strikeout rate ranks lowest in the NL, ahead of the Padres (17.7) while their 1.95 K/BB ratio ranks second in the NL, behind the Padres (1.87).
- Geraldo Perdomo's** 42 hits vs. lefties rank tied for third (also: 4 others), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (44) and Ernie Clement/TOR (44).
- Perdomo's** 32 PA without a strikeout (since July 28) is the longest active streak in the Majors...over his last 7 games, is hitting .375 (9-for-24)/.484 OBP/.583 SLG/1.067 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 6 walks (0 K).
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, over his last 5 games, is hitting .318 (7-for-22)/.348 OBP/.636 SLG/.984 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 1 walk.

LOCKLEAR AND EAGEN RECEIVE MiLB JULY HONORS: Today, Minor League Baseball announced INF Tyler Locklear (Triple-A, Pacific Coast League) and RHP Daniel Eagen (High-A, Northwest League) as July Players and Pitchers of the Month.

- Locklear, before being traded to the D-backs, slashed .422/.490/.807 with Triple-A Tacoma (Mariners) and led the league in AVG (.422), hits (35), home runs (9), RBI (34), SLG (.807) and OPS (1.297)...was second in runs (26), total bases (67) and OBP (.490).
- Eagen went 1-0 with a 2.35 ERA (6 ER in 23.0 IP) in 4 starts with Hillsboro...led the league in opponent AVG (.132) and H/9.0 IP (3.91).

CASTILLO AND CABRERA EARN D-BACKS MONTHLY HONORS: The D-backs named High-A Hillsboro C **Kenny Castillo** and Double-A Amarillo RHP **Jose Cabrera** the organization's July Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month.

- Castillo, in 15 games with the Hops, hit .354 (17-for-48)/1.022 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 7 walks.
- Cabrera, in 6 starts (4 quality) with the Sod Poodles, went 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER in 31.2 IP), opponent .200 AVG, 11 walks and 25 strikeouts.

HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH NL WEST: The D-backs are 16-13 (.552) vs. NL West opponents this season, the second-best interdivision win pct., behind the Dodgers (19-7, .731) and ahead of the Padres (15-13, .536).

- In head-to-head NL West play, the D-backs own the best OPS (.822), SLG (.490) with the most homers (53), extra-base hits (114), runs (153) and stolen bases (20).
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 24 of his 28 games vs. NL West, batting .327 (34-for-104)/.400 OBP/.529 SLG/.929 OPS with 10 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 21 RBI, 14 walks (14 K) and 2 stolen bases.
- Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 9 straight games vs. NL West (2 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, BB) and in 24 of his 28 games vs. NL West this season, slashing .291/.397/.650/1.047 with 7 doubles, 10 homers, 20 RBI, 15 walks, 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.
- Both Marte and Perdomo have reached base safely 48 times, which ranks tied for second in most times on base in head-to-head play, behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (1st, 51).

HITTIN' AT HOME: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 18 straight home games (since June 27), tied for the longest active home streak in the Majors...is batting .424 (28-for-66)/.525 OBP/.561 SLG/1.086 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 13 RBI, 12 walks (5 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 3 stolen bases.

- Corbin Carroll**, has reached safely in 6 of his last 7 home games (since July 19), batting .333 (10-for-30)/.323 OBP/.667 SLG/.989 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 5 RBI and 2 stolen bases.

ON-BASE MACHINE: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 58 times on base since July 1 are tied for the second most in the Majors with Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR, behind Nick Kurtz/ATH (59).

- Has reached base in 27 of his 30 games since July 1, hitting .324 (35-for-108)/.439 OBP/.454 SLG/.893 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 20 walks (10 K).

RELIEVERS RECENTLY: D-backs relievers, over their last 5 games (excluding extra-innings), have allowed just 6 earned runs in 19.1 innings (2.79 ERA).

- Since July 24, in their last 11 games, D-backs' relievers have allowed a MLB-lowest 14.3 (2-of-14) inherited runs allowed pct., ahead of the Padres (17.6, 3-of-17) and Dodgers (20.0, 5-of-25).

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (8-12, 5.48)

- Won his last start on Aug. 2 @ Athletics, allowing 2 runs on 9 hits over 6.0 innings.
- In 9 career home starts vs. Rockies, is 5-1 with a 3.24 ERA (18 ER in 50.0 IP) with 21 walks and 60 strikeouts.

AT A GLANCE: First season with the D-backs...signed as a Major League free agent on June 15.

- 12th season in the Majors along with Marlins (2014), Reds (2015-20, did not pitch in 2017), Giants (2021-23), Twins (2024, did not pitch in 2024).
- In 2024, acquired by the Twins on January 29, 2024, from the Mariners, but missed the entire season after suffering a right elbow strain in Spring Training that require forearm flexor tendon surgery.
- In 2021 with the Giants, set career bests with 13 wins, 3.17 ERA, .225 OPP AVG, .634 OPP AVG.

SNAKEBITES: Third start for the D-backs, second @ Chase Field (0-2).

- Made his first Major League start since July 18, 2023 on July 6 vs. Royals...in 4.0 innings, allowed 4 runs on 4 hits with 0 walks and 6 strikeouts.
- His last Major League season was 2023 with the Giants...in 19 games (18 starts), went 3-8 with a 4.88 ERA (59 R-54 ER), opponent .271 AVG (105-for-388)/.767 OPS, 20 walks and 79 strikeouts.

2025 OVERVIEW: Signed by the D-backs on June 15...released by the Yankees on June 12...signed by the Yankees on May 13.

- In 5 starts for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY) from May 17-June 10, went 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (11 R-10 ER in 20.0 IP), an opponent .300 AVG (24-for-80)/.796 OPS, 9 walks and 20 strikeouts.

AS A STARTER: Has worked primarily as a starting pitcher with 171 starts and 18 relief appearances in 189 career games.

- In 171 career starts, is 53-58 with a 4.23 ERA (478 R-438 ER in 932.0 IP), 251 walks and 823 strikeouts.
- Had a career-best 31 starts in 2015 (Reds), 2019 (Reds) and 2021 (Giants).
- Debut in 2014 with the Marlins with 5 starts from May 14-June 27 then was recalled and made 8 relief appearances the remainder of the season.

VS. PADRES: 11th career start...first since June 20, 2023 vs. Padres (3 ER in 5.0 IP).

- In his last 3 starts (his teams are 3-0), is 2-0 with a 2.16 ERA (4 ER in 16.2 IP), 2 walks and 12 strikeouts.
- In 10 career starts, is 3-1 with a 2.58 ERA (17 ER in 57.0 IP), opponent .216 AVG, 0.98 WHIP and 42 strikeouts...his teams are 8-2 in his 10 starts.
- Has allowed 1 earned run or fewer in 6 of his 10 starts.
- Has walked 2 or fewer batters in 9 of his 10 starts, including four starts with 1 walk and 3 with no walks (1.74 BB/9.0 IP).
