CAREER

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is ninth in Major League Baseball with 138 starts and is tied for fifth with 822.0 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

LAST START

Mikolas tossed 6.0 innings and allowed seven runs on nine hits with three strikeouts...He threw a season-high 99 pitches in the 12-11 win over the Houston Astros on July 6.

vs. NEW YORK

Mikolas is set to make his fourth career start against the New York Yankees...He is 1-0 with a 4.41 ERA (8 ER/16.1 IP) and nine strikeouts.

DON'T WALK SIGN

Mikolas leads Major League Baseball with just 0.92 walks per 9.0 innings since May 22...He's walked just five batters in 48.2 innings over this stretch...His 4.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio (22 SO/5 BB) over this stretch is ranked eighth in the National League.
