ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (92-67) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (60-99) OCTOBER 3, 2022 at PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA -- GAME #160/HOME #79 LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (6-7, 2.99 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (5-12, 3.92 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...closed out the road portion of their 2022 campaign with a 7-5 win yesterday afternoon against the Cardinals...Have won four of their last six and five of their last eight games...Are in the final three games of a stretch that has the team playing each of the last 13 games against the NL Central to close out the year.

TODAY'S TRANSACTION: Prior to tonight's game the Pirates recalled right-handed pitcher Nick Mears from Triple-A Indianapolis...To make room for Mears on the 28-man active roster, right-handed pitcher Luis Ortiz has been optioned to the minor leagues...Mears will wear uniform #36.

HERE'S THE LINE ON KELLER: Mitch Keller will make his final start of the 2022 season tonight after allowing one run in 5.0 innings in his last outing on September 27 against the Reds here at PNC Park...Since the beginning of last month, the 26-year-old Keller has recorded the eighth-lowest ERA (1.80) in all of Major League Baseball and fifth-lowest among all National League pitchers.

GETTING TO KNOW YOU: The Pirates are in the final three games of a stretch that has the team playing each of their final six games of this season against the Cardinals...It's the first time the Pirates have played six-plus games against the same opponent to end the season since doing so in seven straight games at the end of the 1958 season against the Phillies (courtesy of StatsBySTATS).

THE FINAL STAND: The Pirates have won three straight and four of their last five games here at PNC Park...A win tonight would give Pittsburgh its first four-game winning streak at home since also winning four in a row from September 24-27, 2019.

MILESTONE WATCH: Bryan Reynolds connected for his 27th home run of the season yesterday afternoon in St. Louis and enters today three hits shy of 500 in his career...Since the beginning of the 2019 season, Reynolds' 497 hits are the ninth-most among all National League players, trailing Freddie Freeman (625), Trea Turner (619), Paul Goldschmidt (567), Nolan Arenado (544), Manny Machado (543), Charlie Blackmon (528), Pete Alonso (509) and Dansby Swanson (507).

TURNING TWO: Ke'Bryan Hayes has turned a total of 36 double plays this season, which ranks fourth in MLB and second among all third basemen in the National League behind St. Louis' Nolan Arenado (41)...The only two third basemen in Pirates history to record more double plays in a single season are Pie Traynor with 41 in 1925 and Bob Bailey with 38 in 1963.

CRUZIN' ALONG: Oneil Cruz recorded a pair of hits in yesterday's win at St. Louis and now has multiple hits in five of his last six games, going 12-for-26 (.462)...Since the beginning of last month, Cruz ranks second among all rookies in MLB in OPS (.916) and slugging (.557), third in total bases (59) and tied for second in extra base hits (14).

10X2: Sunday afternoon in St. Louis Oneil Cruz became one of eight rookies in Major League history to record 10-plus home runs and 10-plus stolen bases and play in 90 or fewer games during their first Major League season...Prior to Cruz, the last rookie to accomplish that was San Diego's Fernando Tatis Jr. in 2019...Cruz is also one of just five rookies in club history with 15-plus homers and 10-plus stolen bases, joining Garrett Jones in 2009, Al Martin in 1993, Barry Bonds in 1986 and Gus Suhr in 1930.

HELLO NEWMAN: Kevin Newman is hitting at a .359 clip (33-for-92) this season against lefties (he entered this year as a .256 career hitter against southpaws)...He enters today hitting safely in each of his last 11 starts, going 13-for-42 (.310)...On Saturday he collected his 400th career hit with a single off St. Louis' Jake Woodford.

LOVING LEFTIES: Pittsburgh has hit a total of 55 home runs this season off left-handed pitchers...That's the sixth-most home runs in all of Major League Baseball, trailing only the Rangers (72), Giants (69), Astros (68), Yankees (65) and Dodgers (56)...Coming into today, Pittsburgh's 55 home runs against lefties are the fourth-most in a single season in team history...The only three times Pittsburgh has hit more homers off lefties in a single season came in 1979 (65), 1990 (63) and 1987 (60).

CASHING IN AT PNC: Jack Suwinski has gone deep four times in his last nine games at PNC Park while hitting .320 (8-for-25) with a 1.318 OPS in those contests...Suwinski's 15 home runs at PNC Park coming into today are also tied for the seventh-most in a single season in PNC Park history...Brian Giles holds the single-season record with 18 in 2001.

MITCH KELLER: The 26-year-old righthander will make his 29th start (31st appearance) tonight...He allowed one run in 5.0 innings but had a no-decision in his last start; a 4-1 win Tuesday vs. the Reds...Has gone 3-6 with a 2.65 ERA (78.0ip/23er) over his last 14 outings since July 11...Has allowed three or fewer earned runs in 18 of his last 21 starting assignments since returning to the rotation on 5/31.

VS. ST. LOUIS: 2-1 with a 3.35 ERA (37.2ip/14er) in seven career starts...Is 0-1 in three starts this season; suffered a 6-2 loss on 4/9 at Busch Stadium (4.0ip/4er), was in line for the win (5.1ip/2r) but had a no-decision in a 7-5 loss at Busch on 6/13 and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings but had a no-decision in a last at-bat loss on 9/11 at PNC Park...Went 1-0 in two starts in 2021; pitched 5.0 scoreless innings in a combined 4-0 shutout at Busch Stadium on 8/20 and gave up seven runs in 5.1ip on 8/26 at PNC Park (no-decision).
