BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles and Astros open a three-game set tonight after Baltimore dropped two of three games to Boston this past weekend.

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** hit his ninth home run on Sunday, which are tied for fifth most in the AL entering play today...Five of the nine long balls have come off relief pitchers, which are tied for second most in the AL entering play today behind CHW's Munetaka Murakami (8 HR).

👉 In Sunday's 5-3 defeat, the Birds fell to 2-10 (.167) when scoring three runs or fewer, compared to 11-5 (.688) when scoring four or more runs.

👉 Boston swiped four bags in Sunday's rubber match, the most bags Baltimore has allowed an opponent to steal since June 30, 2025 at Texas (also 4).

👉 The Orioles are hitting .263 at Camden Yards this season compared to .209 when on the road...The 0.54 difference is the third largest in MLB (home better than road) behind Kansas City (0.80 difference) and Pittsburgh (0.62), per *STATS Perform*.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward has reached safely in 26 of the last 27 games since March 28 while slashing .324/.438/.476 (34-for-105) with 13 doubles, one homer, 14 runs scored, 11 RBI, 21 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on April 15.

👉 He has drawn a walk in a career-high six straight games, tied for the second-longest active run in the majors behind ATH's Nick Kurtz (16 G)...The last Oriole to accomplish the feat in seven straight was **Anthony Santander** (also 7 G) from May 18-25, 2023.

👉 Ward's .424 on-base percentage ranks fourth in MLB behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (.465), NYY's Ben Rice (.447), and MIA's Xavier Edwards (.435)...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

👉 His 13 doubles are tied for the MLB lead with TOR's Ernie Clement

👉 He's reached base safely 56 times (34 H, 21 BB, 1 HBP), fourth most in the majors behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (60 TOB) and LAA's Mike Trout/WSH's James Wood (both 57 TOB)

👉 Ward has faced 565 total pitches this season, the eighth-highest clip in the majors... Teammate **Gunnar Henderson** ranks ninth with 563.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: Rico Garcia has posted a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) with 14 strikeouts across 13 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

👉 He has yet to allow a hit in each of his first six home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of five Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023), **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019), **Brian Matusz** (6 G, 2013), and **Jorge Julio** (6 G, 2003).

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: Samuel Basallo is slashing .333/.415/.694 (12-for-36) with one double, four home runs, six runs, seven RBI, and five walks against five strikeouts over his last 11 games since April 12...Over his last four starts since April 20, he is 9-for-16 (.563) with one double, two home runs, four runs, four RBI, and two walks.

👉 Basallo has hit safely in each of his first four career starts against the Astros, going 4-for-15 (.267) with one double, two RBI, one walk, and one hit-by-pitch...He made his MLB debut last season at Daikin Park on August 17.

RISPY BUSINESS: In 19 games since April 6, the Birds are 33-for-157 (.210) with runners in scoring position, tied for the fourth lowest average in MLB during that period ahead of the Royals (.207), Cardinals (.202), and White Sox (.186).

👉 Jeremiah Jackson (.368, 7-for-19), Taylor Ward (.357, 5-for-14), and Leody Taveras (.350, 7-for-20) pace the O's in RISP average, while Samuel Basallo (.125, 2-for-16), Colton Cowser (.083, 1-for-12), and Blaze Alexander (.077, 1-for-13) have yet to get going.

👉 Pete Alonso's 33 at-bats with runners in scoring position lead the club and he has five hits (3 2B, 1 HR) and seven RBI in such situations.

👉 Baltimore has 68 strikeouts as a team with runners in scoring position, the seventh-highest mark in the majors.

A LOOK UNDER THE HOOD: Baltimore hitters have posted a combined .380 on-base percentage against fastballs and a .288 on-base percentage against off-speed pitches, ranking eighth and tied for sixth in the majors, respectively...**Gunnar Henderson** is 16-for-62 (.258) with two doubles, one triple, six home runs, and a .613 slugging percentage on all heaters, but has yet to deliver a knock against an off-speed offering, going 0-for-21 with eight strikeouts.

