<u>TONIGHT'S TILT</u>...the Mariners continue their final homestand of the regular season with the 3rd of 3 games against the Houston Astros (1-1)...Seattle will also host the Texas Rangers (4 G, Sept. 28-Oct. 1) on the homestand...tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports** (710 AM) and **Mariners. com** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Dave Sims**.

**QDDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners defeated the Astros by a 6-2 score last night...the Mariners are 22-18 over their last 40 games, 30-20 over their last 50, 32-21 over their last 53, 35-22 over their last 57, 38-24 over their last 62 and 47-30 over their last 77 contests...the Mariners are 66-26 when scoring at least 4 runs and 19-46 when scoring 3-or-fewer...the Mariners are 42-34 at T-Mobile Park and 43-38 on the road this season...they are 28-27 in day games and 57-45 at night...Seattle would need to win each of their final 5 games of the season to match their 90-win campaigns from both 2021 and 2022.

- Going National Tonight's game will also be broadcast live on ESPN Radio with Roxy Bernstein and Tim Kurkjian on the call...the game will also be televised as part of MLB Network Showcase with Jon Morosi reporting live from T-Mobile Park and Matt Vasgersian and Tom Verducci on the call.
- Ouch! Seattle batters have been <u>hit by the most pitches (109)</u> this season, while Mariners pitchers have registered the 5th-fewest hit-by-pitches (55) this season.
- Firepower The Mariners have hit 204 home runs this season...Seattle has hit 200+ home runs in a season 8 times in franchise history: 1996-99, 2016-17, 2019 & 2023.

<u>POSTSEASON PICTURE</u>...the Mariners have 5 regular season games remaining (1 vs. HOU, 4 vs. TEX)... Seattle enters play today 3.0 games back of the Texas Rangers for the AL West Division lead and a half-game back of the Houston Astros for the 3rd and final AL Wild Card spot...the Astros have 4 games remaining (1 at SEA, 3 at ARI), the Rangers have 5 games remaining (1 at LAA, 4 at SEA) and Toronto has 5 games remaining (2 vs. NYY, 3 vs. TB).

THE GOLD STANDARD...defensively, Cal Raleigh's 24 catcher caught stealings <u>lead the Majors</u>... Julio Rodríguez's 12 Outs Above Average rank T-2nd among American League outfielders with Kevin Kiermaier-TOR, trailing only Luis Robert Jr.-CWS (13)... Eugenio Suárez' 10 OAA rank 2nd among AL third basemen, trailing only Maikel Garcia-KC (13).

J.P.: A CHANCE TO 'WALK' INTO HISTORY...J.P. Crawford this season has set career-highs in home runs (17) and RBI (58) and is on pace to set additional highs in on-base percentage (.376), slugging percentage (.427) and OPS (.804)...J.P. ranks T-2nd in the American League in walks (90) with Alex Bregman-HOU and Nathaniel Lowe-TEX, trailing only Shohei Ohtani-LAA (91)...no Mariners player has ever led the league in walks in franchise history (ties included)...Crawford's .376 OBP ranks 4th in the AL behind Ohtani (.412), Yandy Diaz-TB (.408) and Corey Seager-TEX (.394).

ASTOUND ON THE MOUND...the Mariners pitching staff ranks 2nd in MLB in ERA (3.76), 1st in strikeoutto-walk ratio (3.52), T-1st in walks-per-9 innings (2.56), 3rd in WHIP (1.19), 2nd in FIP (3.88) and 3rd in fWAR (19.8) this season...the Mariners are the only team in the Majors to have 3 pitchers with 17+ quality starts this season... George Kirby (19), Luis Castillo (18) and Logan Gilbert (17) make up the trio.

YOUNG PITCHING STUDS...Seattle pitchers age 26-or-younger lead the Majors in fWAR (13.8) by a wide margin over next-closest Los Angeles-NL (9.5), Cleveland (9.2) and Miami (9.1)...the Mariners have 4 pitchers that rank in the top-15 in MLB (age 26-or-younger): **George Kirby** (4.1 fWAR, 3rd), **Logan Gilbert** (3.2, 6th), **Bryce Miller** (2.1, T-13th) and **Matt Brash** (2.1, T-13th).

