TWINS TAKE IT FROM OPENING TIP: The Twins beat the Angels yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-1. Simeon Woods Richardson (2-2) was the starter and winner...

IT STARTS WITH ONE: Since April 8, Twins starters rank second in baseball in ERA (2.45)... below are starters numbers in their first 10 games (March 27-April 7)...

SEND ME AN ANGEL: The Twins and Angels are playing the third of six games in 2025... Minnesota has gone 7-1 in their last eight against Anaheim...

Since the start of last season, the Twins are hitting .330 (92-for-279) with 8.3 runs-per-game and a .958 OPS in eight games with Anaheim. Ty France is hitting .293 (24-for-82) with 17 RBI and a .914 OPS in his last 23 games against the Angels...

SORI, NOT SORI: The Twins faced José Soriano exactly one year ago today at Angel Stadium, posting four runs on him on three hits and three walks as the Twins won 16-5...

SWEEPING SUCCESS: Minnesota is seeking its first sweep of the season today and first since August 2-4, 2024, when they took all three from the White Sox at Target Field...

PLUS-MINUS: Through the Atlanta series on April 20, the Twins were at a 2025 low-water mark of -20 (75-95) in terms of run differential...

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a season-long 11-straight games (career-high is 13, 7/6-26/24)...

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita catcher/outfielder Ricardo Olivar and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Cole Peschl as Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Olivar, 23, played in four games for the Wind Surge this week, going 8-for-17 (.471) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI and a 1.265 OPS... Olivar is ranked as the club's 16th-best prospect, per MLB.com.

- ☞ Making his sixth start of 2025 and 90th of his career...took the loss in his last outing on April 20 at Atlanta (5.0 IP, 8 H, 3 HR, 6 ER, 1 BB, 5 K)
- ☞ In three career starts against Los Angeles-AL, is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA (16.0 IP, 8 ER), four walks and 24 strikeouts...has not faced the Angels since September 24, 2023 at Target Field (W, 6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER, 0 BB, 10 K).
- ☞ Is 2.2 innings away from 500 IP in his major league career.

LAST TIME OUT: Started on April 20 at Truist Park in Atlanta opposite right-hander Grant Holmes...took the loss, his second of the season, allowing six runs on eight hits (3 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings...surrendered a run in each of his innings except the fourth, including two-run homers in the first and third, and a solo shot in the fifth...prior to the game, Ryan had not allowed six earned runs in an outing since September 29, 2023 at Colorado, when he also allowed eight hits and three home runs in 5.0 innings.

☞ The Twins pitching staff entered the game with a major league best 20 two-out runs allowed until the first five runs scored by Atlanta came with two outs in their respective innings...Ryan had previously allowed two two-out runs this season – on March 29 in St. Louis and April 14 vs. New York at Target Field.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started on April 14 vs. New York-NL at Target Field opposite right-hander Clay Holmes...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-1 loss, allowed one run on three hits over 5.0 innings, walking two and striking out eight...his one run allowed came on a Pete Alonso RBI single in the third inning...was his first outing of the year with 90+ pitches thrown (101) and his first outing allowing a walk since August 2, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL.

☞ Struck out the side in the second inning, the second time this season he's retired all three batters in an inning via the strikeout; also did so in the first inning on April 3 vs. Houston.

FACING LOS ANGELES-AL: In three career starts against the Halos, Ryan is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA (16.0 IP, 8 ER), four walks and 24 strikeouts...last outing came on September 24, 2023 at Target Field; earned the win, allowing three runs on seven hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts over 6.0 innings...the Angels are one of two teams that Ryan has faced at least twice and not allowed a home run to; also, San Francisco...has allowed a base runner in 11 of his 16 innings pitched against the Angels.

☞ In 18 career starts against the American League West, Ryan is 5-8 with a 5.11 ERA (93.1 IP, 53 ER), 32 walks and 117 strikeouts.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': The San Francisco native and California State University alumnus is 4-3 in 10 career starts against California teams with a 5.63 ERA (54.1 IP, 34 ER), eight home runs, 19 walks and 65 strikeouts (A's- 2, LAD-1, SD-1, SF-3, LAA-3)...here is how Ryan ranks among Twins pitchers with at least five starts against California teams since 2021:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his third home start of the season, last on April 14 vs. New York-NL...in his last five home starts dating back to July 6, 2024 vs. Houston, he is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (28.0 IP, 14 ER), five home runs, six walks, 35 strikeouts and a 1.04 WHIP; Twins are 2-3 and have been outscored 15-37...in his career, Ryan is 19-13 in 45 home starts with a 3.75 ERA (256.2 IP, 107 ER), 60 walks and 301 strikeouts, compared to 15-15 in 44 road starts with a 4.11 ERA (240.2 IP, 110 ER), 52 walks and 252 strikeouts; 20 of his 40 career quality starts have come at home.

