**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners wrap up a series with the last of 3 games against the New York Mets (1-1)...Seattle will also visit the Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, 5/16-5/18) and Boston Red Sox (4 G, 5/19-5/22) on the 10-game road trip...the Mariners are coming off a 7-game homestand against the Tampa Bay Rays (1-3) and Philadelphia Phillies (1-2)...today's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Dave Sims** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Aaron Goldsmith**.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners dropped last night's middle game to the Mets by a 5-4 score...Seattle is 12-6 when scoring at least 4 runs and 3-13 when scoring 3 or fewer runs this season...the Mariners are 9-7 at T-Mobile Park and 6-12 on the road.

- **Sunny Day, Keeping The Clouds Away** - Seattle is 7-5 in 12 day games this season.
- **Romo's Return** - RHP **Sergio Romo** tossed 1.0 inning of scoreless relief last night in his first game since being reinstated from the 10-day IL...he had most recently appeared on April 11 at MIN.
- **Nice To Have 'Met' You** - With a Mariners win, they would hand the Mets their first series loss this season...New York owns a 9-0-1 series record and a 6-0 mark in rubber games heading into today's.
- **Series Record** - The Mariners own a 3-6-1 series record this season heading into today's rubber match...with a win today, Seattle would secure its first road series victory of 2022.
- **Yesterday's Move** - Seattle acquired minor league infielder **Alex Blandino** and cash considerations from San Francisco in exchange for outfielder **Stuart Fairchild**.

**I <3 TY**...**Ty France** went 2-for-5 last night...overall this season, he is batting .328 (44x134) with 15 runs, 4 doubles, 5 home runs, 25 RBI, 11 walks and 6 hit-by-pitches in 34 games...he's getting on base at a .401 clip, slugging .470 with an .871 OPS...his 44 hits lead the American League...his 12 multi-hit games this season are tied for 2nd-most in the AL along with teammate **J.P. Crawford**, trailing only Tim Anderson-CWS (13 multi-hit games).

**WINK SHOW**...**Jesse Winker** went 2-for-4 with a home run, 3 RBI and a walk last night...he hit a game-tying, 3-run blast in the top of the 7th inning off Mets southpaw reliever Chasen Shreve...in 44 plate appearances against left-handed pitchers this season, Winker is batting .289 (11x38) with 3 doubles, both of his 2 home runs with Seattle, 6 RBI and 6 walks, with a .386 on-base percentage.

**NYC NO MATCH FOR JPC**...**J.P. Crawford** went 1-for-4 with a run scored last night...overall this season, he is batting .327 (37x113) with 15 runs, 7 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 11 RBI, 14 walks and 3 hit-by-pitches in 32 games...he's getting on base at a .414 clip, slugging .513 with a .927 OPS...his 12 multi-hit games this season are tied for 2nd-most in the AL along with teammate **Ty France**, trailing only Tim Anderson-CWS (13 multi-hit games).

**LES MIZ**...**Anthony Misiewicz** tossed 1.0 scoreless inning of relief last night with a strikeout...in 12 games this season, he is 0-0 with a 1.86 ERA (2 ER, 9.2 IP) with 2 walks, 6 strikeouts and a 1.06 WHIP...last night marked his 99th career appearance, all with Seattle...with his next appearance, he will become the 77th pitcher in club history to make at least 100 appearances in a Mariners uniform.

**CAN'T HOLD HIM**...**Luis Torrens** reached base safely 4 times last night, going 2-for-2 with a pair of walks...it set a career-high for Torrens, whose previous career-high was reaching base safely 3 times in a game on 8 occasions, and most recently on Sept. 28, 2021 vs. Oakland.

**TWO "YUTE"S**...the Mariners have the 2nd-youngest group of position players in the Majors this season according to *Baseball-Reference*, with an average age of 26.8 years old...they trail only Cleveland (average age: 26.1)...Seattle has the T4th-youngest pitching staff in the Majors, with an average age of 27.8, trailing Cleveland (26.6), Cincinnati (27.1) and Kansas City (27.7).

**YOUNG RECALLED. SWANSON PLACED ON 15-DAY IL**...yesterday, left-hander **Danny Young** was recalled from Triple-A Tacoma and right-hander **Erik Swanson** was placed on the 15-day Injured List (right elbow inflammation)...in 13 games this season, Swanson is 0-0 with a 1.29 ERA (2 ER, 14.0 IP) with 1 walk and 21 strikeouts...his strikeout-to-walk ratio (21.0) is 2nd-highest in the Majors this season among pitchers with at least 14.0 IP to only Kevin Gausman-TOR (27.0)...Young has made 1 appearance with Seattle this season, making his Major League debut on May 9 vs. Philadelphia (2.1 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 SO).

