TODAY'S GAME: The Giants will try to salvage a game in this three-game series with a win in today's finale.

- ▶ By dropping games one and two of this series, SF has lost back-to-back games for the first time since dropping the first two of its series vs. Washington from April 8-9.
- ▶ Following the game SF heads west to Philly for a rare four-game wrap-around series Friday-Monday...they'll close out their road trip by going further west for three games in Colorado before hosting the Reds starting May 10.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Randy Rodríguez (#73) has been recalled from Triple-A Sacramento while RHP Daulton Jefferies has been optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

- ▶ Rodríguez is seeking his Major League debut...in 10 relief outings for Sacramento this year he had a 1.69 ERA (2er, 10.2ip with 10 strikeouts).
- ▶ The 24-year-old was originally signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Giants on July 2, 2017.

THE ROOK: LHP Kyle Harrison will make his first career start against the Red Sox and second career outing against an American League team (also vs. Cleveland on Sept. 13, 2023).

- ▶ Harrison most recently turned in his first shutout performance of the season on April 26 vs. PIT, striking out seven while allowing five hits and zero walks across 6.0 innings.
- ▶ On the road in his brief MLB career, Harrison is 2-2 with a 5.46 ERA (19er, 31.1ip), 23 strikeouts, 10 home runs allowed and a .920 opposing OPS in six career starts...he has a 2.97 ERA (12er, 36.1ip) in seven career home starts.
- ▶ Harrison throws his four-seam fastball 65.4% of the time...it has a +5 run value according to *Baseball Savant*...the Red Sox have dealt a lot of damage against four-seam fastballs with their .855 OPS ranking third in MLB.

A ROCK AND A HARD PLACE: SF has been unlucky when it comes to turning hard hit balls into hits and runs, especially in last night's game...according to *Sports Info Solutions*, SF had a xBA of .261 last night and an actual batting average of .161...xBA measures the chances that a batted ball will be a hit based on batted-ball data.

GRANDSON OF THE WIND CARL: OF Mike Yastrzemski, grandson of Hall of Famer and Red Sox legend Carl Yastrzemski, is playing his second career series here at Fenway Park.

- ▶ SF's Yaz went 4-for-13 with a double, a homer, two RBI, two walks and five runs scored in three games here back in 2019.
- ▶ In last night's game, Yastrzemski plated one of SF's two runs with an RBI bunt single...over his last 10 games, he is batting .370 (10x27) with four runs, two home runs, nine RBI and a 1.007 OPS (since April 18)...he began the year 4-for-33 through his first 13 games with no extra-base hits.

PUSH TO START: Thanks to a shutout inning by yesterday's opener, LHP Erik Miller, the Giants starters now have a 1.69 ERA (8er, 42.2ip) over their last nine games...they've struck out 38, walked 12 and allowed one homer in those 42.2 innings.

- ▶ Over their last 24 games dating to April 5, Giants starters have logged a 3.28 ERA (46er, 126.1ip), fifth-best in the Majors...in the National League specifically, it's the second-best starter's ERA behind the Phillies (2.32).

A PITCHER'S BEST FRIEND: With another groundball double play last night, the Giants have forced 31 this season, which is third-most in MLB, and second in the National League behind St. Louis' 33...Boston on the other hand has grounded into 18 double plays this season, tied for seventh-fewest in MLB.

- ▶ A major reason for the high volume of double plays is that Giants pitchers have forced an MLB-leading 418 ground balls with a 51.7% ground ball rate, which is 0.1% off the MLB lead (Atlanta, 51.8%).

WE LIKE TO GET A BRONZE ON: The Giants are 8-5 this season in day games compared to 6-12 in night games.

- ▶ SF has slashed .265/.322/.442 with 25 doubles, 16 homers and a .764 OPS in the 13 day games while averaging 4.8 runs/game.
- ▶ The .764 OPS in day games is fifth-best in the Majors...only the Brewers (.836), Orioles (.793), Padres (.790) and Braves (.774) are better.
- ▶ In the 18 night games, the Giants are slashing .220/.293/.321 as a team with 12 homers and a .614 OPS...they've averaged 3.1 runs/game at night.

