METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets enjoyed a day off on Thursday... On Wednesday, the Mets fell to the Marlins, 5-0, at Citi Field...Tonight, the Mets start their second road trip of the year, a six-game road trip against the A's (three games) and Twins (three games).

THIS DAY IN METS HISTORY: On this day in 1962, the New York Mets played their first game...The Mets fell to the St. Louis Cardinals, 11-4 in St. Louis...Roger Craig took the loss, while Gil Hodges hit the first home run in franchise history, a solo shot in the top of the fourth inning.

AW SNAP: The Mets fell to the Fish on Wednesday, which snapped a season-high six-game winning streak...Despite the loss, the Mets have won seven of their last nine games.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: New York hits the road for the second time this season...The Mets are 3-3 on the road this year...Last year, the Mets finished the season going 43-38 away from Citi Field...The Mets surpassed their road win total of 2023 (32-49)...The Mets hit .254/.316/.416 on the road last year...They ranked seventh in the majors in AVG and SLG and were 10th in OBP.

DIRTY DOZEN: Mets pitchers have collected 118 strikeouts this season, tied for the sixth-most strikeouts through the team's first 12 games in a season (125K in 2019, 124K in 2022, 123K in 2018, and 119K in 2017 and 2021).

LOW FIVE: On Wednesday, the Mets allowed a season-high-tying five runs for the third time...They are the only team in the majors to not allow more than five runs in a game this season...It is tied for the second-longest such streak in team history to being a season (most: 20 games, 1978).

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: Mets relievers have combined to post a 1.70 ERA (9 ER/47.2 IP) this season...That is the second-best mark in the majors...New York relievers have stranded 21 of 26 inherited runners (19.2 percent) the second-best mark in the majors (min. five inherited runners).

MAX POWER: Max Kranick extended his career-high scoreless inning streak to 14.0 IP (since: 5/7/22 at CIN with PIT), including 9.0 innings pitched this season...He has held opponents to a .068 on-base percentage (2-29, 0 BB) which is the best in the NL and fourth-best in the majors for a reliever...He has not issued a walk to any of his 29 batters faced and is one of six pitchers in the majors this season to not issue a walk and face at least 25 batters.

LINSANITY: After going 0-11 through his first three games, Francisco Lindor is batting .333 (10-30) with seven runs, two doubles, one home run, four RBI, three walks, two steals, a .371 OBP, .500 SLG and an .871 OPS...He has hit safely in each of those eight games.

A'S-METS NOTES: The Mets head to California to face the A's on the road for the first time since 2023...The Mets have won four straight against the A's in California and five of their last six.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: Pete Alonso has safely hit in six of his last seven games...He is batting .333 (14-42) with seven runs, five doubles, three homers, 15 RBI, eight walks, a .451 OBP, a .667 SLG and a 1.118 OPS...His 15 RBI are tied for the fifth-most in the majors.

ALMOST ALWAYS JUAN: Juan Soto did not reach base on Wednesday for the first time this season...He reached base safely in each of his first 11 games as a Met, a career-high season-opening streak...He has reached base two or more times in seven games...Overall, he is batting .279 (12-43) with 10 runs, four doubles, one home run, four RBI, nine walks with a .846 OPS and a 146 OPS+.

WE REMEMBER: The New York Mets announced that the team will wear a tribute uniform patch all season long to honor Mets Hall of Famer Ed Kranepool...Kranepool passed away on September 8, 2024, at age 79...Kranepool played for the Mets from 1962-1979, spending his entire 18-year career with the Mets...He was a member of the 1969 Miracle Mets, a 1965 All-Star and the club's all-time leader in games played...Kranepool remains in the Mets all-time top 10 in many statistical categories including plate appearances, hits, at-bats, total bases, doubles, RBI, walks and runs scored...He was inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in 1990.

THE WRIGHT WAY: On July 19, the New York Mets will retire No. 5 and induct David Wright into the Mets Hall of Fame...On April 11, 2005, David Wright went 2-5 with one run and a double as the Mets defeated the Astros, 8-4 in Houston...Wright will become the eighth player in franchise history to have his number retired by the Mets, joining Tom Seaver (#41), Mike Piazza (#31), Jerry Koosman (#36), Keith Hernandez (#17), Willie Mays (#24), Dwight Gooden (#16) and Darryl Strawberry (#18).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his Mets Citi Field debut against Toronto on April 5 and he gave up one run over four innings of work to go along with six strikeouts, four hits and two walks...He now is 0-1 with a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.2 IP) and has 10 strikeouts over his first two starts.