**KYLE LEWIS UPDATE**...outfielder **Kyle Lewis** has appeared in 6 games on Major League rehab assignment with Triple-A Tacoma, batting .333 (8x24) with 5 runs, 1 double, 2 home runs, 6 RBI and 2 walks...he's gotten on base at a .385 clip, slugging .625 with a 1.010 OPS.

**HOMECOMING**...last night's starting pitcher **George Kirby** made his 2nd career Major League start...the Rye, New York native tossed 4.0 innings, allowing 3 runs (1 earned) on 3 hits with 1 walk and 1 strikeout on 89 pitches (60 strikes)...Kirby is the first player in American League history (since 1901) to accumulate 10.0+ innings, 8+ strikeouts, while allowing no more than 1 earned run and 1 walk over a starting pitcher's first 2 career Major League games.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...each of the first 2 games of the current Mariners-Mets series has been decided by 1 run...Seattle was victorious in Friday night's lid-lifter, winning by a 2-1 score...New York won last night's contest by a 5-4 advantage, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that since the beginning of the 2021 season, the Mariners (1st) and Mets (2nd) pace the Majors, respectively, in 1-run wins?...the Mariners have 39 one-run wins and the Mets have 36 since the beginning of last season...Seattle is 39-25 (.609) in 1-run games over that span, 3rd-best winning percentage in the Majors to Los Angeles-AL (.644/29-16) and San Francisco (.625/35-21)...the Mets are 36-39 (.480) in their 1-run games in that span, T18th-best winning percentage in MLB.

ABOUT RAY...

- The 30-year-old left-hander is set to make his 8th start of the season and first against the Mets...he is making his 201st career Major League appearance (197th start) and 7th career start against New York-NL.
- Named the 2021 American League Cy Young Award winner, receiving 29 of 30 first-place votes...Gerrit Cole-NYY received the only other first-place vote.
- In 2021 ranked 1st among American League starters in ERA (2.84), strikeouts (248), innings pitched (193.1), games started (32), WHIP (1.045), ERA+ (154) and Baseball-Reference Wins Above Replacement (6.7).
- 1 of 5 starting pitchers named to the All-MLB First Team.
- In 2021 led AL pitchers in quality starts (23), tied for 2nd-most in the Majors with Sandy Alcantara-MIA and trailing only Walker Buehler-LAD (28).
- In 2021, his 10 outings with at least 10 strikeouts were most among MLB pitchers, ranking ahead of Gerrit Cole-NYY (9).
- In 2021 ranked 3rd in the American League in strikeouts per 9 innings (11.54) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.77).
- In 2021 became first pitcher to lead his respective league in ERA, strikeouts and WHIP in a season since Clayton Kershaw-LAD in 2013 and the first in the American League since Justin Verlander-DET in 2011.
- Signed a 5-year contract with Seattle on Nov. 30, 2021.

**LAST TIME OUT...**W #3 in last start on 5/10 vs. Philadelphia...struck out a season-high 10 batters over 5.2 innings, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits (1 HR) and 2 walks.

**WORKHORSE...**ranks 3rd in the American League in innings per start with 6.16, ranking behind Justin Verlander-HOU (6.53) and Kevin Gausman-TOR (6.33), while ranking ahead of Frankie Montas-OAK (6.11) and Alek Manoah-TOR (6.00) who round out the top 5.

**GOING DEEP...**was one of just 4 MLB pitchers to throw at least 6.0 innings in each of his first 4 starts (also: Alek Manoah-TOR, Chris Bassitt-NYM, Joe Musgrove-SD) before only going 5.0 innings against Miami on 4/30.

**FIRST 200...**made his 200th career MLB appearance on 5/10 vs. Philadelphia...ranks 10th in MLB history with 1,331 career strikeouts through 200 career games.

**OPENING DAY W...**earned his first win of the season after tossing 7.0 innings allowing just 1 run on 3 hits (1 HR), 4 walks and a HBP, while striking out 5...became the 4th Mariners pitcher to toss at least 7.0 innings while allowing 1 run or less on Opening Day, joining Félix Hernández (5 times, last: 2015), Randy Johnson (1993) and Mike Moore (1984).

**PIECES OF EIGHT...**his 8 consecutive outings with at least 6.0 innings pitched and allowing 2 or fewer runs from July 28-Sept. 5, 2021 was the longest streak in the American League during the 2021 season.

