Ozzie Albies (.364) and Mauricio Dubón (.345) pace the club in RISP batting average.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and New York Mets today conclude a three-game weekend series with the third of 13 scheduled games between the clubs this season...This is the first of four series between the teams this season...They will next meet for a four-game wraparound series from July 3-6.

A Outfielder Eli White logged three extra-base hits and two RBI to spur a Braves win over the Mets last night, 3-1...Atlanta starter Martín Pérez gave up one run across 5.1 innings.

A The Braves and Mets are slated to play all of their regular season games during the summer months for the second consecutive season...Each of the contests between these two clubs will be completed by August 12...In that span, 25% of Atlanta's games will be against New York.

A Atlanta played to an 8-5 record against New York last season, including a 4-3 mark here at Citi Field...Overall, the 2025 Braves went 30-22 against the NL East, but 46-64 against all other opponents.

A The Braves have taken the season series from the Mets for nine consecutive seasons, dating to 2018...The team is 77-50 (.606) against New York in that span.

A RH Freddy Peralta is set to face the Braves for the 10th time (9th start) in his career, but for the first time as a Met...In nine previous outings against Atlanta as a Milwaukee Brewer, the 6-foot-0, 198-pound right-hander has gone 5-2 with a 4.26 ERA (21 ER/44.1 IP)...Overall, the native of Moca, DR, has given up at least four runs in three of his last four outings this year...In total, he is 4-5 with a 4.04 ERA (35 ER/78.0 IP) this season.

BRYCE ELDER: Is set to take his 15th turn today with a 5-3 record and a 2.66 ERA (25 ER/84.2 IP) – the 10th-best in Major League Baseball among qualifiers...The right-hander also ranks highly in the National League in innings pitched (84.2), opponent batting average (7th, .206) and WHIP (7th, 1.05)...The Braves are 9-5 in his turns.

A The 6-foot-2, 220-pound native of Decatur, TX, has made five starts and six appearances against New York, going 5-3 with a 3.94 ERA (14 ER/32.0 IP).

A Over a 21-start span dating to August 24 of last season, Elder has compiled a major-league-most 16 Quality Starts...He owns a 2.71 ERA (39 ER/129.1 IP) and a 1.03 WHIP in that time.

A Elder has held left-handed hitters to a .155 batting average, the third-lowest mark in MLB regardless of throwing hand...Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (.108) and Philadelphia's Christopher Sánchez (.143) are the only players that have been better in that regard.

A He owns a 10.05 K/9 on the road this season.

ELI WHITE: Tied his career high with three hits yesterday, all of which went for extra bases...The outfielder hit a pair of doubles and homered for the third time this season, logging two RBI in the process.

A White became the second Brave this season to accumulate three extra-base hits in a single game...Matt Olson also had two doubles and a homer on April 2 at Arizona.

A Since July 8, 2025, the outfielder from Greenville, SC, leads Atlanta's club in at-bats-per-home run (15.90)...Matt Olson ranks second in that time with an AB/HR of 17.66...White's AB/HR ratio ranks eighth in the National League in that span.

A The right-handed hitter is batting .435 (10-for-23) as a pinch-hitter dating to the start of the 2025 season...Among players with as many pinch-hit plate appearances (24 PA), his batting average leads MLB.

A He is currently the third-fastest man in MLB according to Statcast, registering a sprint speed of 30.3 mph...Teammate Jorge Mateo (30.4 mph) and Bobby Witt Jr. (KC, 30.4) are the only players ahead of him.

SHORTENING UP: Mauricio Dubón went 1-for-4 out of the leadoff spot yesterday...With a 2-2 count in the third inning, he dumped his lone hit into right field for a single.

A The right-handed utility player has recorded 15 hits to the opposite field in two-strike counts this season, tied for the most in Major League Baseball...Miami's Otto Lopez also has that many...For Dubón, 56.3% of his two-strike hits have been hit the other way.

A In two-strike counts overall, Dubón's .228 batting average is eighth-best in the National League...Ozzie Albies (.239) ranks fourth on that list.

A As a team, the Braves lead MLB with a .559 OPS in two-strike counts...The league average is .508 in such situations.

SERIES & RUBBER GAMES: The Braves today will attempt to avoid losing just their fourth series of the season...Their three series defeats to this point are the fewest in Major League Baseball...The Dodgers have lost the second-fewest series, dropping five of them.

