TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Padres meet for the first of a three-game series...SF has won 13 of its last 17 games overall entering play today and hold a 1. Dgame lead over the Dodgers for the NL West with 12 games remaining on the regular season schedule.

**NATIONAL LEAD:** The Giants' 97-53 current record puts them in contention for the best record by an NL team in the divisional era...their 97 wins through their first 150 games are the fifth-most in the NL since 1969...the 1975 Reds and 1986 Mets each finished the year with 108 wins, which is the best mark for any NL team since 1969.

BEST IN THE BIGS: The Giants (97-53, .647) enter tonight with the best record in the Majors, one game ahead of the Dodgers (96-54, .640)...the .647 winning percentage through 150 games is the club's best in the SF-era and the best by a Giant's team since 1913.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** San Francisco is 48-27 (.640) away from home this season, its sixth-best road win percentage in franchise history...SF's last trip was an undefeated six-game trek through Denver and Chicago in which the Giants outscored their opponents by 34 runs.

ROAD W'S: SF has won 12 of its last 14 road games...beginning July 2, the Giants' 24-8 (.750) road record is tops in MLB, ahead of the Brewers (26-11, .703, 2nd).

MOON SHOTS: The Giants have reached 227 home runs this season, surpassing the 2000 club (226) for second-most all time by a Giants team in a single season...the team needs just eight more homers to match a franchise-best 235 home runs done by the 2001 club...the Giants have hit at least one home run in 12 of 13 games against the Friars this season, including all six games at Petco.

**REACHING BASE: IF/OF Kris Bryant** has reached base safely in each of his last 18 games entering play today, his longest streak since a 23-game on-base streak from June 2-26, 2019 with the Cube. **DANCING IN SEPTEMBER:** The Giants are averaging 5.89 runs per game this month, on pace to be one of the team's highest-scoring Septembers in the modern era...SF has outscored their opponents 106-66 this month (*Stats, LLC*).

5 FOR +.500: RHP Kevin Gausman is one of Giants, 5+ Starting Pitchers with .500+ Win Pct. - All-Time five pitchers for the Giants who have made 20+ starts this season and have a win percentage of .500 or better...only three other rotations in franchise history have had five such pitchers (see chart).

3 MORE FOR 100: The Giants need just three more victories for 100 this year...just seven Giants teams in franchise history have won 100 games: 1904 NY Giants (106), 1905 NY Giants (105), 1912 NY Giants (103), 1962 SF Giants (103), 1993 SF Giants (103), 1913 NY Giants (101) and 2003 SF Giants (100)...this 2021 club is on pace for 105 wins

**GETTING CLOSER TO 1,500: C Buster Posey** is just 14 hits away from reaching the 1,500 hit milestone...he enters tonight's game with a current 13-game hit streak against San Diego, batting .408 (20-for-49) with three home runs and six RBI.

WITH RISP: Giants hitters are just 3-for-29 (.103) with hitting with RISP in their last five games.

#### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

RHP Joe Musgrove faces the Giants for the fourth time this season and the second time in the last week...he's 1-2 with a 6.75 ERA (12er, 16.0ip) in his three starts this year.

RHP Kevin Gausman is slated to face San Diego for the fifth time this year...he matched up with Pierce Johnson last Thursday at Oracle Park and allowed four runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings...overall, the right-hander is 2-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7er, 24.0ip) in his four starts against San Diego this year, including a 1.38 figure (2er, 13.0ip) in two starts here at Petco Park.

The Giants enter today with 227 homers, second-most in the Majors behind Toronto (240)...SF has scored 50.8% of their runs off home runs (374 of 736 total runs), most in the Majors...only two Giants teams since 1950 have led MLB in home runs (including ties for the lead) and only one since the team moved West in 1958: 1954 NY Giants (186 HR tied with Brooklyn) & 1972 SF Giants (150 HR)...the 227 homers are second-most in team history behind the 2001 club, who hit a franchise-best 235 homers.

TODAY'S OUTING: 2021 NL All Star will make his 31st start of the season in the second game of this three-game set against the Padres...the Giants are 19-11 in his starts this year, going 12-5 on the

innings of a 7-4 loss...it was just the fourth time all year he's allowed fouror-more runs in a start.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Gausman looks to continue his historical road numbers when he takes the mound today...his 2.11 road ERA is the third-best in MLB this year and the sixth-lowest among Giants pitchers all-time in a singleseason (min. 15 starts).

WINNING WAYS: Is looking to become the Giants' first 15-game winner since **Johnny Cueto** (18) and **Madison Bumgarner** (15) in 2016.

VS. SAN DIEGO: Has faced the Padres four times this season and is 2-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7er, 24.0ip).

FEWER THAN 3: Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 28 of 30 starts overall this year.

THIS IS 40: Is the fifth Giants pitcher since 1958 with an ERA under three in his first 40 starts with the team according to Stats, LLC (see chart)

SECOND HALF: Is 5-3 with a 4.77 ERA (32er, 60.1ip) and a .278 batting average against in 12 second half starts...went 9-3 with a 1.73 ERA (22er, 114.2ip) in 18 first half starts.

70%: Gausman has won 70% of his decisions this season and his ERA is south of 3.00...according to Stats, LLC, only a few of the biggest names in recent Giants history can boast of such a season in the wild card era.

WITH RISP: Opposition is 20-for-

# DICK TIDROW

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, MO. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children— Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