**AL PITCHER OF THE MONTH...**won the award for the month of August 2021, sporting a 1.76 ERA (8 ER, 41.0 IP) over 6 starts, allowing 27 hits and 8 walks while recording 52 strikeouts with a 0.85 WHIP and a .188 batting average allowed...was his first career monthly award.

**200 STRIKEOUTS...**recorded his 4th season with at least 200 strikeouts (2016, 2017, 2019, 2021)...1 of 6 active pitchers with at least four 200+ strikeout seasons prior to turning 30 (Clayton Kershaw, Chris Sale, Madison Bumgarner, David Price, Justin Verlander).

**ELITE COMPANY...**recorded 49 strikeouts and 1 walk over a 6-start span from April 24-May 22, the 3rd pitcher in AL history to have 49+ strikeouts and no more than 1 walk over a 6-start span in a single season, joining Pedro Martinez (2000) and Gerrit Cole (2021).

**LEFT ON BASE...**his 90.1 left-on-base percentage in 2021 ranked highest in the Majors among qualified pitchers...ranked highest in Major League history in a season (min. 162 IP).

**'RAY' OF SUNSHINE...**tossed 6.1 innings of one-run ball on June 8, 2021 at Chicago-AL with 5 hits, 0 BB, and 13 strikeouts...the 13 K's were his most in a game since recording a career-high 14 on Sept. 4, 2017 at Los Angeles-NL...became the 2nd pitcher in Toronto history with 13+ strikeouts and 0 walks in a game, joining Roger Clemens (4x).

**1,000 INNINGS...**tallied his 10th win on Aug. 30, 2021 vs. Baltimore, giving up 2 runs and 4 hits over 7.0 IP with a walk and 10 strikeouts...reached 1,000 career innings after the 1st out of the 6th frame...his 1,241 strikeouts to that point were the most in a player's first 1,000 career innings in Major League history (2nd: Yu Darvish - 1,222).

**MISSED IT...BY THAT MUCH...**took a no-hitter into the 7th inning on July 11, 2021 at Tampa Bay...tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing 1 hit and 1 walk while striking out 11.

**GOLDEN WIN...**picked up his 1st win of 2021 and the 50th of his career on April 30 vs. ATL as he threw 6.2 IP allowing five hits and two earned runs (0BB, 5K)...went 12.2 innings without issuing a walk over his last two starts after tying his career high with six walks on April 18 at Kansas City.

**ADVANCED STATS...**ranked in the 93rd percentile in strikeout percentage, 87th percentile in whiff percentage, 76th percentile in expected batting average, 75th percentile in fastball velocity, 73rd percentile in walk percentage and 70th percentile in chase rate for the 2021 season.

**DOMINATE THE ZONE...**His 2.4 walks per 9 innings pitched in 2021 marked the largest decrease (7.8 BB/9 in 2020) among qualified starting pitchers from season to season in Major League history...via Elias Sports Bureau.

**14K...**Recorded 14 strikeouts on Aug. 25 vs. Chicago-AL, tying a career-high previously set in 2017...went 7.0 IP, allowing 1 R on 5 H, walking 1 and striking out 14.

**CAREER...**Is a veteran of 9 Major League seasons Detroit (2014), Arizona (2015-20), Toronto (2020-21) and Seattle (2022)...made his Major League debut with Detroit on May 6, 2014 vs. Houston...came into the 2022 season as Major League Baseball's all-time leader in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.21), minimum 1,000 innings pitched...his 1,241 strikeouts over his first 1,000 career innings pitched are the most all-time over a player's first 1,000 career innings in MLB history...drafted by Washington in the 12th round of the 2010 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Brentwood High School (TN).

27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 7th start of the season Monday at Toronto...L#5 in last start on 5/9 (5.0,9,6,6,1,5,2 HR)...Earned W#1 on 4/22 (7.0,6,1,1,0,5,HR)...has had 7 starts of 7.0 innings pitched and no more than 1 run allowed since the start of 2021, most in the AL during that span...Seattle owned a 22-9 record in Flexen's 31 starts in 2021...**WELCOME TO SEATTLE:** Signed a 2-year Major League contract with Seattle, that also includes an option for 2023 on December 18, 2020...**CAREER:** Flexen has appeared in 4 Major League seasons with New York-NL (2017-19) and Seattle (2021)...was originally selected by the Mets in the 14th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Newark Memorial (CA) High School...made his Major League debut with New York-NL on July 27, 2017 at San Diego...vs. TOR; 0-0 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER, 11.0 IP) in 2 career games against the Blue Jays.