A The Braves haven't lost consecutive series since August 31-September 14, 2025, when they lost five in a row.

A Atlanta is 8-2 (.800) in rubber matches this season, the most wins and highest winning percentage of any club.

A With the series on the line, the Braves have pitched to a 1.72 ERA (17 ER/89.0 IP), easily the best mark in baseball...The Dodgers ranks second at 2.67.

Today's Game

Makes his 15th start of the season and the 93rd of his career in the finale of a three-game series at New York (NL)...The Braves and Mets have split the first two games of the set.

Faces New York for the first time in 2026...Is 3-0 with a 3.94 ERA (14 ER/32.0 IP) in six career appearances (five starts) against the Mets...Has yet to lose a decision to New York...Last beat them 4-3 on August 14, 2025, allowing two runs over 7.0 innings with six strikeouts.

Carries a 5-3 record and a 2.66 ERA (25 ER/84.2 IP) through 14 starts, the 10th-lowest mark among qualified major league starters...Has posted a 71-to-25 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 1.05 WHIP this season...Atlanta is 9-5 in his 14 turns.

Over a 21-start span dating to August 24 of last season, Elder has compiled a major-league-most 16 quality starts...He owns a 2.71 ERA (39 ER/129.1 IP) and a 1.03 WHIP over the stretch.

His 2.66 ERA (25 ER/84.2 IP) over his first 14 starts of the season is the second-lowest of his career through 14 turns to open a year, behind only his 2023 All-Star mark (2.60, 24 ER/83.0 IP).

Across the 14-start span, Elder worked more innings (84.2 to 83.0), allowed nine fewer hits (64 to 73) and recorded two more strikeouts (71 to 69) than he did to begin 2023...His 1.05 WHIP through 14 starts is a career low for the span, down from 1.14 in 2023.

Left-handed batters are hitting .155 (30-for-194) with four home runs against him this season, the second-lowest opponent average against lefties among qualified right-handed starters, behind only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (.108)...Right-handers are batting .291 (34-for-117) with three homers.

Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this season after not throwing the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25...Has gone to the offering almost exclusively against left-handed batters, throwing it to a right-hander on just seven of his 150 cutters this season.

Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts, the first such mark by an Atlanta starter since Teheran in 2014.

Since the start of the 2023 season, Atlanta is 47-36 in Elder's starts...His 83 starts for the Braves over the span lead the staff.

2026

Took a no-decision in Atlanta's 3-2 win over Pittsburgh in the home series finale June 7, allowing two runs on two hits and two walks with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings on 88 pitches...Logged his 10th quality start of the season, tied for the second-most in the majors behind Philadelphia's Christopher Sánchez (11)...The Braves completed a three-game sweep of the Pirates.

Earned the win on June 2 in the series opener against Toronto, allowing three runs on six hits and a walk with six strikeouts over 6.2 innings on 103 pitches in Atlanta's 4-3 win at Truist Park...Logged his ninth quality start of the season...Yielded a two-run home run to Okamoto in the second inning.

Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 13 of his 14 starts this season.

Took the loss on May 27 at Boston, allowing season highs in hits (9), runs (6) and earned runs (5) over 3.1 innings on 59 pitches in an 8-0 defeat at Fenway Park... Boston batted around in a six-run fourth inning, matching the most runs Atlanta has allowed in a frame this season.

The start snapped an 11-start season-opening streak of allowing three earned runs or fewer, leaving him one of three Braves since 2013 to open a season with at least 11 such turns, joining Reynaldo López (17 in 2024) and Max Fried (11 in 2020)... It also ended a run of 14 consecutive starts of at least 5.0 innings with three earned runs or fewer, dating to September 19 of last season.

Earned his fourth win on May 10 at Dodger Stadium, allowing one hit over 5.2 scoreless innings with four walks and eight strikeouts on 83 pitches in the 7-2 victory at Los Angeles (NL)...Marked his second career win against the Dodgers.

Career

Awards: 2023 National League All-Star.

Completed his first full major league season in 2023, going 12-4 with a 3.81 ERA (74 ER/174.2 IP) in 31 games, all starts.

Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.

Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.

Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts... Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-10) and Ian Anderson ('20-'21) each had five such starts.

Career Cont.

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.

Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.