RE-PETEDLY BLANK'D...the Mariners pitching staff has recorded 16 shutouts this season, tied for most in MLB with San Diego...Seattle also set a franchise record, surpassing its 15 shutouts in 2003...Seattle leads the Majors registering 19 games with no walks, ranking ahead of San Francisco (18)...the Mariners are 14-5 (.737) in those contests.

THE J-ROD SHOW: AL MVP CANDIDATE?...Julio Rodríguez leads American League outfielders in fWAR (6.1) by more than a full "win", ranking ahead of Luis Robert Jr.-CWS (4.9) and Aaron Judge-NYY (4.9)...among AL outfielders with at least 400 plate appearances for the rate stats, Julio ranks 1st in hits (179), 2nd in stolen bases (36), 6th in batting average (.282), 4th in home runs (31), 2nd in runs scored (100), 3rd in RBI (102), 6th in slugging percentage (.493), 6th in OPS (.833), 4th in OPS+ (131), 2nd in doubles (37), 1st in total bases (313) and 2nd in extra-base hits (70)...in 2022, Julio won an AL Silver Slugger Award in his rookie season, alongside outfielders Aaron Judge-NYY and Mike Trout-LAA.

JULIO & GEORGE: SOPHOMORE STARS...Julio Rodríguez has produced 6.1 FanGraphs Wins Above Replacement this season, T-3rd-most in the American League with Marcus Semien-TEX (6.1) and trailing Shohei Ohtani-LAA (6.6) and Corey Seager-TEX (6.2)...George Kirby's 4.1 fWAR places him 7th among AL pitchers...the second-year stalwarts produced 5.4 and 3.0 fWAR, respectively, during their 2022 rookie campaigns...Rodríguez and Kirby became the first position player/pitcher rookie duo to accumulate 5.0+ and 3.0+ fWAR, respectively, as teammates since Alvin Davis and Mark Langston did it for the 1984 Mariners...Rodríguez and Kirby are the first teammate duo in Major League history with 5.0+ and 3.0+ fWAR, respectively, in their follow-up season of their rookie campaigns.

SILVER IN CAL'S FUTURE...Cal Raleigh leads Major League catchers in home runs (30) and is set to do so in back-to-back seasons after leading catchers with 27 HR in 2022...Raleigh is the first catcher in Mariners history with a 30+ homer season...the 26-year-old backstop is tied for the AL lead among catchers in fWAR (4.7) with Adley Rutschman-BAL...Raleigh has 5 multi-homer games this season, most among MLB catchers and tied for 5th-most overall.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...Cal Raleigh leads Major League catchers in home runs (30) this season, ranking ahead of Francisco Álvarez-NYM (23 HR) and Yainer Diaz-HOU (23)...Cal also leads the Majors in catcher caught stealings, nabbing 24 would-be base stealers and ranking ahead of Shea Langeliers-OAK (23 CCS), but...DID YOU KNOW?...that Raleigh could become the first catcher in 30 years to lead the Majors in both?...the last catcher to lead the big leagues in home runs as a catcher and catcher caught stealings in the same season was Hall of Famer Mike Piazza-LAD in 1993...Piazza led the way with 35 home runs and 58 catcher caught stealings.

### ABOUT BRYCE MILLER...

- The 24-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 25th career start, and his 3rd against the Houston Astros. Selected by Seattle in the 4th round (113th overall) of the 2021 MLB
- First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Derek Miller.

  Spent 3 seasons at Texas A&M from 2019-21...also spent 2 seasons playing for Brazos Valley Bombers of the Texas Collegiate League in 2018 and 2020, and 1 season with the Fal-
- mouth Commodores of the Cape Cod League in 2019. Was born in Mount Pleasant, Texas and attended New Braunfels High School in New Braunfels, Texas.