BUCKET OF CHICKEN?: Over their last six games the Giants offense is slashing .202/.267/.319 and has scored a total of 13 runs...they are averaging 2.2 runs/game in that span and have gone 2-4 as a team in the win-loss column.

- ▶ They haven't scored more than three runs in any of those six games.
- ▶ SF has struck out 54 times in those six games and hasn't had fewer than seven strikeouts in any one of the six games.

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season today in the final game of this three-game series against the Red Sox...Harrison is 2-1 with a 4.09 ERA (15er, 33.0ip) in his six starts this season...the Giants are 4-2 in his starts this season, having won each of his last three.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

LAST TIME OUT: Logged his first scoreless start of the season and the third such start of his career last Friday vs. Pittsburgh in SF's 3-0 win...the Pirates were 1-for-10 against his changeup and breaking pitches...he threw 16 breakaing pitches in total, all for strikes while he threw 16 of his 27 changeups for strikes (six outs, one hit allowed on the changeup).

A LITTLE HELP FROM BUSTER: Former Giants catcher **Buster Posey** swung by the Giants' clubhouse last week and Harrison stopped him for a brief chat as he had been searching to find a feel for all three of his pitches at once...as told to the SF Chronicle, Harrison told Posey that he felt so close, yet so far from finding his footing..."you're going to feel like that your whole career," Posey told him..."it's that everlasting search."...Harrison took the advice and worked hard between starts in search of his slider, which he found in his start against the Pirates.

FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues...opposing hitters are 17-for-47 (.362) with three homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 19-for-83 (.229) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 65.4% of the time, highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches.

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited the walks through his first six starts, allowing just five free passes in 33.0 innings...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings...his 3.6% walk rate this season is ninth-lowest in MLB among qualifiers.

MORE FROM SIS: According to Sports Info Solutions, one career stat for Harrison that stands out is that his first time through the order, he has 36 strikeouts vs. 117 batters faced...other times through the order, he has just 30 strikeouts out of 151 batters faced.

LOTS OF PUNCHOUTS: Has struck out 66 batters in his first 13 big league games...according to *Stats, LLC*, since 1901, only two other Giants lefties have struck out 66-or-more batters through their first 13 games with the Giants: **LHP Shawn Estes** (71) and **LHP Andrew Suarez** (66).

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the southpaw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since **Madison Bumgarner** in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/28 vs. PIT; S, 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb (22 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), he has made 10 appearances, going 2-0-5 while allowing eight hits, two runs and five walks with 14 strikeouts (10.0ip) for a 1.80 ERA.
- ▶ 11 of his 14 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/30 at BOS; 1.1ip, h, hb, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...made his season debut on April 21, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/1 at BOS; 1.1ip, 2h, 2k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made three appearances since being reinstated (3.1ip, 4h, 0r, bb, 2k).
- ▶ Batters are 6-for-14 (.429) with two walks and two strikeouts vs. Jackson in his four appearances at the MLB level this year.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/1 at BOS; 1.0ip, 2bb, k (18 pitches) (start)

- ▶ Opened last night's game...was his first start since June 2, 2022 with Double-A Reading.
- ▶ Over his last 11 outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs over 11.1 innings (2.38 ERA) with 16 strikeouts, four walks, a 0.71 WHIP and a .111 opposing batting average (4x36).
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-16 off him early on...RHBs are 4-for-30.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).

#73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 4/30 vs. TAC (w/AAA); 1.0ip, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today and is on a Major League roster for the first time...is seeking his MLB debut.
- ▶ In 10 appearances at Triple-A (all in relief), Rodríguez had a 1.69 ERA (2er, 10.2ip) with 10 strikeouts and four walks...batters were hitting .184 off him to start the year.