👉 Their .235 on-base percentage against breaking pitches is the lowest mark in MLB, trailing the Mets (.239) and Diamondbacks (.242)...**Adley Rutschman** (.400, 6-for-15) and **Leody Taveras** (.333, 5-for-15) lead the way among Oriole hitters against such pitches.

TIGHT SQUEEZE: The Orioles have played 21 games decided by three runs or less, second in the majors behind the Mariners (22)...The Birds are 9-12 (.429) in those games...The Orioles have also played 16 games decided by two runs or fewer, tied with the Mariners and Yankees for second most in the majors behind the Cardinals and Guardians (both 17 G), going 9-7 (.563) in those affairs.

'PEN PALS: Grant Wolfram has not allowed a home run in 31.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 36.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

👉 The O's 14.7 percent inherited runners scored rate (5 IRS/34 IR) is third in MLB behind the Rockies (13.6%; 6 IRS/44 IR) and Mariners (14.3%, 5 IRS/35 IR).

👉 The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

IN ORBIT: The O's and Astros meet tonight for the first of six matchups this season...In the first series following the All-Star break, Baltimore travels to Daikin Park for a three-game set from July 17-19.

👉 Orioles Head MLB Strength Coach **Trey Wiedman** spent eight seasons in the Astros organization, most recently as the major league assistant strength and conditioning coach (2017-19).

👉 Baltimore Bullpen Coach **Hank Conger** played seven MLB seasons from 2010-16,

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his sixth start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Baz did not factor into the decision on April 21 at Kansas City after throwing a season-high 6.1 innings, allowing four runs on eight hits and two walks with four strikeouts...Threw 98 pitches, 62 strikes.
 ⚡ Has walked multiple batters in each of his last four starts after issuing zero free passes in his first start on March 29 vs. Minnesota.

HOMETOWN SHOWDOWN: The Houston, Texas native has made three career starts opposite the Astros, going 0-1 with a 4.00 ERA (8 ER/18.0 IP).
 ⚡ Last faced Houston on May 29, 2025 as a member of the Rays and did not factor into the decision (5.2 IP, 7 H, 3 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 3 K).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: In his previous start on April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.
 ⚡ Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 15 doubles, ahead of SEA's Logan Gilbert and SF's Adrian Houser (both 13).
 ⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his five starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.
 ⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: **Brad Bergesen** (2010), **Mike Mussina** (2000, 1996), **Pat Rapp** (2000), and **Scott Erickson** (1996).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 11 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted two home runs over 56.2 innings (0.32 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP), including a career-high five long balls on August 19, 2025 vs. New York-AL.

CUTTING IT UP: Baz has held opponents to a .172/.250/.345 (5-for-29) line with two doubles, one home run, and an 18.8 percent strikeout rate off his cutter.
 ⚡ The opposition has combined to slash .358/.404/.556 (29-for-81) with 13 doubles, one home run, and an 18.1 percent strikeout rate on all his other offerings.
 ⚡ Baz has allowed opponents to go 15-for-43 (.349) with seven doubles off his knuckle curve after holding them to a .214 (48-for-224) mark with 15 doubles during the 2025 campaign.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Left-handed hitters are slashing .373/.438/.567 (25-for-67) with 10 doubles and nine walks, compared to .209/.239/.395 (9-for-43) with five doubles and one walk by righties.
 ⚡ Baz's 1.005 opponent OPS vs. lefties is third-highest in MLB (min. 80 BF), with the next closest being TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.027) and STL's Dustin May (1.014).

ODDS AND ENDS: Baz has limited the opposition to a 2-for-15 (.133) average with runners in scoring position and two outs.
 ⚡ Baz has allowed hitters to go 11-for-21 (.524) with six doubles and one home run on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.498 opponent OPS on the first pitch is the highest in MLB (min. 20 BF), ahead of TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.223).
 ⚡ Has limited opponents to a .231 (9-for-39) mark the first time through the lineup, compared to a combined 25-for-71 (.352) clip the second and third time through.