GRIFFIN FANNING: During Spring Training, he struck out 22 batters over his 14.1 innings of work, highlighted by his nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings vs. Tampa Bay on March 17...His 22 strikeouts ranked ninth in the Grapefruit League and tied for the 17th-most across the majors...Canning finished the spring with an impressive 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) and a K/9.0IP of 13.8...In his last two major league seasons Canning has recorded 130 and 139 strikeouts respectively.

WORKHORSE: Last season, he set a career-high with 31 starts and 171.2 innings pitched for the Angels and in 2023 he finished with 127.0 innings...He is just one of 51 pitchers to throw at least 125.0 innings in each of the past two seasons...In the last two seasons combined, Canning has thrown 298.2 innings which ranks 48th in the majors over that time.

KEEP THE CHANGE: Canning's changeup is one of his best pitches and last season it had a run value of four which ranked eighth in the majors...He threw his changeup 26.7% of the time and held his opponents to a .259 batting average against that pitch...He also generated a 28.8% whiff% on his changeup which was the 11th-highest clip in the majors...So far this season he has thrown it 22.2% and it produced a 35.3 whiff% while picking up a strikeout with the pitch.

STAY GOLDEN: Canning was awarded the American League Rawlings Gold Glove in 2020, and he owns a career .951 fielding percentage...Last season he had a perfect fielding percentage on his 32 chances.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK: He signed a one-year contract with the Mets on December 19, 2024, and he had spent his entire five-year major league career with the Angels prior to signing with the Mets this past offseason...Canning owns a career 25-35 record with a 4.75 ERA (273 ER/517.2 IP) and 493 career strikeouts.

- Threw a scoreless inning in relief on April 9 against Miami...He has already thrown 9.1 innings this year which is tied for the most by a reliever this season (Also: Jalen Beeks Arizona, Jack Dreyer Los Angeles-NL and Steven Matz St. Louis).
- Pitched 2.1 scoreless innings on April 5 against Toronto, which at the time extended his career-high season-opening scoreless streak to 7.1 innings...He had retired 22 of his 26 batters faced during the streak (3 H, BB)...Was the 10th time in his career and second time this season that he has pitched at least 2.1 innings.
- Got the final two outs and picked up the save in the Mets 6-5 win on April 2 at Miami...It was his first career save after not recording one in his first 118 career appearances.
- Pitched 2.1 scoreless innings on Opening Day (March 27) against Houston.
- Made his second career Opening Day roster and his first with the Mets.
- Appeared in nine Grapefruit League games and finished with a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) and 14 strikeouts.
- Began last season with Miami before he was acquired by the Mets on July 30 in exchange for INF Wilfredo Lara.
- Finished last season with a 5.14 ERA (12 ER/21.0 IP) and 51 strikeouts over 39 games between the Marlins and Mets.

- Held the Marlins scoreless for two innings on April 7 and picked up his first hold of the season...It was the eighth game since the start of last season in which he entered in relief and pitched at least two scoreless innings.
- Pitched two scoreless innings and earned the win on April 2 at Miami...It was his seventh career win as a reliever and his seven wins since the start of the 2024 season are tied for the 16th-most amongst relievers during that time frame (Tied for 10th-most in the NL).
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Pitched in six Grapefruit League games and surrendered two runs in 5.2 innings of work while striking out six.
- Was on the Wild Card, NLDS and NLCS rosters...He appeared in all three rounds and pitched to a 6.43 ERA (5 ER/7.0 IP) over six appearances.
- Recalled from Triple-A Syracuse on July 2...Also, with the Mets from April 4-5 and April 14-May 15.
- In 2024 he completed 36.0 innings in 23 relief outings and allowed eight runs (2.00 ERA), going 6-0 with three saves and 41 strikeouts...Was 1-3 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP) in seven starts.

- Gave up three earned runs in the loss on April 9 against Miami...It was just the 12th time in his career that he had surrendered 3 or more earned runs in a game.
- Earned his second save of the season on April 7 against Toronto, he hit two batters but also recorded a strikeout.
- Struck out three batters and picked up the win while pitching a scoreless ninth inning in the Mets win vs. Toronto on April 5.
- Picked up his first save of the season in his first appearance on March 28 when he pitched a perfect ninth inning against Houston.
- Pitched in four Grapefruit League games and finished with a 5.40 ERA (2 ER/3.1 IP) to go along with five strikeouts.
- Unscored upon in five of six postseason games in 2024...He finished the postseason with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER/8.2 IP), one win, two saves, one hold and one blown save.
- Worked 5.1 scoreless innings with six strikeouts in the NLCS...Earned his second save of the postseason with 1.1 scoreless innings (3 K) in Game 2 NLCS at Los Angeles-NL.
