**RAY MATTER**—The Rays have won four consecutive games, outscoring opponents, 23-11, during the streak, which comes on the heels of a 3-7 stretch from April 21-May 1...it is their 2nd-longest winning streak of the season behind April 16-20 (5)...the Rays are a season-high-tying 2 games over .500 for the third time...this winning streak has brought them from last place in the AL East into a tie for 2nd...they are 1.5 GB of the Red Sox in the division, their smallest deficit since the end of play on April 24.

- + The Rays are 10-5 on the road, tied for 3rd in the majors, and 30-11 (.732) on the road since Aug 10, 2020, best in the majors...the Rays have won eight of their last nine road games after going 2-4 on the season-opening road trip...over this 8-1 span, the Rays have made just 3 errors while their opponents have combined for 15 errors.
- + The Rays have used 37 players, 22 pitchers and 10 starting pitchers...all rank 2nd in the majors—the Brewers have used 41 players, Cubs have used 24 pitchers and Blue Jays have used 11 starters.
- + The Rays are 7-6 in this stretch of 17 consecutive days without an off day, and 15-11 in this stretch of 30 games in 31 days.

**SEEKING SWEEP**—Tonight the Rays are attempting to sweep a 4-game series for the first time since Aug 10-13, 2020 at BOS...the Rays have completed 233 4-game series in club history and swept 16 of them, including six of 122 4-game series on the road...four of their last five 4-game sweeps have come at Tropicana Field—prior to last August at Fenway Park, their last sweep of a 4-game series on the road was Aug 16-19, 2012 at LAA.

- + The Rays have swept the Angels seven times in franchise history: six 3-game sweeps and one 4-game sweep...**Kevin Cash** has been at the helm for two of these, joining **Joe Maddon** (4) and **Lou Piniella** (1)...on the road, the Rays have swept the Angels three times: May 6-8, 2016 (3-0), Aug 16-19, 2012 (4-0) and June 6-8, 2011 (3-0).
- + The Rays have swept one series this season: April 16-18 at NYY (3-0)...last season the Rays swept six series overall and four series of 3 games (or more)...the Rays last season swept road series of 3+ games against the Red Sox (4-0), Yankees (3-0) and Marlins (3-0).

**PITCHING PLANS**—Tonight's game will be started by **Collin McHugh**, his first since May 7, 2019 vs. KC (with HOU)...tonight is the sixth time this season the Rays are using an opener (3-2)...the Rays introduced the opener concept at Angel Stadium on May 19, 2018, when **Sergio Romo** pitched a perfect 1st inning and struck out **Zack Cozart**, **Mike Trout** and **Justin Upton**...Romo opened again the next day, pitching 1.1 scoreless innings.

- + Incl. postseason, since the debut of the opener on May 19, 2018, the Rays have used one 113 times and are 68-45 (.602) in those games.
- + McHugh will become the 11th starting pitcher used by the Rays this season, matching the Blue Jays for most in the majors.

**PITCHING PROPERLY**—Last night the Rays only run allowed came on a bases-loaded walk to **Jared Walsh** in the 3rd inning...the Rays have pitched to a 2.92 ERA (108-IP, 35-ER) in their last 12 games, allowing 3 runs (or fewer) 10 times over that stretch...this has lowered the staff's season ERA from 4.62 to 3.98, its lowest since the end of play on April 2 (2.00)...the Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) in 16 of their last 25 games (64.0 pct.) since April 10, after doing it once in the first 7 games this season.

- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.49 ERA (226.2-IP, 88-ER) in 25 games, which ranks 5th in the AL over that stretch.
- + The bullpen has a 2.47 ERA (58.1-IP, 16-ER) in the last 13 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 4.18...since April 10, the bullpen is 13th in the majors with a 3.44 ERA (115-IP, 44-ER) in 25 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 53 runs in the 7th inning or later, most in the AL ahead of the Twins (52)...the Rays have yielded 3 HR in the 7th, 4 HR in the 8th, 2 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras...however, in the last 13 games the Rays have allowed 8 runs in the 7th inning or later, after 45 runs through the first 19 games of this season.
- + The Rays are 9-8 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 4-5 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

**ABOUT THE OFFENSE**—Last night all 3 runs scored by the Rays came on a **Brandon Lowe** homer in the 7th inning...the Rays were held to 1 hit through 6 innings and their 4 hits for the game were their 2nd-fewest of the season behind April 12 vs. TEX (3)...the Rays also recorded a season-

high-tying 8 BB, their most in a road game since Aug 10, 2020 at BOS (8).

