- TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants and Dodgers meet for the first time since mid-May, and play six of their final nine games against each other...SF is 4-3 in the season series thus far, going 2-2 here at UNIQLO Field at Dodger Stadium.
- ▶ San Francisco looks to finish above .500 against LA for the first time since 2021 (10-9).
- ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game:
- ▶ **RHP Logan Webb** placed on the 15-day Injured List with a right middle finger blister (retro to Sept. 15).
 - ▶ **IF Nate Furman** placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right oblique strain (retro to Sept. 16).
 - ▶ **RHP Duncan Davitt** (#76) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
 - ▶ **OF Victor Bericoto** (#78) returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 10-day Injured List.

- ROAD WRAP UP:** These three games with the Dodgers will conclude the Giants' road schedule in 2026...with a 28-50 (.359) record on the road this season, SF is currently tied for its most road losses since going 31-50 (.383) in 2018...SF has lost more than 50 road games in just three seasons in the SF era (since 1958), doing so in 2017 (55), 1992 (51) and 1985 (57).
- ▶ SF is coming off a 2-1 series win at St. Louis earlier this week, marking their first road series victory of 3+ games since June 5-7 at Chicago-NL...SF is just 2-11-0 (win-loss-tied) in their past 13 road series (one of those wins was the single game at Atlanta, which counts as a one-game series).
 - ▶ The Giants are 5-5 in their last 10 road games.

- WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** The Giants have had 16 players make their MLB debuts this season, tying a franchise record from 2008...the 16 debuts are also most in MLB in 2026.
- ▶ SF has also had 67 different players appear in a game this season, which is a franchise record (previous: 66 in 2022)...the 67 players used by SF is tied with 2019 Seattle for the sixth-most players used in a single season in MLB history (*Stats, LLC*)...it's the most players used by any team this season (Mets rank second with 64 players used).
 - ▶ Of SF's current 28-man roster, 14 are rookies and another six had under a year of service time entering 2026...since the start of August, the Giants have had 10 players make their MLB debuts, six of whom are pitchers.
 - ▶ The Giants have 22 players currently on the Injured List (16 on the 60-day IL).

- THE BRYCE IS RIGHT:** **IF Bryce Eldridge** is slashing .330/.423/.541 with 28 RBI over his last 29 games...his 28 RBI since August 14 are third-most in the Majors behind teammate Rafael Devers (34) and Pete Crow-Armstrong (32).
- ▶ Eldridge has a .500 slugging percentage against left-handed pitchers...is on pace to be the highest mark by a rookie left-handed batter (min. 100 PA) since Nolan Jones in 2023 (.525) and the highest mark by a Giants rookie LHB over the last 50 years (*STATS, LLC*).
 - ▶ Is one of three Giants in team history to hit 17+ homers as a rookie at 21 years of age or younger...**Willie Mays** (20 HR in 1951) and **Orlando Cepeda** (25 HR in 1958) are the others.

- ON THE FARM:** *Baseball America* put out its farm system grades for 2026, with SF receiving one of two A+ grades (also St. Louis)...this comes after SF's system jumped from No. 14 preseason to No. 4 overall in BA's August farm system rankings.
- ▶ Key graduations from BA: **1B Bryce Eldridge, C Daniel Susac, C Jesus Rodríguez & RHP Dylan Smith.**
 - ▶ Breakouts: **SS Josuar Gonzalez, SS Luis Hernandez, SS Joniel Hernandez, C Drew Cavanaugh, OF Jonah Cox & LHP Joe Whitman.**
 - ▶ Key additions: **SS Luis Hernandez, RHP Jackson Flora, LHP Henry Lalane, RHP Ramon Marquez, LHP Carson Boleman, SS Joniel Hernandez, RHP Miguel Mendez, 2B Kaeden Kent, RHP Kaden Waechter, OF Peyton Bonds, RHP Eric Nachtsheim & LHP Matt Wilkinson.**

WHAT'S UP, ROOK?: The 24-year-old from San Juan de los Morros, VZ is in his debut MLB season...this is Perdomo's third level this season (also Double-A and Triple-A).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Made his MLB debut on September 1 at Pittsburgh, becoming the 15th Giants player to make their MLB debut this season...he became just the seventh Giants left-handed pitcher since 1899 to throw at least 4.0 innings of relief in their MLB debut as shown in the chart below.

LAST TIME OUT: Stumbled last Saturday against the Padres at Oracle Park in SF's 7-6 defeat...suffered the loss after allowing five runs on 10 hits in 4.2 innings while walking two and striking out three...the 10 hits allowed matched the most he'd allowed in any outing in his professional career since his first pro season in 2022...the outing was a departure from his first two outings (one start) where he allowed one run six hits in 10.0 total innings.

UNDER THE HOOD: The Padres did a good job of hitting Perdomo's two primary pitches, his fastball and changeup...in his first two starts combined, the Pirates and Mets went 3-for-10 on his four-seamer and 1-for-14 on his changeup...the Padres, however, went 5-for-8 with five singles off his four-seamer while going 4-for-13 off his changeup...all three of his strikeouts vs. San Diego came on his changeup.

WITH THE RIVER CATS: Was 7-2 with a 5.10 ERA (27er, 47.2ip) in nine games for Triple-A Sacramento prior to is promotion...he was in excellent form prior to his call-up...after starting 1-2 in his first three Triple-A starts, Perdomo went 6-0 with a 3.89 ERA (16er, 37.0ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP over his final six AAA starts since July 30.

WITH THE SQUIRRELS: Went 2-4 with a 3.98 ERA (32er, 72.1ip), 89 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP in 13 starts for Double-A Richmond prior to his promotion...at the time of his promotion to Double-A, Perdomo's 89 strikeouts were ninth-most in all of Double-A.

SPLITS: Was burned by left-handed hitters in Triple-A, with them holding a .348/.434/.576 slash line compared to a .264/.319/.424 slash line against right-handed hitters...through three MLB games, lefties are 8-for-22 (.364) with two homers off him...righties, who were 1-for-19 (.053) in his first two starts, are now hitting .235 (8-for-34) after Padres' righties went 7-for-15 with two walks.

LAST SEASON: Spent the entire 2025 season with High-A Eugene...led the NWL in innings pitched (127.1)...he ranked inside the league's top-5 in games started (26, T-1st), WHIP (1.24, 2nd), wins (8, T-3rd), ERA (3.96, 4th) and strikeouts (118, 4th).

- ▶ Is 1-3 with a 4.54 ERA in 41 games between the A's (25g) Brewers (10g) and SF (6g) at the MLB level this year.
