THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY
On this date in 1990, RHP Ben McDonald won his fourth consecutive Major League start by defeating the A's 4-1 at the Oakland Coliseum...McDonald went on to win his next start as well, on August 13 at Seattle, to become the first Orioles pitcher ever to win his first six big league decisions.



THESE GO TO 11: The Orioles recorded a season-high 19 hits in Friday night's 11-0 win at Washington...The 19 hits marked the most for the O's since August 30, 2019 at Kansas City (21).
 ⚾ According to STATS, LLC., the O's 11-0 win marked the largest shutout victory by a team coming off a 100-loss season against a defending World Series champion in Major League history.
 ⚾ The shutout marked the eighth road shutout of at least 11 runs in Orioles history (since 1954) and their largest shutout victory on the road since September 4, 2012 (12-0 at Toronto).
 ⚾ Friday night marked the O's fourth ever shutout against the Nationals, with three of the four coming at Nationals Park...It also marked the largest win against the Nationals in O's history.

MAKE MINE A DOUBLE: INF José Iglesias went 4-for-4 with a double and two RBI in the win... His four hits matched his career-high and marked his sixth career four-hit game (second this season, 7/26 at BOS)...He is tied for the Major-League lead with seven doubles.
 ⚾ According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Iglesias' seven doubles in his first 10 games are the most doubles in Orioles history through a player's first 10 games of a season.

HOMER HAPPY: Renato Núñez collected his fifth home run of the season on Friday night...He leads the team with five home runs 11 RBI...His five home runs are tied for second in the AL and are tied for third in the majors...His 11 RBI are tied for fifth in the AL and are tied for 10th in the majors.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The Orioles have been one of the more successful teams in baseball at swinging at the first pitch...They rank first in the AL in batting average (.456), hits (26), doubles (9), extra-base hits (14), and OPS (1.325) as a team with a 0-0 count.
 ⚾ OF Anthony Santander leads the O's with six hits with a 0-0 count, good for second-most in the AL.
 ⚾ Both Santander and INF Renato Núñez are tied for the AL lead in extra-base hits (3) with a 0-0 count.

ALL ABOUT THAT (ON) BASE: The Orioles rank second in the American League and fifth in the majors with a .773 team OPS (on-base percentage plus slugging percentage)...INF Renato Núñez (1.069) leads the team and ranks fourth in the AL in OPS among qualifying hitters.

SCHEDULING UPDATES: Major League Baseball has announced several scheduling updates following the postponement of recent games as a result of positive tests for COVID-19...The following O's games have been rescheduled or adjusted (both are home games):
 ⚾ Wednesday, August 19 vs. Toronto: Originally scheduled for a 7:35 p.m. ET first pitch, will now start at 1:05 p.m.
 ⚾ Friday, September 4 vs. New York-AL: Originally scheduled for August 5 at Camden Yards, will be made up as part of a doubleheader on September 4 beginning at 5:05 p.m.

RACKING UP THE K'S: From July 29-August 2, O's pitchers struck out at least 10 batters in five consecutive games, setting a new club record...The previous record of four-straight had been done three times...The O's have recorded 10-or-more strikeouts in seven of their 13 games this season.
 ⚾ The O's rank eighth in the AL with a 8.76 strikeouts per 9.0 innings mark (109 K/112.0 IP).
 ⚾ Orioles starting pitchers rank eighth in the AL with 56 strikeouts...Only Rays starters (63 K) have more among AL East clubs.

TAKE A CHANCE: C Chance Sisco led off the fourth inning with his first home run of the season on Thursday night, and his first since August 31, 2019 at Kansas City...Sisco's average on the year is .417 (5-for-12) to lead all catchers in the majors with at least 10 at-bats.

INTERLEAGUE INFO: The O's will play a total of 20 games against National League opponents this season, including contests with the Miami Marlins (0-4), Washington Nationals (1-0), Philadelphia Phillies (three games), New York Mets (four games), and Atlanta Braves (three games)...Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the O's are 198-230...The O's went 7-13 in Interleague Play last season...Baltimore's 14 Interleague victories in 2016 were the most in club history.

THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW: Since the start of the 2019 season, INF Hanser Alberto leads the majors with 94 hits off of left-handed pitching (18 more than then the next on the list)...In that time, he also leads the majors with a .407 (94-for-231) average against lefties... This season, Alberto ranks seventh in the AL with a .339 (19-for-56) against all pitchers.