LAST TIME OUT...L#6 on 9/22 at TEX after tossing 4.1 innings and allowing 6 runs on 6 hits (2 HR) and 1 walk with 5 strikeouts.

ASTRO KILLER...in each of his 2 previous starts against Houston this season Miller has pitched at least 6.0 innings and allowed just 2 hits and no runs...Bryce has allowed just 6 total baserunners in 12.1 innings pitched against the Astros this season.

WILD WILD WEST...will make his 9th start against an AL West opponent this season...Miller currently owns a 3.86 ERA (18 ER, 42.0 IP) with 6 walks and 42 strikeouts...AL West opponents are batting just .215 (34x158) against Miller this season which is tied for the lowest among Mariners starters with Logan Gilbert.

KEEPING THE BASES CLEAN ... recorded his 5th start of the season where he has pitched 6.0+ innings and allowed 2-or-fewer hits in his start against Houston on 8/18...he is tied for the 5th most such starts in the Majors this season (also: Shohei Ohtani-LAA and Lucas Giolito-CLE).

THE CENTURY MARK ... recorded his 100th career strikeout in his outing against Oakland on 8/30 after striking out Ryan Noda in the 5th inning...his 100 strikeouts in his first 20 career games is tied for the 5th fastest to 100 strikeouts in franchise history (also: Roenis Elías).

MAKING MORE HISTORY...became the 1st pitcher since at least 1901 to go 6.0+ innings pitched and allow 2-or-fewer hits in at least 4 of his first 10 career appearances.

ROOKIE DOMINATION...allowed 153 runners to reach base safely through his first 24 career starts which is the 3rd the fewest in a pitcher's first 24 starts in franchise history (min. 100.0 IP)...he currently ranks behind Logan Gilbert (150).

FIRST 5 STARTS...became the 4th pitcher in franchise history to not allow a home run over his first 5 career starts, joining Michael Pineda, Jim Converse and Brian Snyder...his 4 earned runs allowed are tied for the fewest in a pitcher's first 5 career starts in franchise history, joining James Paxton (4 ER, 31.1 IP) and Justin Dunn (4 ER. 9.2 IP).

AN ALMOST PERFECT BEGINNING...took a perfect game into the 6th inning in his first career Major League start at Oakland on 5/2 before a Tony Kemp 1-out single broke up the no-hit bid...the 16-consecutive batters retired in a pitcher's MLB debut are the most since 1961 (h/t Elias Sports).

WHAT A DEBUT...became just the 3rd pitcher in MLB history to strike out 10 batters without issuing a walk in their Major League debut, joining RHP Johnny Cueto-CIN (4/3/08) and Stephen Strausburg-WSN (6/8/10)...became the 30th pitcher in MLB history to strikeout 10+ in their ML debut...also set a franchise record for most strikeouts in a debut moving ahead of Enrique Romo, who struck out 9 on 4/7/77

NO RUNNERS ALLOWED ... became the only pitcher in MLB history to have 3-or-fewer baserunners allowed in each of their first 3 career starts, his 8 baserunners allowed were the fewest in a pitcher's first 3 career appearances since at least 1901 (min. 15 IP).

MAKING IT LOOK EASY...he became the only pitcher in MLB history to have 6.0+ innings pitched and allow 3-or-fewer baserunners in his first 3 career starts...his 3-game streak of 6.0+ innings pitched and 3-or-fewer baserunners allowed is tied for the longest since 1901...Blake Snell-SDP and Corbin Burnes-MIL were the most recent pitchers to achieve this feat, both doing so in 2021.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING...became the 2nd pitcher in MLB history to go at least 6.0 innings and allow 2-or-fewer hits in each of his first 2 career games, joining Ken Cloude-SEA (1997)...via Sarah Langs.

IT'S BEEN 21 YEARS ... he became the first pitcher with a sub-1.00 ERA & 15 strikeouts over his first 2 career games since Kazuhisa Ishii-LAD (2002)...he is the only pitcher in MLB history to do that while allowing no more than 1 walk.