☞ His 301 career strikeouts at home rank third all-time among pitchers at Target Field; Kyle Gibson (436) and José Berrios (432) lead the list...of pitchers with 10-or-more starts at Target Field, Ryan's 1.02 WHIP ranks first while his 5.02 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks fourth.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .224/.255/.388 with two home runs, no walks and eight strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .231/.310/.442 with three home runs, three walks and 20 strikeouts...in 2024, left-handed hitters slashed .203/.243/.373 with nine home runs, 11 walks and 61 strikeouts in 255 plate appearances, while right-handed hitters slashed .229/.269/.425 with 10 home runs, 12 walks and 86 strikeouts in 283 plate appearances.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .207 (185-for-892) with a .631 OPS...righties are .238 (234-for-983) with a .734 OPS.

☞ In his three career starts against Los-Angeles-AL, lefties slashed .250/.333/.292 with three walks and nine strikeouts, while righties slashed .308/.317/.462 with one walk and 15 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through five starts in 2025, Ryan has relied on a five-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

☞ With 443 pitches thrown so far this season, Ryan's average exit velocity is 92.6 mph with a hard hit rate of 47.9 percent, compared to 88.3 mph and 36.6 percent in 2024...his strikeout rate is 25.7 percent and his walk rate is 2.8 percent, compared to 27.3 percent strikeout rate and 4.3 percent walk rate in 2024.

☞ Ryan threw two 95.2 mph fastballs in his last outing against the Braves, both to Austin Riley in the first inning...he threw nine pitches between 94.0-94.9 mph, two of which were sinkers...also, his nine total whiffs induced were his second fewest of the season; induced seven whiffs in his first outing on March 29 at St. Louis.

THROUGH THE FIRST 90: Today's start marks the 90th of Ryan's career...among Twins pitchers (1961-present) through their first 90 career starts with the club, Ryan's 3.93 ERA through 89 starts ranks ninth behind teammate Bailey Ober's 3.88 ERA...his current 553 strikeouts rank second behind Johan Santana's 622 strikeouts; Dave Boswell is next closest with 529 strikeouts...his current 112 walks are the fourth fewest behind Kevin Tapani (107), Bailey Ober (107) and Kevin Slowey (81).

☞ Ryan is one of five active starters in the major leagues with over 100 innings pitched in 90-or-fewer starts...among such players, he ranks third in strikeouts (553), second in walks (112) and first in WHIP (1.068)...also, he is one of two such pitchers that has thrown a complete-game shutout (Nestor Cortes is the other).

CAREER NOTES

- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive season in the Twins' opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.

NEED THE SUN TO BREAK: In three daytime starts this season, Ryan is 0-2 with a 6.60 ERA (15.0 IP, 11 ER), five home runs allowed, a 1.267 WHIP and a .295/.358/.557 opponent slashline (61 at-bats), compared to 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER), no home runs, a .583 WHIP and a .125/.167/.200 opponent slashline (40 at-bats); the only game the Twins have won this season when Ryan started was on April 9 at Kansas City, a night game.

☞ In his career, Ryan is 14-14 with a 3.63 ERA (213.1 IP, 86 ER), 32 home runs, a 1.041 WHIP and 5.30 strikeouts-per-walk allowed in 39 daytime starts, compared to 20-14 with a 4.15 ERA (284.0 IP, 131 ER), 48 home runs, a 1.088 WHIP and 4.71 strikeouts-per-walk allowed.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2025: 2-1, 5.41 ERA // CAREER: 27-22, 3.83 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is set to start tomorrow night's series opener in Cleveland...last pitched on April 22 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, earning his second-straight win in Minnesota's 4-2 victory; allowed one run on eight hits over 6.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...is facing the Guardians for the ninth time in his career; is 2-2 with a 2.20 ERA (45.0 IP, 11 ER), five home runs, five walks and 36 strikeouts...did not factor into the decision of his last outing against Cleveland on September 18, 2024, a 5-4 Minnesota loss at Progressive Field in which Ober allowed two runs on four hits (2 HR) over seven innings, walking none and striking out 12.

- Stewart (HLD, 2), Jax, Varland and Duran all combined to throw 3.2 scoreless IP allowing just 1 H w/ 1 BB and 6 K in yesterday's win vs. LAA.
- Pen went 1-0, 3.22 ERA (22.1 IP, 8 ER) w/ 9 BB, 27 K, 4 HLD and 2 SV in six games vs. LAA last season.
- Duran snapped the club's streak of 17 save-less games on 4/15 vs. NYM to start the season; streak was the longest in Twins history (1961-) and longest by any team since New York-AL went 21 games without a save to begin the 2007 season.