- + The Rays have totaled 18 runs on 23 hits, 5 HR, 20 BB and 4 errors this series...the club record for walks in a single series is 26, 2x-last July 8-11, 2010 vs. CLE...the Rays have recorded 6 BB (or more) in three consecutive games for the first time since Aug 1-4, 2019 (3).
- + The 5 HR this series pass their total from the previous 8 games.
- + In the last 13 games since April 23 vs. TOR, the Rays have scored 43 runs (3.31 R/G) on 86 hits and 47 BB, have struck out 138 times and are batting .203 (86-for-424) overall and .129 (13-for-101) with RISP.
- + The Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 20 of 32 games (62.5 pct.) this season, tied for the 2nd-fewest in the AL after the Tigers (22).
- + The Rays have struck out 327 times this season, tied for 2nd in the majors behind the Tigers (330)...they rank 11th in the AL in batting avg. (.223), 6th in on-base pct. (.310) and 10th in home runs (33).
- + The Rays have used 32 different batting orders in 32 games.

**CHICKEN ON THE BONE**—The Rays have scored 18 runs this series despite batting .200 (6-for-30) with RISP...the 6 hits are only one shy of tying the team total from the 10-game homestand, when they hit .099 (7-for-71) with RISP...the Rays are 8-for-41 with RISP during the winning streak.

- + This season the Rays are batting .192 (54-for-281) with RISP, last in the majors—29th place is the Nationals (.211)...with RISP and 2 out, their .150 avg. (20-for-133) is last in the majors (29th: Mets, .165)...strangely, they are batting .292 (7-for-24) with the bases loaded.
- + The Rays are batting .235 (35-for-149) with RISP on the road, compared to batting .144 (19-for-132) with RISP at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have struck out 97 times with RISP, 2nd in the majors (Dodgers, 98) and most in the AL...**Willy Adames** and **Randy Arozarena** both have 14 SO with RISP, tied for most in the majors.
- + The Rays have had 64 PA this season with a runner on third and less than 2 outs, and that runner has scored 30 times (46.9 pct.), 17th in the majors...the ML avg. in those situations is 48.8 pct.

**RAYS vs. ANGELS**—With a win tonight, the Rays would clinch the season series over the Angels for a fifth straight time and improve to 5-0-1 over the last six season series...the remaining 3 games are at Tropicana Field, June 25-27...the Rays are 87-101 (.463) all-time against the Angels (42-49 at home, 45-52 on the road), including 55-38 as the Rays after going 32-63 in the Devil Rays era (1998-2007).

- + Since June 2, 2015, the Rays are 15-3 at Angel Stadium...since the start of 2010, the Rays are 31-12 (.721) at Angel Stadium, including 11-1-1 in series play, compared to 16-19 (.457) at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have seen former Manager **Joe Maddon** in two prior series, both with the Cubs: July 4-5, 2017 at Wrigley Field (1-1) and Sep 19-20, 2017 at home (1-1)...only two current Rays played for a Rays team managed by Joe: **Chris Archer** and **Kevin Kiermaier**.

**UP NEXT: ATHLETICS**—Tomorrow is the fifth of seven meetings with Oakland this season, all over a 14-day stretch, after the two clubs split a 4-game series at Tropicana Field last week...tomorrow is the first time the Rays are playing at the Oakland Coliseum since winning the 2019 AL Wild Card Game...the Rays held a lead from the fifth pitch through the final pitch, after **Yandy Diaz** hit a leadoff homer off **Sean Manaea**...the Rays are 78-111 (.413) all-time against the Athletics and 32-60 (.348) at the Oakland Coliseum—their lowest winning pct. at a current AL ballpark.

- + Since July 22, 2016, 20 of the 27 games have been decided by 2 runs (or fewer) and 16 of the 27 have been decided by 1-run margins.
- + LH **Rich Hill** made 14 starts for Oakland in 2016 before they sent him to the Dodgers at the trade deadline...INF **Joey Wendle** is the only other Ray who once played for the Athletics (2016-17).

**THIS DAY IN RAYS HISTORY**—On May 6, 2000, **Steve Trachsel** pitched a 3-hit shutout, finishing with 11 SO to outduel **Pedro Martínez** in a 1-0 Devil Rays victory at Fenway Park...**Greg Vaughn** drove in the game's only run with a 2-out single in the 8th inning...Pedro recorded 17 SO, a single-game record for an opposing pitcher against the Rays that has been matched once since, by **Brandon Morrow** on Aug 8, 2010 in Toronto.
