**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. Detroit over the weekend, followed by a loss to the Mets last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three against New York and wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel to Atlanta to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play the Braves at Truist Park for three games over the weekend.

**WHAT DOES THE FOX SAY:** Along with Twins.TV, tonight's game came be seen on FOX 9 (KMSP-TV) and Gray Media...it marks a new, multi-year partnership to broadcast 10 Tuesday night regular season games per season...all 10 simulcasts of Twins.TV production will air live in the Twin Cities on the main FOX 9 channel, beginning with an exclusive 30-minute FOX 9 pregame show, "Twins Tuesday Live"...select Gray Media stations in Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota and Iowa will carry each of the 10 Tuesday games, ensuring local over-the-air coverage of Twins baseball across Twins Territory for the first time since 1988.

**RAINY DAYS AND MONDAYS GET ME DOWN:** The Twins lost to the Mets last night at Target Field by a score of 5-1, falling to 0-6 in series openers...Joe Ryan was the starter and did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts — a season-high in Ks for a Minnesota starter...the offense recorded just three hits, walked three times and struck out 13 times, tying their season-high for punchouts...Matt Wallner had two of the club's hits, including a triple, his second of the season...Willi Castro went 0-for-4, snapping his on-base streak at 15 games.

**NEW YORK MINUTES:** The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 29th, 30th and 31st times in their history this week...Minnesota is 11-18 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 3-8 at Citi Field, 2-7 at Target Field...Minnesota's last win against the Mets was an 8-3 victory at Citi Field on July 31, 2024...their last win at Target Field came on September 9, 2023, an 8-4 victory...Twins are just 1-4 in their last five vs. New York and 4-14 in their last 18.

**ADDITIONALLY:** Since the start of 2023, Wallner has posted an .879 OPS and a .509 slugging percentage at the big league level...his OPS ranks eighth in the AL (minimum of 550 plate appearances) and his slugging percentage ranks 10th.

**PARDON MY FRENCH:** Yesterday afternoon, Ty France was named American League Player of the Week, his second career honor (also April 25, 2022)...over his last eight games, France has hit .407 (11-for-27) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, a .484 on-base percentage, a .704 slugging percentage and a 1.188 OPS.

☞ He ranks in the 97th percentile in baseball in strikeout percentage (7.7%).  
☞ He is hitting .333 (5-for-15) off breaking pitches...he is hitting .500 (3-for-6) against offspeed pitches.

**ROTATIONAL PULL:** In their first 10 games of the season, the Twins starting staff went 1-5, 6.90 ERA (45.2 IP, 35 ER), with 17 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .314 opponent batting average and 11 home runs allowed...in their last seven starts, since last Tuesday, they have combined to go 2-1, 0.96 ERA (37.1 IP, 4 ER), with seven walks, 36 strikeouts, a .173 opponent batting average and one home run allowed...below are the last seven starts:

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2017, two weeks into the major league season, Ervin Santana became the first pitcher in baseball to record a complete game win, one-hitting and shutting out the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field, under manager Paul Molitor...the only two complete games before that in 2017 had been of the eight-inning variety, and both had resulted in losses.

**SOMEWHERE OBER THE RAINBOW:** Last pitched on April 10 at Kauffman Stadium vs. the Royals...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-3 defeat...allowed one run on five hits in 6.0 quality innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...Twins led Kansas City 2-1 when Ober exited the game, but the Royals scored twice against the bullpen in the seventh.

- ⚡ His lone run allowed came on a single to leftfield from Salvador Perez, scoring Bobby Witt Jr.; this was Ober's first time allowing a run during the first inning so far this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on April 5 at Target Field vs. the Astros...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-1 victory...allowed one run on three hits in 4.0 innings, with two walks and five strikeouts.

- ⚡ His lone run allowed came on a leadoff homer from Jose Altuve of the first pitch of the game...this was his third career leadoff homer allowed and his second allowed on the first pitch.
- ⚡ Marked his first time allowing one-or-fewer earned runs since September 7, 2024 at Tampa Bay (0 R).

**THE NIGHT WE MET:** Has never pitched against the Mets...New York-NL is one of two remaining teams (excluding the Twins) that Ober has yet to face, the other being Chicago-NL.

- ⚡ Went 1-3 in seven Interleague starts in 2024 with a 6.94 ERA (36.1 IP, 28 ER), 11 walks and 36 strikeouts, allowing a .279 (39-for-140) opponent batting average...last IL start came on March 30 at St. Louis (2.2 IP, 8 ER)...has not won an IL start since July 22, 2024 vs. the Phillies.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In four seasons with the Twins, Ober has gone 14-9 with a 3.82 ERA (235.1 IP, 100 ER), 9.37 K/9, 2.26 BB/9 and 1.57 HR/9 in 45 starts at home compared to 11-13 with a 3.87 ERA (248.2 IP, 107 ER), 9.08 K/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.27 HR/9 in 46 road starts.

- ⚡ Ober is 0-4 in his last six starts at home, posting a 7.22 ERA (28.2 IP, 23 ER) with 11 walks and 32 strikeouts, allowing 23 runs off 30 hits (7 HR); compared to 5-0, 1.67 ERA (32.1 IP, 6 ER), with seven walks and 36 strikeouts, allowing eight runs off 21 hits...last home victory came on August 9 vs. Cleveland.
- ⚡ Ober is 2-2 when facing NL East opponents at home, posting a 7.32 ERA (19.2 IP, 16 ER), with eight walks and 17 strikeouts...allowing 16 runs on 22 hits.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through three starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .316/.435/.526 in 19 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .286/.324/.543 in 35 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 91.1 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 40.0 compared to righties' 91.9 mph and 63.0 percent.

- ⚡ Has a whiff rate of 18.9 percent vs. lefties and 26.0 percent vs. righties.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 40% of the time...primarily uses his slider and sweeper against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