ROUGH ROAD AHEAD: Based on 2019 winning percentages, the Orioles own the second-toughest strength of schedule in the American League (tied for third-toughest in the majors)...The Orioles will play four of last year's 10 postseason teams in 2020...The toughest 2020 schedules based on 2019 winning percentages:
 ⚾ Los Angeles Angels .534
 ⚾ Miami Marlins .534
 ⚾ BALTIMORE ORIOLES .532
 ⚾ Colorado Rockies .532

INJURED LIST: Four players are on the Injured List...RHP Hunter Harvey (right forearm strain) and RHP Dillon Tate (right elbow contusion) are on the 10-day Injured List...INF/OF Trey Mancini (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment) and INF Richie Martin (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL...LHP John Means is currently on the bereavement list.

THE SKIPPER: Brandon Hyde was named the 20th manager in O's history on December 14, 2018...He began his first Major League managerial role following 16 professional seasons in the coaching ranks and four as a player...Most recently, Hyde served as bench coach for the Chicago Cubs in 2018, his second season in that role (also 2014)...Hyde spent three seasons as the Cubs first base coach from 2015-17, and previously served as Chicago's Director of Player Development from August 2012-2013, after joining the Cubs in December of 2011 as their Minor League Field Coordinator...Prior to joining the Cubs, Hyde spent nine seasons in the Marlins organization.

QUICK HITS: Making his fifth Major League start (12th appearance) and first start this season...Made his 2020 debut on 8/4 vs. Miami, tossing 3.1 innings of relief (1 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 1 K, 1 HR)...Was acquired by the Orioles from Philadelphia in exchange for International Signing Bonus Slots on 6/9/19...Was acquired by Philadelphia from Houston along with RHP Vince Velasquez, RHP Mark Appel, LHP Brett Oberholtzer and RHP Harold Arauz in exchange for SS Harold Arauz and RHP Ken Giles on 12/12/15...Was originally selected by the Houston Astros in the 2nd round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Cal State Fullerton.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Made his Major League debut with the Orioles on 7/1 at Tampa Bay, taking a no-decision (5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, BB)...He did not record a strikeout in his debut, making him just the third pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) with at least 5.0 innings pitched in their Major League debut without a strikeout...Struck out his first career batter on 7/14 vs. Tampa Bay, striking out INF Willy Adames in the second inning and set a career-high with seven strikeouts in the start...Earned his first career win on 8/4 vs. Toronto, tossing 5.0 innings in relief...Made 10 appearances for Baltimore, pitching to a 1-2 record with a 6.50 ERA (26 ER/ 36.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts...Made 17 appearances (16 starts) across three different minor league affiliates (Double-A Reading, Triple-A Lehigh Valley, and Triple-A Norfolk), going 3-5 with a 4.65 ERA (48 ER/ 93.0 IP).

CAREER VS. WASHINGTON: This will be Eshelman's first career appearance against Washington.

INTERLEAGUE INFO: Eshelman will be making his second career Interleague start (third appearance)...His lone start came on 7/30/19 at San Diego when he worked 4.0 innings, allowing four runs on seven hits, two home runs, with a walk and five strikeouts...His other IL appearance was his 2020 season debut vs. MIA on 8/4.

START IT UP: This will be Eshelman's first start since 7/30/19 at San Diego, as his last six Major League appearances have been in relief...In four career starts to this point, Eshelman has posted a 0-2 record with a 7.36 ERA (15 ER/ 18.1 IP), seven home runs, six walks, and 15 strikeouts...He has not recorded a decision since earning the win in a relief outing on 8/4/19 vs. Toronto.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Eshelman held opposing left-handed batters to a .241 (14-for-58) average with two doubles and four home runs with the Orioles last season, while right-handers batted .359 (33-for-92) with four doubles and eight home runs against him...Between Triple-A Norfolk and Triple-A Lehigh Valley, Eshelman held International League left-handed batters to a .237 average (31-for-131) in 2019.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: In five career appearances (two starts) on the road, Eshelman has not recorded a decision and has a 5.40 ERA (11 ER/ 18.1 IP) with five walks and nine strikeouts.
